Civil works of construction of Library hall, Seminar hall, two class rooms and 360 m compound wall work is going on. These works are funded by RUSA.

For the optimum utilization of the resources in the institution, various committees have been constituted comprising the Principal as the Chairman, senior members of the faculty as Conveners and other teachers as members. These committees meet on regular basis to discuss issues related to their respective committees so as to ensure the optimum utilization of the facilities on campus. The in-charge of each facility (In-charges of the Departments, Librarian, Physical Director etc.,) maintains stock and accession registers. These registers are verified annually by the Annual Departmental Verification Committees. These Committees are constituted by members of faculty related to other departments.
