




Soil Day



The Telangana government's flagship program Telangana Ku Haritha Haram (THH), taken up to enhance the green cover in the state is the biggest plantation drive in the country. Chief minister K Chandrasekhar Rao, started THH in July, 2015 with an intention to improve the forest coverage to 33% from the 24% in 2014.
