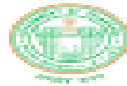

Sub: Collegiate Education-Review Meetings on academic and administrative issues in certain Government Degree Colleges- Old and non-useful Furniture, Books, Lab Material etc.-Condemnation-Reg.  
Ref: Minutes of Meeting-Review Meetings of CCE with GDCs.

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education Telangana has conducted review meetings with Principals, Academic Coordinators & IQAC Coordinators of certain Government Degree Colleges to review the academic and administrative issues on 02.11.2019, 20.11.2019 & 21.11.2019. During these review meetings it has come to the notice of Commissioner of Collegiate Education that Old and non-useful Furniture, Books, Lab Material etc., is accumulated in Government Degree Colleges.

In this connection Commissioner of Collegiate Education has instructed the Principals of Government Degree Colleges to constitute a College Level Committee comprising of Principal, One Senior Lecturer and Administrative Officer/Office Superintendent to identify and classify the items into three categories Good, Repairable and Non-repairable (which shall be condemned). Commissioner of Collegiate Education also instructed that the items which are identified by College Level Committee shall be ratified by the CCE nominated Principal of nearby colleges. The details of items condemnable along with the rates shall be sent for approval of CCE, Subject to approval the condemnation process is as follows.

1. Condemned Furniture/Books/Lab Material etc., cost less than Rs.20,000/- shall be sold directly to any firm.
2. Condemned Furniture/Books/Lab Material etc., cost from Rs.20,000/- to Rs.1,00,000/- shall be called for quotations and highest quotation must be considered.
3. Condemned Furniture/Books/Lab Material etc., cost is more than Rs.1,00,000/- shall be called for tenders in e-procurement basis.

4. The amount received shall be credited into government treasury account.

Principals are informed to follow the above process scrupulously, any deviation will be viewed seriously and action will be taken accordingly.

## Guidelines to Identify e-wastage/ Scrap material

1. In-charges of all the departments ( B.Sc, B.A, B.Com) are requested to identify Scrap material (computers, furniture, Lab equipment, any other which dept. feels that wastage) at your department level with the help of your department staff.
2. This should be done by Tuesday.
3. Report the list of above scrap identified by the in-charges to the Condemnation committee.
4. Condemnation committee have to visit the concern department, inquire above said scrap and certify that as a scrap.
5. The certified scrap list collected from all the departments compiled by the committee and send to the CCE for approval. It should be done within two days.
6. After approval from CCE same list send to MSTC officials who already created login for our college.
7. MSTC upload this list in [mstc.ecommerce .com](http://mstc.ecommerce.com) website
8. Buyers will visit our college to verify the same. They will place their bid amount in the MSTC cite.
9. After the scheduled time highest bidder will pay the amount through MSTC and take away the scrap.

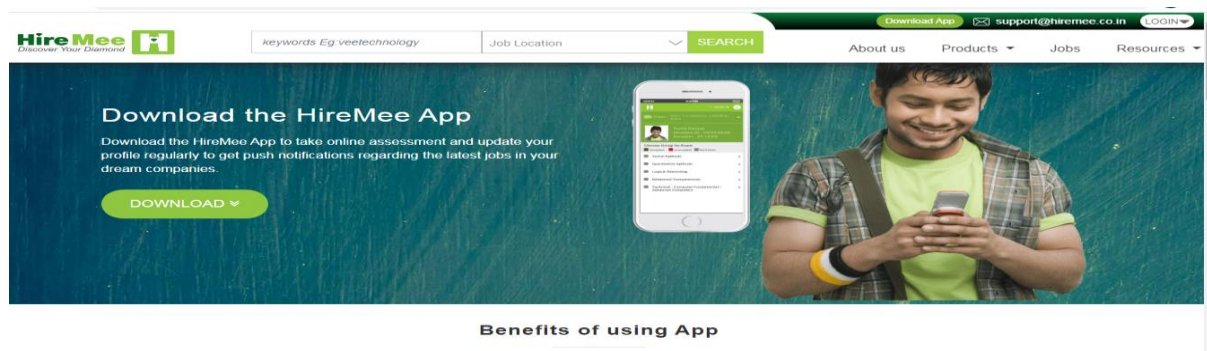

**Sub:** Collegiate Education - MoU signed with Naandi Foundation - 40 hour skilling programme by Naandi Foundation in all Government Degree Colleges - Instructions - Reg.

The attention of all the Principals of Government Degree Colleges is drawn to the subject cited above. The Principals of all GDCs are informed that Commissionerate of Collegiate Education has signed the MOU with Naandi Foundation, on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2018.

Naandi Foundation is an apolitical, autonomous Public Charitable Trust and a Not-for-profit organisation with an objective to impart skill development program to underprivileged youth. The organization aims to build and enhance the employability skill set among the students studying in colleges under the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education in the State of Telangana.

Mahindra Pride Classroom, a project by Naandi Foundation conducts "Employability Skill Training Program" in the Colleges of Telangana State.

1. The program shall be carried out in Government Degree Colleges, in the State of Telangana.
2. Only students studying in the final semester will receive this training.
3. The skilling program shall be for duration of 40 hours.
4. The program shall include Soft-Skills, Communication Skills, Life Skill and Interview preparations under employability skill development program.
5. The Program is free of cost. Naandi shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name either from the students or the Government institutions for conducting the aforesaid program.

6. Mahindra Pride Classroom Coordinator will contact the Principals of the Colleges to plan and schedule their 40 hrs program in their premises.
7. One class/batch of students should have maximum of 50 students for effective and impactful training.
8. The Skilling programme by Naandi Foundation may start after the completion of first semester examinations in all Government Degree Colleges.
9. Certificates shall be awarded by Naandi to the students on successful completion of the training and qualifying the assessment which will be conducted after the completion of the program.



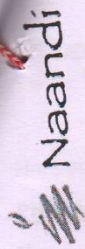

## **Memorandum of Agreement**

This Memorandum of Agreement is made between

**Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana (CCETS)**

and

**Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay (ST- IIT Bombay)**

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education is created to promote quality education, giving special attention to the areas located in backward and rural areas. It also strengthens the women education at undergraduate level and works towards educational opportunities for weaker sections of the society.

The Spoken Tutorial project developed by IIT Bombay for MHRD, Government of India is the initiative of the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (ICT), launched by the Ministry of Human Resources and Development, Government of India. The uses of spoken tutorial is to advocate and popularize numerous Open Source software and their utilization.

Spoken tutorial project intends to provide opportunity to conduct software training from ST-IIT Bombay to all the Government Degree Colleges (GDCs) in Telangana state. As the programme is funded by the National Mission on Education through ICT, MHRD, Government of India it charges a nominal annual User Fee of Rs.25000/year/college. The program will provide the following benefits to the students of GDCs under purview of CCETS-

1. Students and Teachers receive hands on training through a particular FOSS (Free and Open Source Software) like Linux, Scilab, LaTeX, PHP & MySQL, Java, C/C++, Libre Office etc. The students who complete the required training hours will be awarded Certificates by Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay.
2. The training enhances IT, Software skills and employability for the students and any number of students and faculty can take any number of courses and Certificates in a year with User Fee of Rs. 25000/year/college.

**The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE), Telangana State and Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay** does hereby agree to the following broad terms of cooperation as under:

**Commissionerate of Collegiate Education shall-**

- Identify a Chief Central Co-ordinator from the department who will actively work and co-ordinate with Spoken Tutorial team, IIT Bombay to roll-out and introduce the project into all degree colleges in the state.
- Put up the signed agreement note on the CCE website along with Spoken Tutorial site link and Telangana training manager Ms. Swati Dongardive's contact details and issue notifications to all the Principals of Government Degree Colleges to make the Payment through NEFT, introduce and roll-out the Spoken Tutorial based software training in colleges.
- Conduct a Master training program for a faculty member in each GDC through Faculty Development Training Program for running Software training SELF learning way in their respective Colleges as one of the initiatives under capacity building.
- Offer General IT Skills package in Telugu also.
- Issue circular to all the GDCs to introduce and roll-out the Spoken Tutorial based software training in the GDCs.
- Have a monitoring system on department's website [ccets.cgg.gov.in](http://ccets.cgg.gov.in) to track the progress made by the different colleges, suggest bi-monthly reports from colleges to CCE and ST, IIT Bombay.

**The Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay shall-**

- Work as a mentor for the GDCs in the Telangana State.
- Support the training and execution by CCE by providing manuals and continuous guidance at the unit level that is the Government Degree College.
- Nominate a Representative who will work with the Faculty Development Training Program in CCE.

- Provide guidance and learning path for progressively higher levels of learning through advanced courses.
- Provide the knowhow and course content material that includes CDs/DVDs, online material, instruction sheets and any other training material related to the GDCs.
- Issues Completion Certificates, who undergo training and qualifies the Online assessment test
- Participation Certificates shall be issued to the students who undergo the training and do not take the online test.
- Provide the promotional materials like posters, brochures, leaflets, banners etc. to the CCETS and the GDCs in TS.


#### **General**

- This agreement is for a duration of one year from the date of signing and can be renewed and modified from time to time if necessary, based on mutual consent.
- IIT Bombay-ST permits the colleges with less than 100 number of students to learn along with nearby college students and will not expect the User Fee of Rs.25000/college/year.
- The interpretation of any clause will rest with CCE TS.

Now based on the above mentioned promise(s), the parties put their signatures on this MoA on 19.02.2019.
