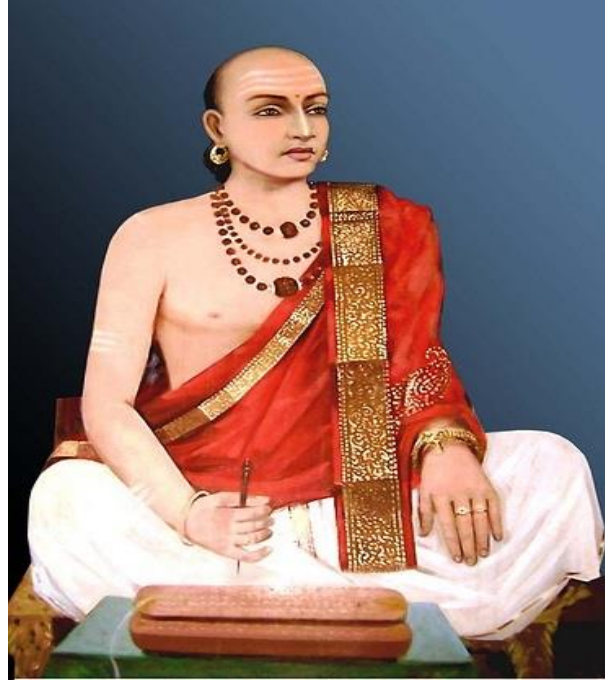

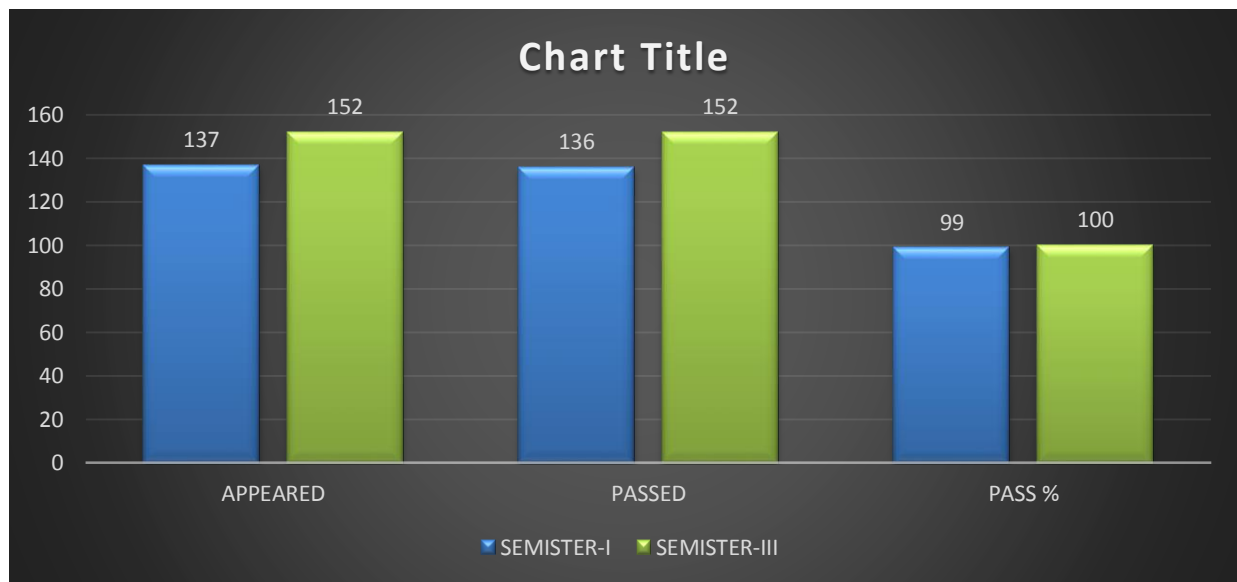

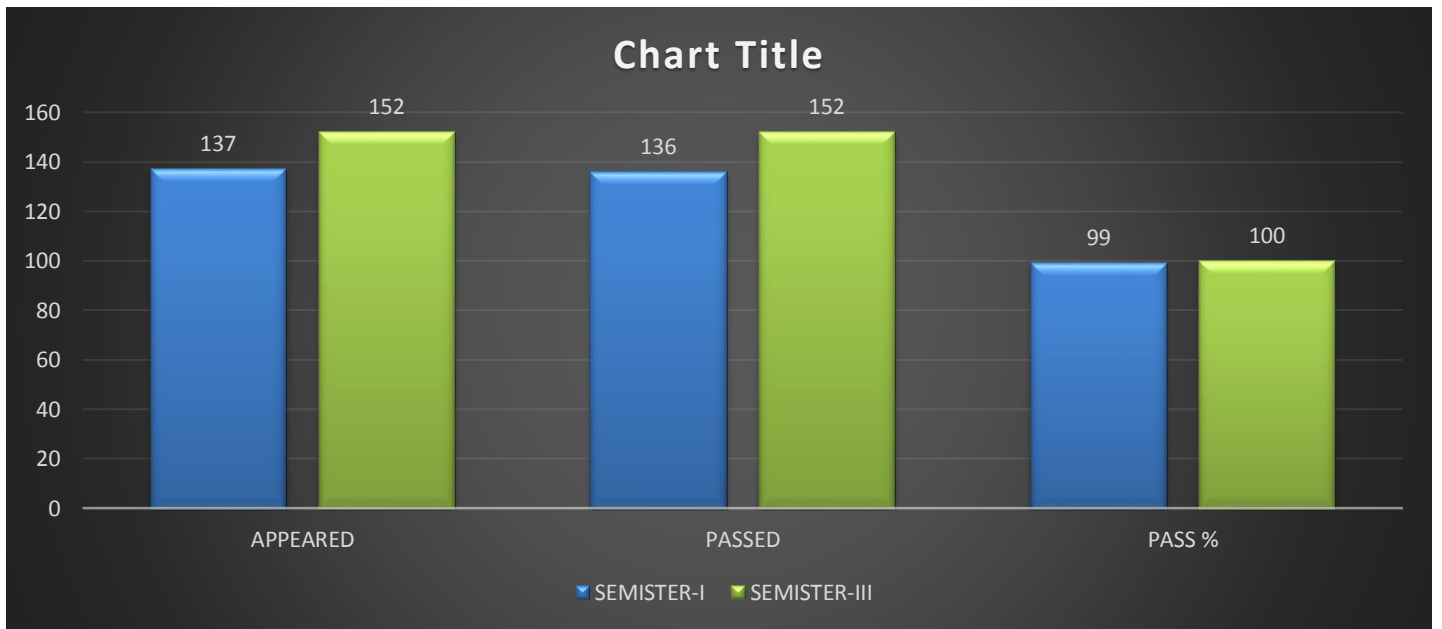
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

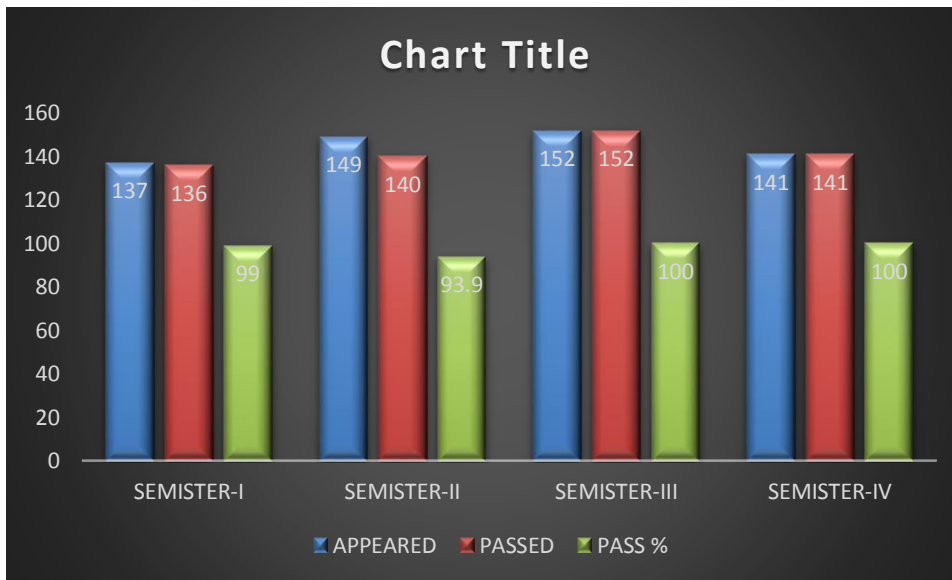

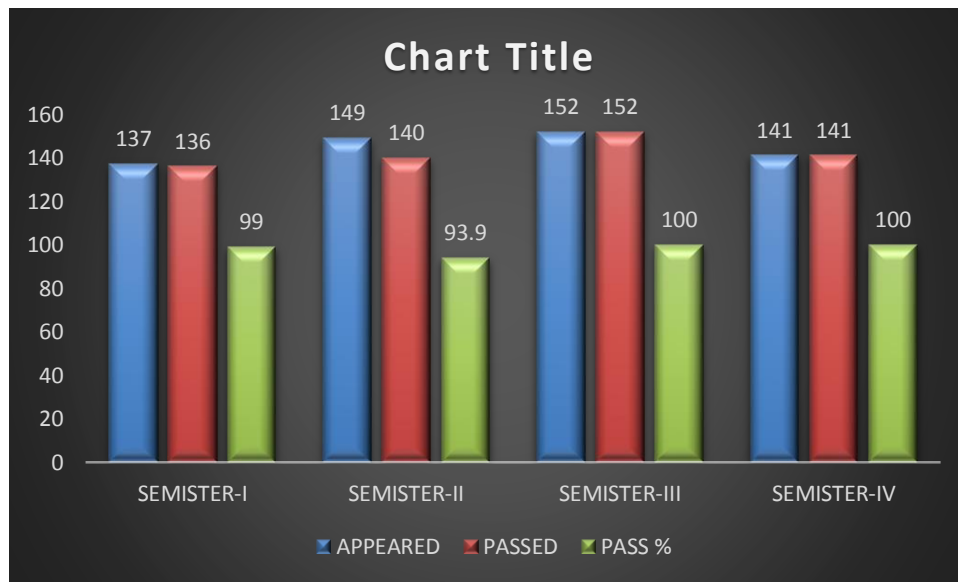
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

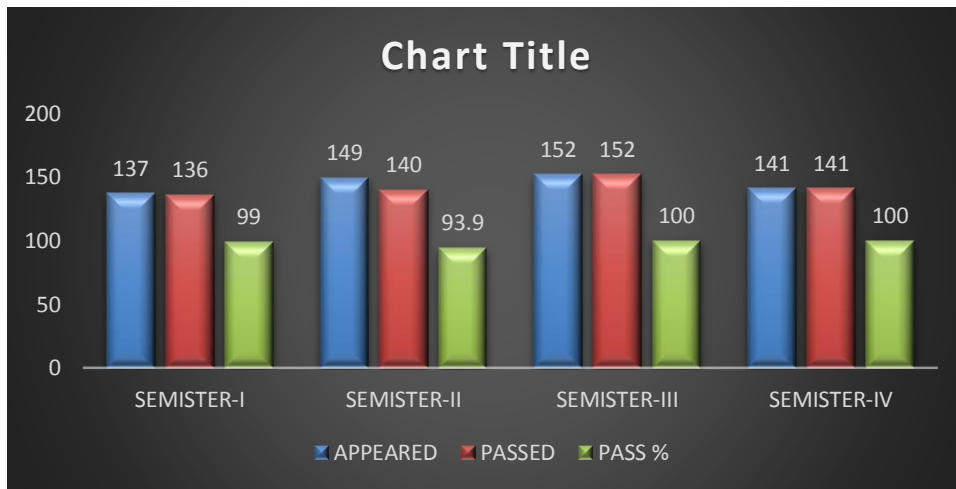
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

TEACHING LEARNING EVALUATION:

- Department of Telugu follows the syllabus and other curricular aspects framed by Palamuru University, Mahabubnagar.

TEACHING :

- The teaching involves mainly lecture, student centric and discussion methods supplemented by seminars.

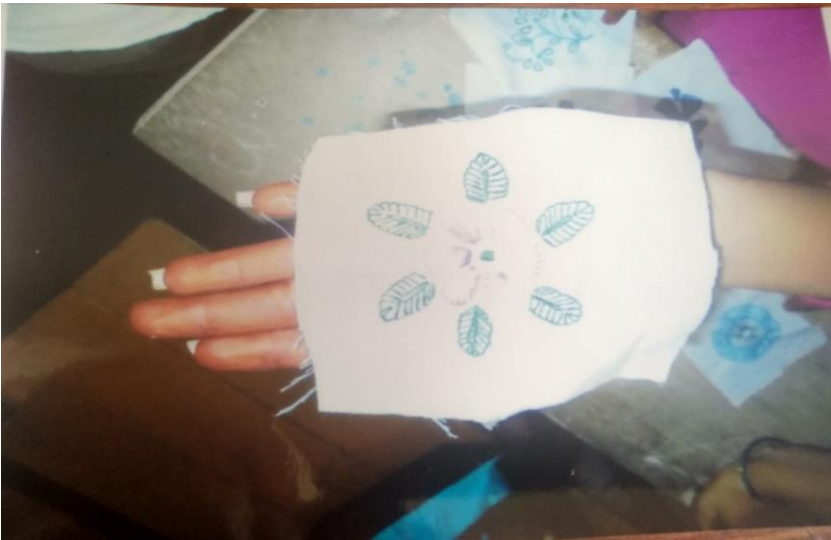

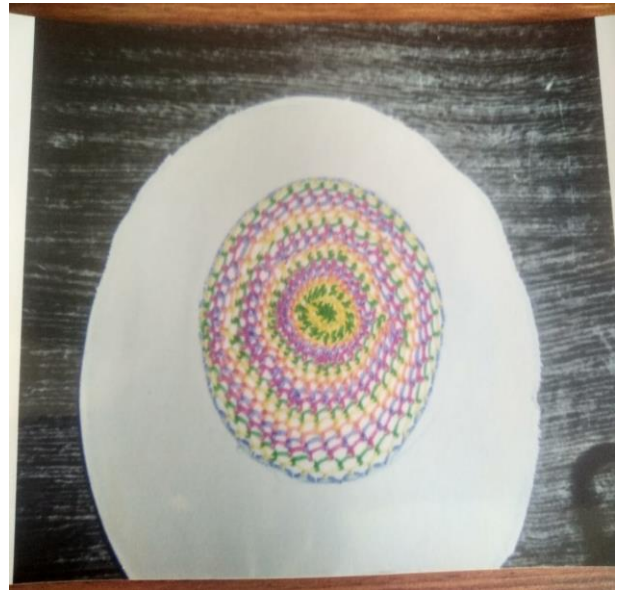


STUDENT SUPPORT AND PROGRESSION:

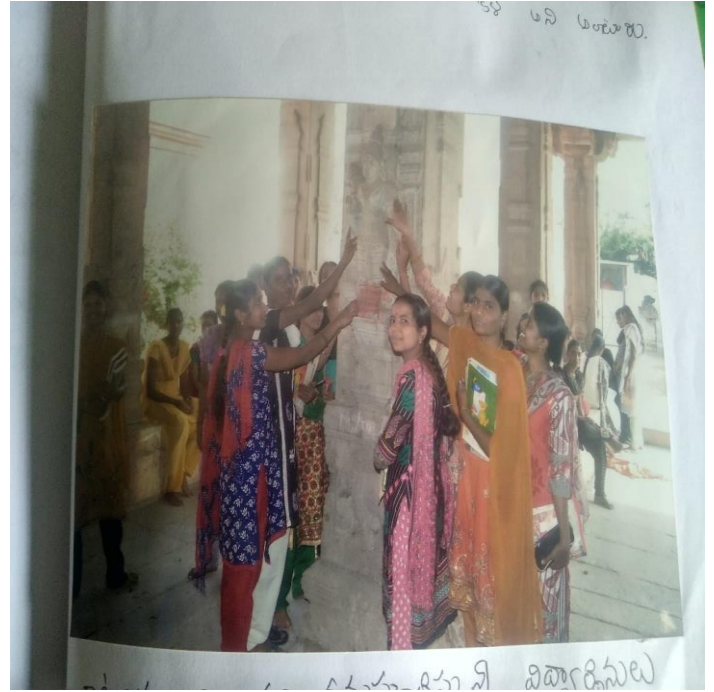

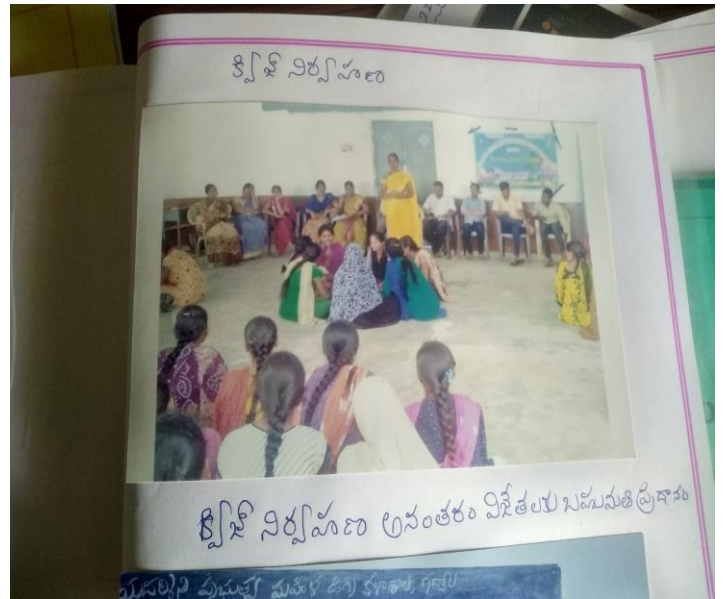
