- It is noted that all the parents has given a very positive feedback on all the parameters and the overall average score is calculated as 8.91 which is a very good sign.
- As the lowest average is calculated for the college environment towards the overall development of the students, it is resolved to take all appropriate steps in this direction. Along with the existing practices more guest lectures, extension lectures, career guidance, competitive examination coaching, personality development classes shall be conducted.
- As few parents have suggested to focus on the overall development of the students and also to provide competitive examination coaching, it is resolved to take all the necessary measures in this direction under the supervision of career and guidance cell of the college..
