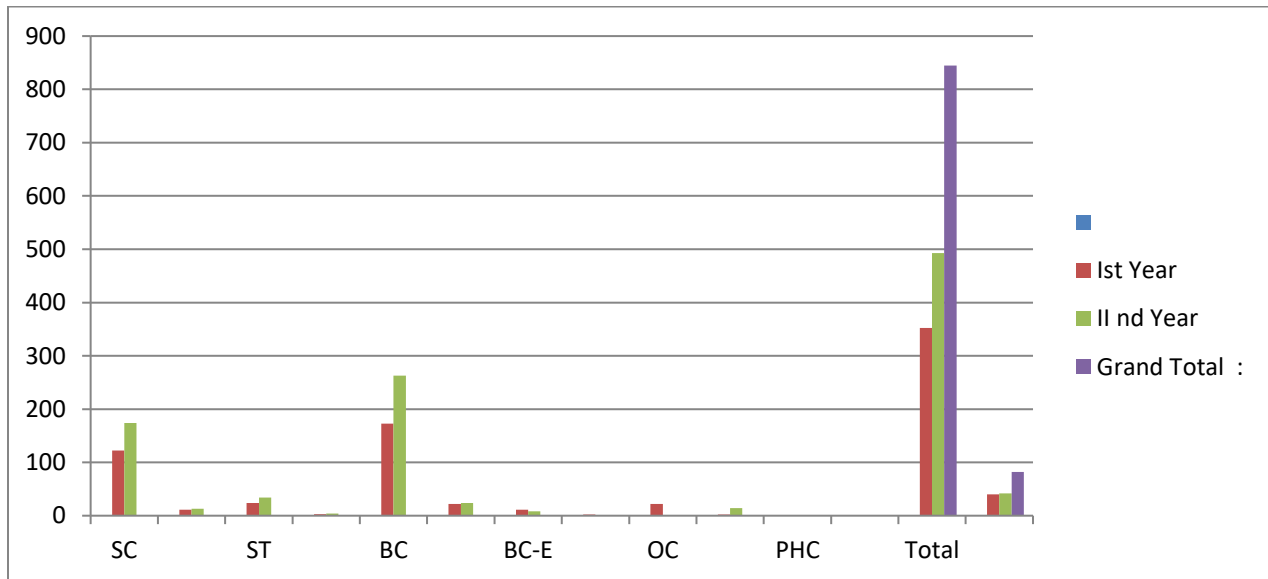

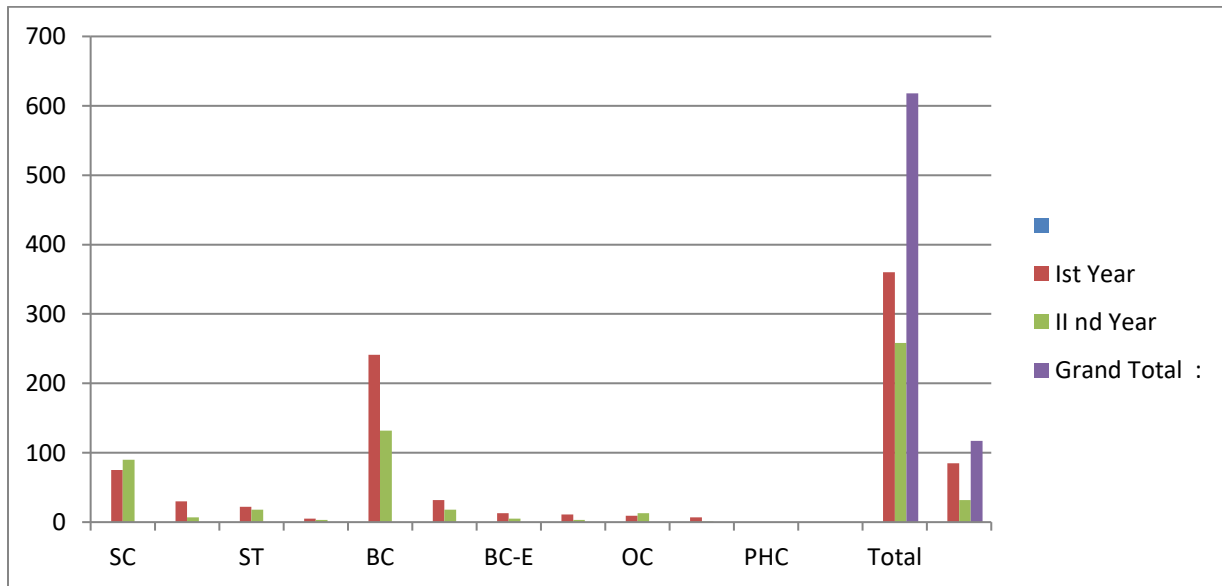
### 2014 -15 Students Category wise details Bar Chart

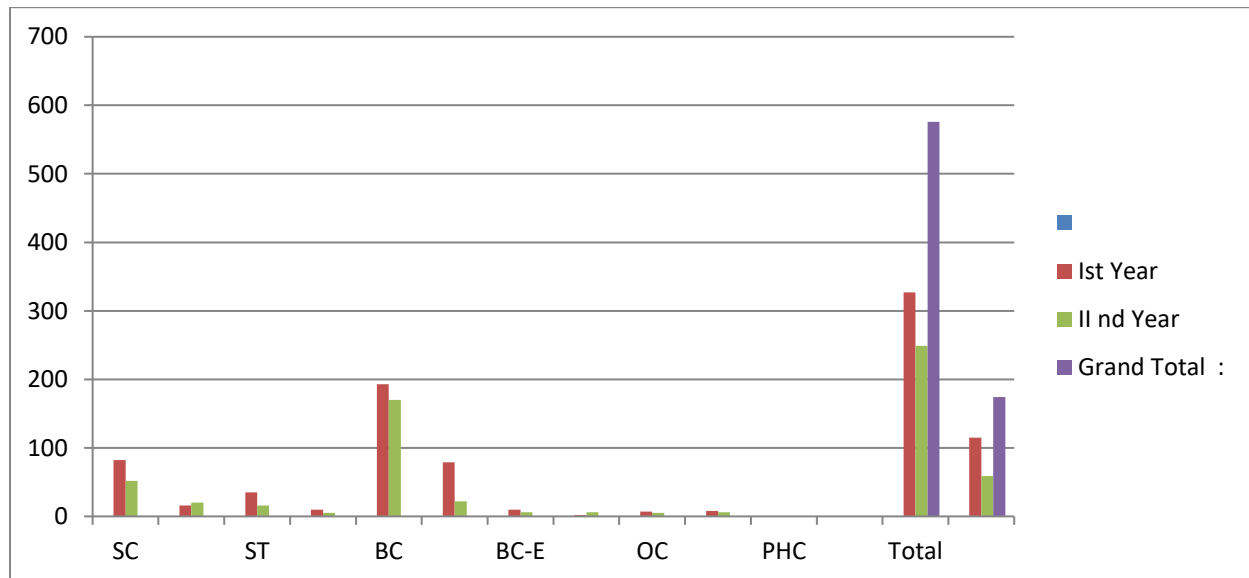
### 2015-16 Students Category wise details Bar Chart

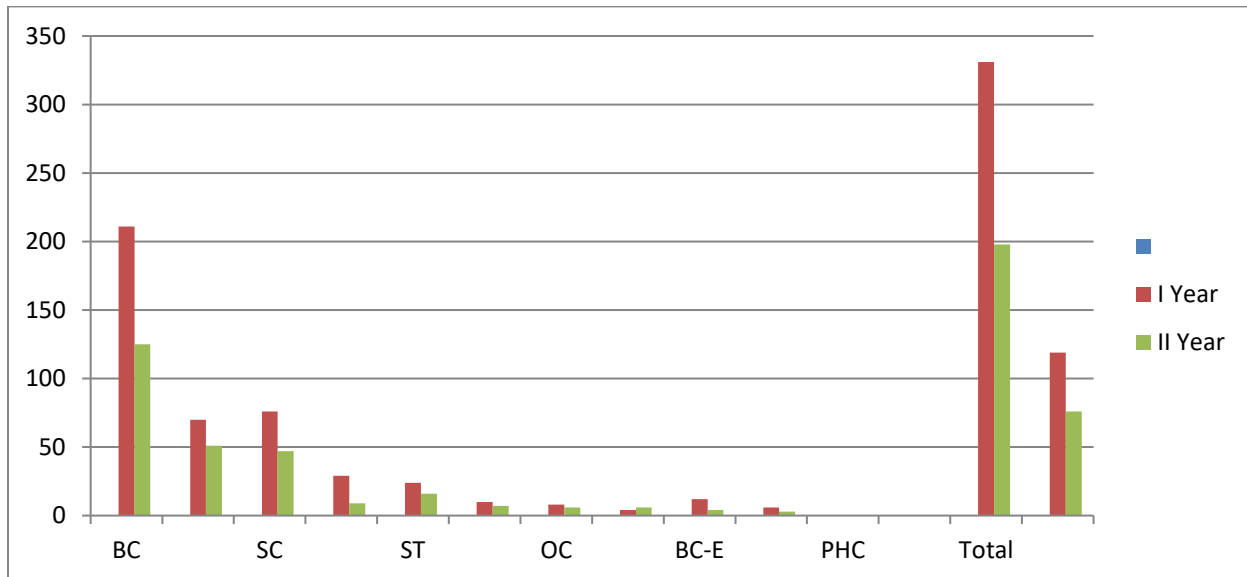
## 2016-17 Students Category wise details Bar Chart

## 2017-18 Students Category wise details Bar Chart

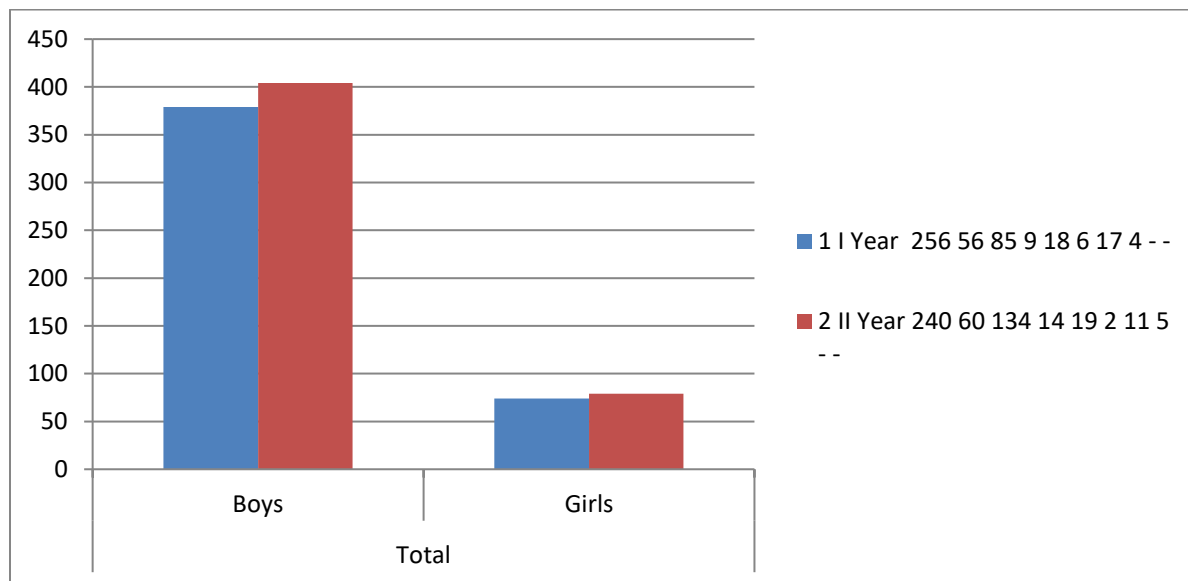

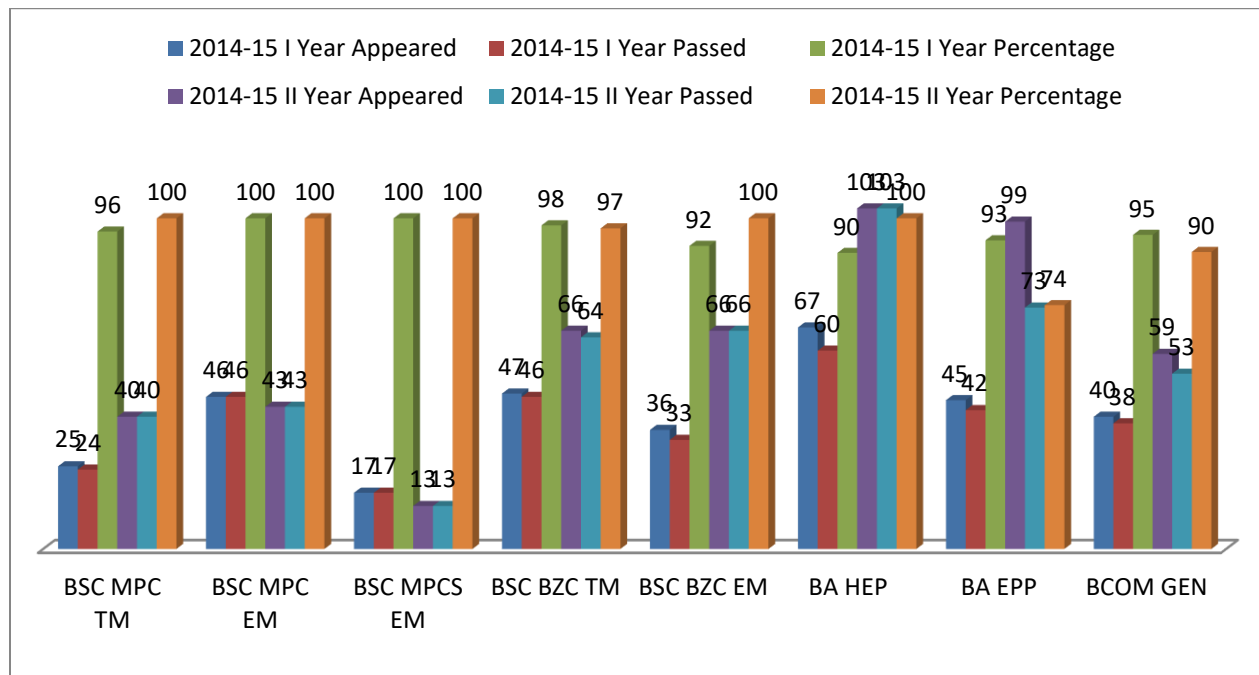

## 2018-19 Students Category wise details Bar Chart



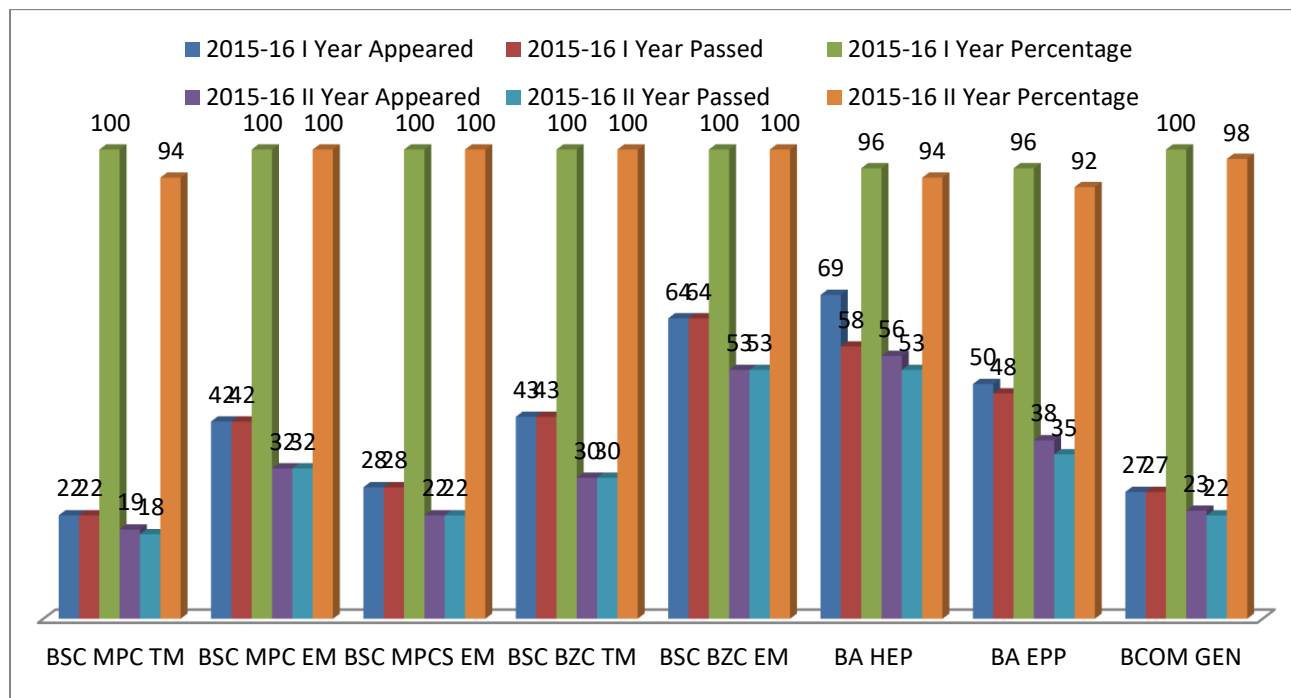
