Question Wise Employers Feedback Analysis on Syllabus



Feedback Analysis Report

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) every year mandatorily collect feedback forms on curriculum from stakeholders- students, teachers, employers and alumni. This is done by the college level Feedback Committee. Feedback on curriculum is collected from the students manually. Alumni Feedback is collected during alumni meetings & even online. The teachers and Employers' Feedback is also collected either in person or online. The Statistical data is handed over to the Feedback committee for its analysis. The feedback committee collects inputs and suggestions from the stakeholders and further action to be taken is discussed with departments and authorities. The decisions taken by the authorities are forwarded for action to be initiated. The feedback analysis was also done graphically for easy understanding and effective presentation. The important and brief summary of the feedback is listed below:

Summary on student feedback Analysis:

From the student feedback forms the following observations are made:

1. 92% students are agreeing that present syllabus is suitable for their course.
2. 93% students feel that syllabus is need based.
3. Almost every student agrees that syllabus is justifying its aims and objectives.
4. 86% students report that there is a balance between theory and applications.
5. Only 7% students are of the view that material is not available for syllabus.
6. Every student believes that syllabus outcomes can be achieved and it is useful for providing employment opportunities.
7. 4% students think that it will not help in enhancing their knowledge and skills.
8. Overall every student is satisfied with the syllabus for their course.

Summary on Teachers feedback Analysis:

From the teachers feedback forms the following observations are made:

- a) Almost every teacher is satisfied with the syllabus what they have and also thinks that the syllabus is suitable for their concerned subject, syllabus can enhance the student's knowledge and skills, course outcomes can be achieved and syllabus is very handy to teach.
- b) 96% teacher have the opinion that syllabus is need based.

- c) Only 4% teachers feel that they are not doing justice in defining aims and objectives.
- d) 12% teachers think that there is no balance between theory and applications.
- e) 12% teachers suggest that syllabus needs to be more application oriented to provide employment opportunities.

Summary on Alumni feedback Analysis:

From the Alumni feedback forms it is observed that almost every alumnus is happy with the syllabus what they studied in their course. Alumni feedback suggests that the syllabus is suitable for the course, need based, doing justice in defining aims and objectives, course outcomes can be achieved, helps in enhancing their knowledge and skills and also useful for providing employment opportunities.

Only 6% alumni suggest that the syllabus needs balance between theory and applications.

Summary on Employers feedback Analysis:

From employers feedback forms it is observed that syllabus is suitable for the course and need based. The following observations are made from Employers feedback forms:

1. 18% employers has the opinion that syllabus is not doing justice in defining aims and objectives.
2. 9% thinks that there is no balance between theory and applications, course outcomes cannot be achieved, it will not enhance the student's knowledge and skills, and it will not provide employment opportunities.

The feedback transaction on syllabus was done for physics subject, wherein the feedback was forwarded to the Head, Department of Physics, Kakatiya University (affiliating university), and the Department Head acknowledged the same positively.



1. The revised first semester syllabus w.e.f 2019-20 has experiments on determination of Young's modulus Y by uniform and non-uniform bending methods. These experiments are related to theory chapter "Mechanics of Continuous Media" which was removed from syllabus w.e.f. 2019-20. It was suggested to remove these experiments from practical syllabus list and add experiments related to theory syllabus.
2. It was suggested to introduce the basics of Operational Amplifiers with inverting and non-inverting configuration in electronics part to support the students preparing for JAM to pursue M.Sc Physics in premier institutes.
