7. The Grant is subject to the Adjustment on the basis of Utilization Certificate in the prescribed Performa submitted by the College.

8. The University/College shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure out the Grants, which shall be utilized, only on approved items of expenditure and ensure proper labeling of the items purchased.

9. The utilization certificate to the effect that the Grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the University Grants Commission as early as possible after the close of the current financial year. Balance grant will be released only on receipt of audited UC and Statement of Expenditure etc., signed by Chartered Accountant.

10. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of University Grants Commission's Grant shall not be disposed or encumbered or utilized for the purposes other than those for which the Grant was give, without proper sanction of the University Grants Commission and should, at any time the College ceased to function, such assets shall revert to the University Grants Commission.

11. The University/College/Institute shall maintain a Register of Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the Grants in the prescribed form.
12. The grantee institution shall ensure the Utilization of grants-in-aid for which it is being sanctioned/paid. In case of non-Utilization/part utilization; or mis-utilization of grants sanctioned by the Commission for the purpose for which these were approved and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the approval or does not furnish the required documents or is disaffiliated from the University the entire amount paid by the Commission shall be refunded by the College with simple interest @ 10% per annum as amended from time to time on unutilized amount from the date of drawl to the date of refund as per provisions contained in General Financial Rules of Government of India will be charged.
13. **The grant should not be used for Self-Financing/Unaided Courses.**
14. It may be noted that the accounts of the grant-in-aid institution shall be subject to inspection by Officers of the SERO, UGC, Hyderabad.
15. The interest earned by the University/ College/Institute on this grants in aid shall be treated as additional grant and may be shown in the U.C./Statement of expenditure to be furnished by grantee institution.

NOTIFICATION

Whereas, on account of large scale misappropriation of funds,  
mis-management and in response to several mass agitation and appeals  
made by the students, staff and all sections of the society including  
the M.L.As of the District belonging to 5 political parties, the  
Government issued orders in Memo.No. 79/J2/84-22 Edn., dt. 6-5-1985  
for taking over Sri Ramachandra Arts & Science College, Kothagudem,  
Khammam Dist. through a notification under sub-section (6) of  
Section 60 of the A.P. Education Act, 1982 (Act 1 of 1982), which  
was published in the Government Gazette dated 6-5-1985. The  
Government also appointed a Special Officer (Principal, Govt. College)  
Bhadrachalam) for the purpose of carrying on the Management of the  
said institution for and on behalf of the Government.

2) And whereas, the Director of Higher Education in his proceedings  
Rc.No. 296/K3-1/83, dt. 19-3-85, issued orders suspending the  
management of the College under sub-section (3) of Section 24 of  
of Andhra Pradesh Education Act, 1982.

3) And aggrieved by the orders of the Government in appointing  
a Special officer, the erstwhile private management of Sri Ramachan-  
dra Arts & Science College, Kothagudem filed W.P.No. 4899/85. The  
Hon'ble High Court in their order dated 26-6-85 in W.P.No. 6812/85  
and J.V.M.F.No. 735/85 in W.P.No. 4899/85 ordered to maintain status quo  
and as on that date. The Management again filed W.A.No. 7467/85.  
The Hon'ble High Court in their order dated 19-1-1991 in W.A.No.  
1467/85 in W.P.No. 4899/85 have dismissed both the W.A. as well as.  
Writ Petition, as withdrawn)

4) And whereas, the Hon'ble High Court in its order dated 12-2-97  
in Writ Petition No. 7791/99 among other things, has directed to  
complete the enquiry pursuant to the Memo.No. 2597/CE.3/87-2, Education  
dated 7-5-1988 after giving notice and reasonable opportunity to the

petitioners to put-forth their version, before the Government and appropriate decision in this matter may be taken by the respondents within ten weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order. The High Court also directed that the order of status - quo earlier granted by the court shall continue in operation until the disposal and consideration of the matter by the Government, pursuant to the said directions;

5) And whereas, Government in their Memo 4th read above, issued a notice to the former Secretary & Correspondent of the College to co-operate with Enquiry Officer i.e. Regional Joint Director of Higher Education, Warangal District by producing relevant records for completing the enquiry;

6) And whereas, the Regional Joint Director of Higher Education, Warangal in his letter 5th read above, has reported that after receipt of the reply from the former Secretary & Correspondent of the College and also the material available, it was found that the following structures do not exist in the College.

The Regional Joint Director of Higher Education, Warangal has also reported that the records reveals that the college received several other grants from U.G.C but in his reply no mention has been made against the utilisation of the said funds and also that the reluctance and failure to produce cash books and other records pertaining to financial matters prove to be an indication that these amounts have been misappropriated;

7) And whereas the Government after due consideration have decided to take over Physically and the Management of Sri Ramachandra Arts & Science College, Kothagudem, Khammam District, in public interest subject to the following conditions, namely:

- i) The Management should transfer all the movable properties and assets to the Government;
- ii) The Management should transfer all the immovable properties through a deed of conveyance to the Government. The Deed of conveyance should be registered afterwards;
- iii) Only qualified, willing and suitable persons will be absorbed into the Government service against the posts admitted for Grant-in-aid, and their present designation and scale of pay cannot be protected as a matter of course and right. Excess and unqualified staff and salaries paid over and above the Grant-in-aid rules will not be taken into consideration.

8) The Commissioner of Collegiate Education, is directed to take necessary action immediately to take over the college from the Management of the College through a conveyance deed and also to submit proposal to Government for fixing the cadre strength and thereafter for absorption of the staff of the college into the Government service in due course.

The Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Hyderabad is requested to submit necessary proposals for sanction of the expenditure indicating suitable head of account.

This order issues with the concurrence of Finance and Planning Department vide their U.O.No.44645-3/684/E.3.S.VII/88, dated 19-11-88.
