

- Assignments are given to average and backlog students. Teaching notes are also given to students every year.




- Study projects are given to bright and advanced students. In this academic year every student is preparing project work.




#### **HI. RESEARCH, CONSULTANCY AND EXTENSION LECTURE**

> Department store the project works to guide the research activities for our students.




- The students are grouped and placed under a teacher to develop close rapport to solve the personal problems of each student.

In this process the student does not feel any agitation to clarify their doubts.
