6. Subject wise details of Labs available with dimensions, facilities and amount spent in previous academic year for each subject lab equipments.
7. Three Governing Body Meeting reports of the Academic Year 2020-21.
8. Compliance Report forwarded by Governing Body Member
9. Latest Affiliation orders issued for the Academic Year 2020-21.





#### GENERAL GUIDELINES:-

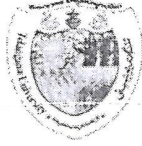
1. Non-Compliance of the conditions laid down by the Inspection Committee within the stipulated time shall lead to withdrawal of affiliation.
