### **FIT INDIA FREEDOM RUN 2.0**

Fit India Freedom Run was conceived last year when the entire nation started following social distancing in a 'new normal' lifestyle, so as to keep the imperative need of fitness active even while following the social distancing norms, Fit India Freedom Run was launched on the concept of virtual run ie; 'it can be run anywhere, anytime! You run a route of your choice, at a time that suits you. Basically, you run your own race and time your own pace'.

The first edition of the campaign was held from 15th August to 2nd October, 2020. - Organize events on launch day i.e 13<sup>th</sup> August 2021 at iconic and historically important places in the State/Uts to be attended by People's representatives/Celebrities/Athletes/Iconic Personalities/Social Media Influencers, etc.
- Organizers to register their RUN on Fit India portal with details of participants and kms covered
- Promote Freedom Run on their social media channels with #AzadiKaAmritMahotsav and #Run4India.
- Adequate publicity for the program through Social Media, Regional TV/Newspaper, etc.
- Ensure participation at Panchayati/Municipality level, Schools/Colleges, Youth Clubs, Self-help Groups, etc.

It is the responsibility of the accompanying faculty to ensure that the students of their respective college maintain strict discipline and manners in the venue college. Necessary instructions should be given to the participants to ensure smooth conduct of the events. Any violation in this regard shall be viewed very seriously.

If there are girl participants in the team, the participant college Principal shall ensure that a lady lecturer accompanies them. The Principals of Participant and host colleges shall be held responsible for the safety and security of the students.

Cluster level and State level coordinators are permitted to claim their travel expenses from their Parent College TA Budget.

In case of delay in release of fund, advance to conduct Yuvatarangam at College/Cluster/State level shall be taken from the

available/accumulated funds of the college which shall be reimbursed after realization of said allotted budget (TSKC Budget HoA 2202-03-103-00-46-130-132). Under any circumstances, Principals of GDCs should not instruct any faculty to meet the above expenses from their pocket.

The results of the events shall be communicated to O/o CCE and host college of the next level competitions in the prescribed profroma mentioned at Annexure 17), within 24hrs of completion of the event. Communication of the final results to O/o CCE within the time specified, is the responsibility of the coordinators and the host college. Results communicated after 24hrs of completion of the event shall not be considered. A scanned copy of the results duly forwarded by the Principal (in case of College level competitions) and Principal of the Host college (in case of Cluster level and State level competitions) shall be mailed in the prescribed proforma mentioned at Annexure 17 to excellence-ce@telangana.gov.in and the same shall also be filled in the google form provided (without any spelling mistakes).
