Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The year 2020-21 has brought a massive crisis in education system of HEI , the pandemic covid -19 has brought an unprecedented prices to the educational institutions specially H.E.I To reduce and reverse the long term negative effect, Educational Institutions implement learning recovery programs ,to protect educational system by building back better learning process. The HEI brick and mortar institutions, digitally transformed themselves to provide learning experiences to our UG students via online teaching ,following the instructions of CCE and almanac issued by the palamuru university. Transition from conventional to online teaching has been a challenge for teachers and students , irrespective of age and teaching experience , all the faculty made a shift to online teaching . In our Institution all teaching faculty following the instructions of head of the institution , used various teaching tools like Microsoft teams, Google meet , Zoom class, Vediolectures , you tube channel preparation etc .. such platforms adopted to complete the syllabus , online quiz, seminars , google forms framed for feedbacks during the year 2020-21.Teaching faculty delivered numerous online classes by preparing , intimating students through whatsapp groups, to complete the syllabus of ongoing semesters , for the academic year 2020-21, and ensured that the education of the students was uninterrupted .Unlike conventional class rooms, online classes made instructional strategies such as Time table for each courses , pre and post class activities Assignments and online examinations by using learning management system , All the teaching faculty used online pedagogies such as Team based learning (TBL), Discussion forums, use of open education resources , including SWAYAM , NPTEL courses to make class more effective . Lectures kept significant amount of effort in preparation of presentation in-class activities, more over there is a need to train teaching faculty on effective online teaching using online tools.
