POLICY DOCUMENT ON GREEN CAMPUS

Government Degree College Narsapur is committed to promoting green practices among the students and employees.

Almost all the students and the employees travel by public transport (TSRTC buses). The students who reside in and around the campus come to college on foot. The pathway to the campus as well as within the premises is friendly to pedestrians. The green cover of the college is highlighted by landscape gardening. Plastic use is banned on campus.

- 1. <u>Plastic free campus</u>: The college has issued instructions to staff and students not to use plastic cups, bottles, covers, etc. Thus, it is a plastic free zone.
- 2. Landscaping and gardening: Plants and trees of a great variety dot the campus. They are regularly watered and taken care of. The volunteers of the NSS as well as Life Sciences students are involved in the preservation of greenery. Well-ventilated classrooms reduce dependence on fans. The natural sunlight reduces the use of lights. The green cover has reduced dependence on electricity. Thus the current bills are negligible. Greenhouse emissions are thus cut to the least. Government-backed Haritha Haram programs are conducted every year in association with local bodies. The environment in the college is peaceful and healthy.
- 3. <u>Eoffice and e-communication</u>: The college uses Whatsapp and other social media to communicate with the students, thus reducing the dependence on paper. Thus the online medium helps the college go paperless. Whatever little paper is generated is sent for recycling.
- 4. <u>Campus friendly to pedestrians</u>: The pathways in and around the campus are easy to walk on as they are well laid and possess green cover.
- 5. <u>**Public Transport**</u>: The state road transport corporation bus stop is located just outside the campus and most of the students (they have bus passes) and staff travel by bus.
