O R D E R:

The Andhra Pradesh Regional Committee in its meeting held on 25th May, 1963 adopted a resolution recommending to Government to take over the management of the Arts and Science College, Gadwal immediately from the current academic year as Gadwal is declared a draught area and people are finding it difficult to collect funds to run the College.

Government have examined the above resolution of A.P. Regional Committee in consultation with the Director of Public Instruction and have decided that the management of the Arts and Science College at Gadwal be taken over by Government subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The Governing Body should transfer all the assets of the College movable and immovable (including the building donated by Sri Krishna Ram Bhupal) without liabilities free of cost through a Registered Deed of conveyance.
- 2) The date of taking over of the College by Government will be the date on which the College is actually transferred with all assets to Government through the Conveyance deed as in item (1) above.
- 3) The College shall be called "The Government Arts and Science College, Gadwal".
- 4) Only qualified suitable and willing members of the existing staff will be absorbed into Government service and others allowed to continue in service till the age of retirement without giving them the benefit of Government Service.
- 5) Pending fixation of cadre strength and absorption of staff into Government service the staff existing as on the date of taking over the College under Government shall be paid salaries as they drew in the aided managements scales of pay and allowances for the previous month.
- 6) The stamp duty for the registration of the deed of conveyance will be borne by the Government.
- 7) the rates of fees to be collected from the Students would be the University rates of fee with effect from the succeeding term in which the college is handed over to Government.

3. The Director of Public Instruction is authorised to incur necessary expenditure in this regard, not exceeding Rs.70,000/- during the current year on salaries of staff and contingencies and see that the deed of conveyance is executed immediately for taking over the College.

4. The expenditure on this account shall be debited to 137/28 Education A. University B. Government Arts Colleges-E. Schemes in the Third Five Year Plan-I(ii) Arts Colleges for Men (Telengana)".

5. The above scheme is on the 'new service' and the expenditure shall be met from an advance from the State contingency Fund in the first instance pending a vote of the Legislature for a token grant of Rs.100/- and finally met by diversion of funds sanctioned in G.O.Ms.No.690 P.&P.R.(plg.II) Department dated 28th June, 1963.

6. Pending scrutiny by the Accountant General later a permanent advance not exceeding Rs.300/- is sanctioned for the College.

7. The present Principal of the College shall be the drawing and countersigning Officer in respect of the salaries of staff (including himself) contingent and other expenditure in respect of the College. He will present the bills at the sub-treasury Gadwal Taluk, Mahabubnagar District. The Principal shall also act as Special Officer for the preparation of conveyance deeds in consultation with the Government Pleader concerned and to get them registered after approval by Government.

8. The Accountant General is requested to issue necessary instructions to the District Treasury Officer, Mahaboobnagar with reference to the orders in paragraph 6 and 7 above.

9. The Director of Stationery is requested to provide the Stationery required by the College direct on the requisition of the Principal.

10. The Director of Public Instruction is permitted to arrange for the local purchase of any additional furniture and equipment required by the College during the current year according to the instructions contained in Article 123(j) of the A.P. Financial Code Vol.I.

ORDER:

3+4=7

1. Sanction is accorded to the creation of three posts of Assistant Lecturers (One each for English, Telugu and Chemistry) and four posts for Demonstrators (One each for Physics, Chemistry Botany and Zoology) for the Maharani Adi Laxmi Devamma Govt. Arts & Science College, Gadwal, temporarily for a period of seven months from 1.8.64 to 28.2.1965, the staff sanctioned above is eligible for the usual scales of pay and allowances admissible to the posts in question.

2. The expenditure shall be divided to "28 Edn. A. University-D. Schemes in the Third Five Year Plan. I(ii) Arts Colleges for Men (Malengana."

3. The action of the Director of Public Instruction in having created the four posts of demonstrators referred to in para 1 above in pursuance of the powers delegated to him in G.O. Ms. No. 60, General Administration (rules) Department dated 9-1-1960 is also approved.

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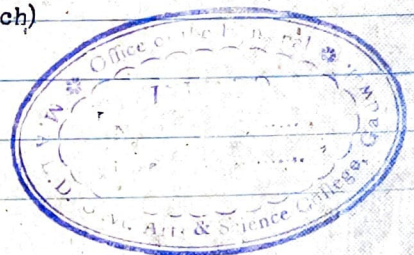
