

## **Feedback Analysis on Curriculum Design & Review of syllabus for the Academic Year 2019- 20**

Feedback has been collected manually from the students, the Teachers, the Parents, the alumni and the local employers on curriculum of various courses and their related aspects in the month of February, 2020 to make teaching learning process more effective and to meet the needs of the students in all aspects. Feedback forms have been designed separately for students, teachers, parents, alumni and local employers. Feedback forms were analysed by IQAC and major suggestions from stakeholders were forwarded to concerned Departments and affiliated university for Action. 275 students, 50 parents, 35 teachers, 15 Alumni, local employers responses were recorded and analysed on curriculum, academic environment and other student related services on campus.

### **Analysis of the Feedback**

#### Student's Feedback

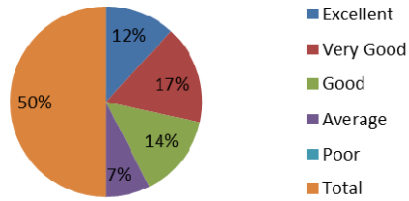
Student feedback forms (300) were issued to the students of all sections randomly in February 2020 and 275 forms were collected after a week. The data in these forms is tabulated as shown below. Out of 275 student respondents 92% were satisfied with the curriculum of the courses offered in the college and rated excellent, very good and good. 20% of students commented to include more programmes on communication skills, soft skills and 40% suggested increasing number of campus drives, job oriented courses.

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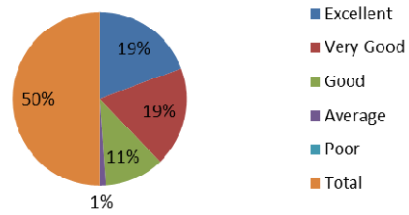

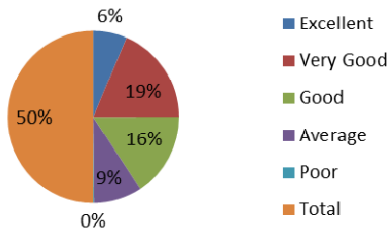
**Relevance of course structure to the course objectives**



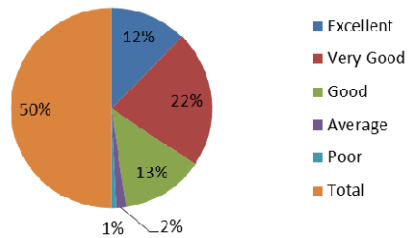
**Scope for skill development/employability/entrepreneurship in the course offered**



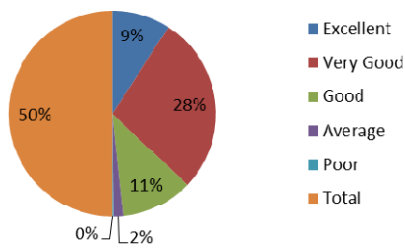
**The research orientation in the course design**



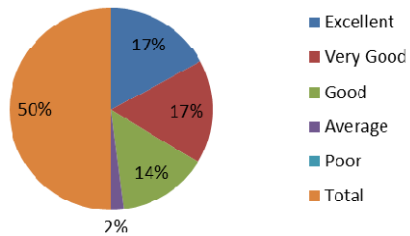
**Structure of CBCS curriculum**



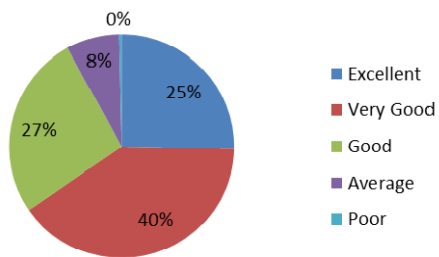
**Pattern of curriculum evaluation**

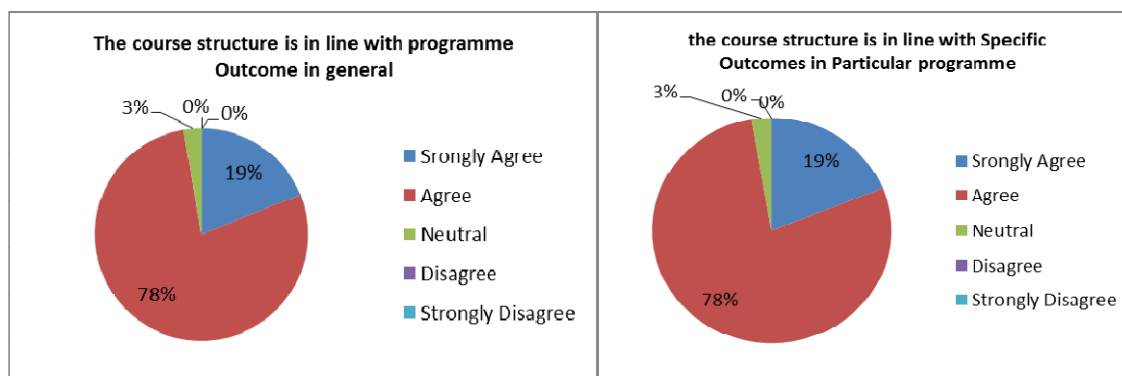
## Teacher's Feedback

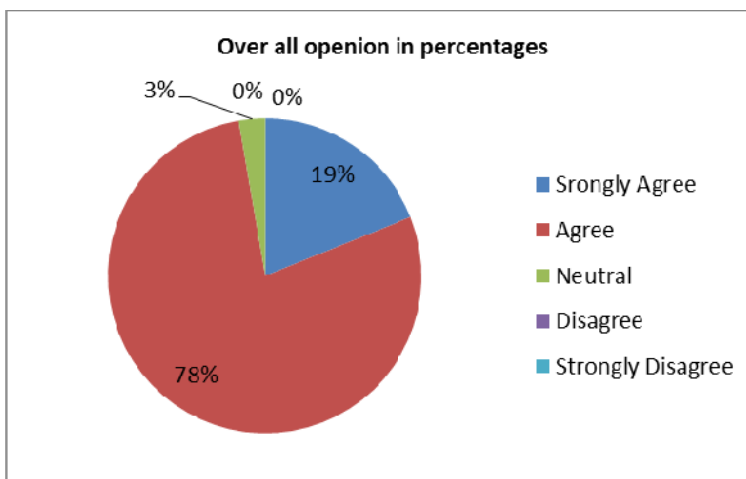
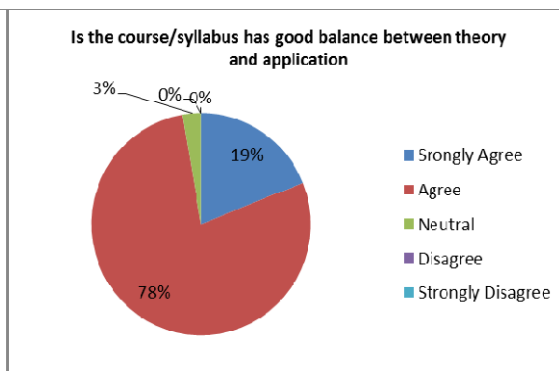
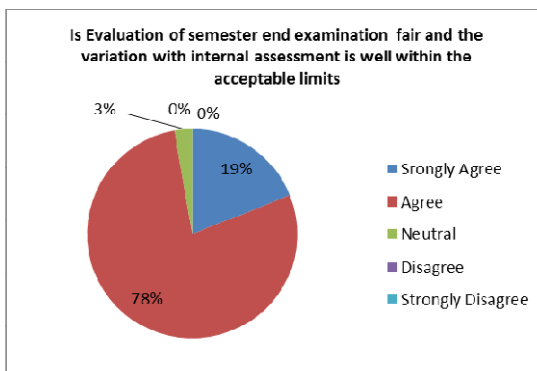
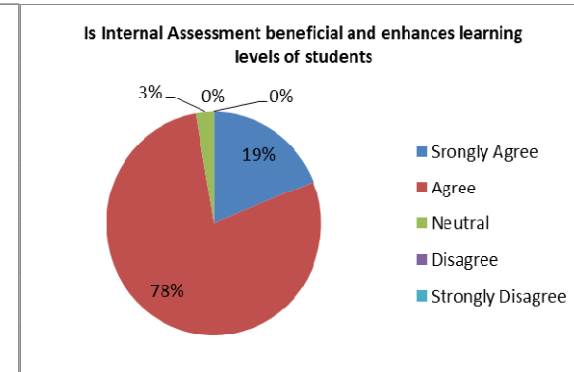
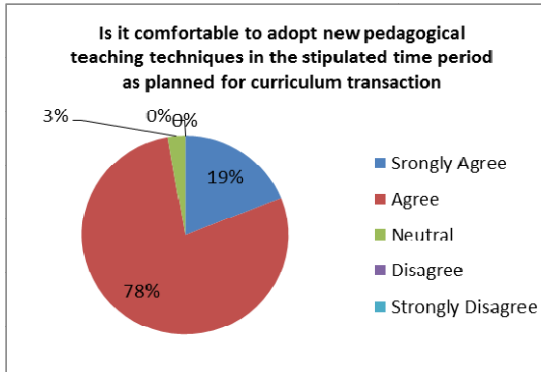
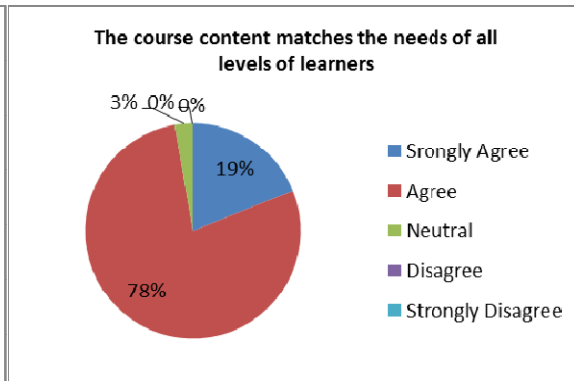
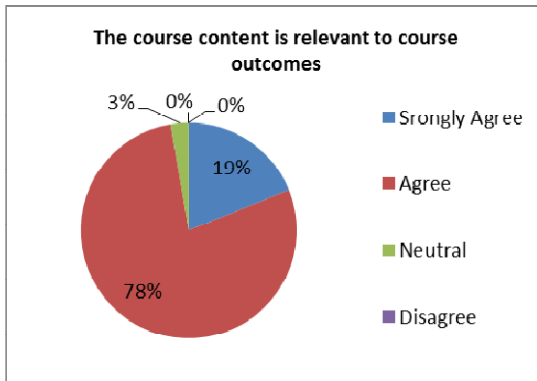

### Employer's Feedback

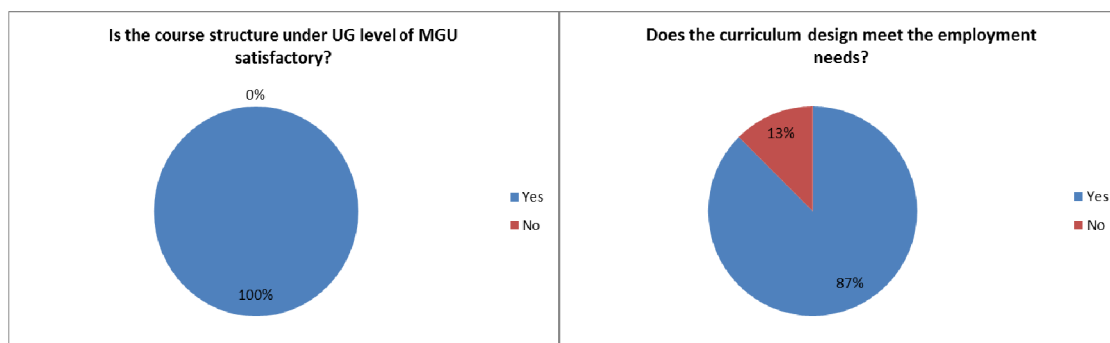

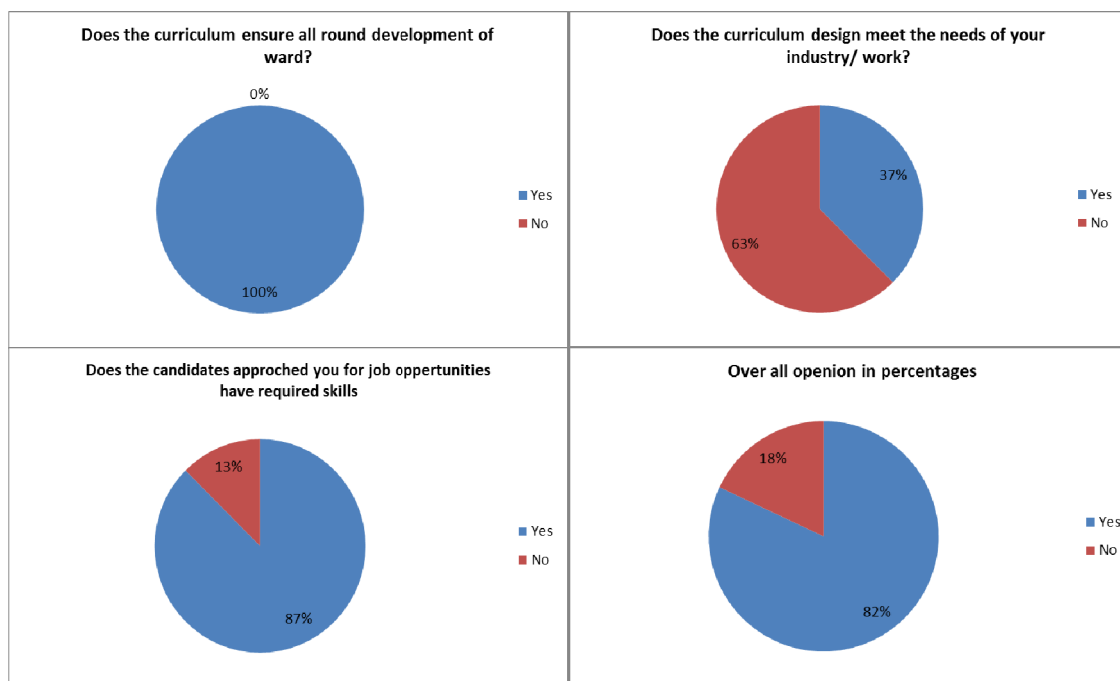
