

- > 20 attributes were given to the students for marking their opinions on teaching and learning to fill up the feedback forms.
- > 1823 samples were collected for the academic year 2020-21 from all courses offered.
- > 5 ratings were provided i.e. Excellent, Very good, Good, Average & Poor.
- ➤ In the analysis it is found that 0.86% students opted POOR, with regard to column no 7 i.e. Encouraging questions on the topic in the class and clearing doubts.
