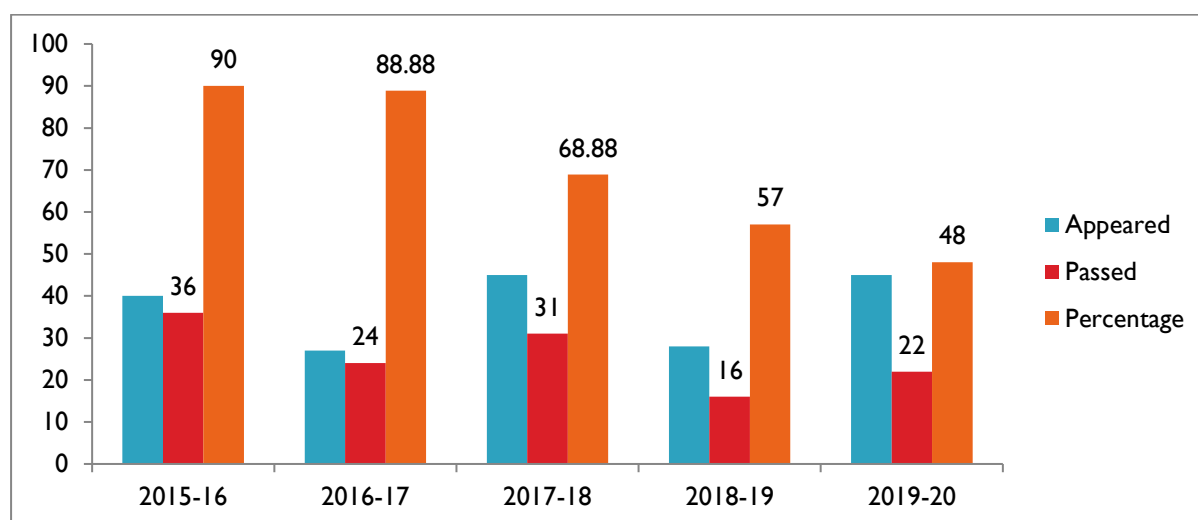
ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE DEPARTMENTS

CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Department of commerce is following the curriculum decided by the Board of Studies of O.U, Hyderabad. Some aspects of curricular activities are presented below.

TEACHING PRACTICES

A. **Annual Academic Plan:** In the beginning of the academic year the academic plan is distributed among the faculty members as per working days available during the academic year.

B. **Teaching Diaries:** Prescribed teaching diary is supplied by the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Hyderabad to record the Co-curricular and extra-curricular of the Faculty. It is a regular practice of faculty members to write daily academic activity on the same day. It is reviewed by the Incharge once in a week and once in a month by the Head of the Institution.

C. **Synopsis:** The faculty members prepare synopsis in their allotted subjects well in advance as per the units of the subjects. In the same way they solve the problems in the note books. Study material is distributed to the students after the completion of a unit/topic.

D. **Review of Syllabus:** The Incharge of the department is responsible for review of syllabus. On the basis of teaching diaries and annual curricular plan the Incharge reviews the syllabus and academic activities. The same information is mentioned in the minutes. If any faculty member is unable to complete the syllabus and other academic activities as per Annual Curricular Plan (ACP) he is instructed to cover the same in the subsequent months.

MODERN METHODS OF TEACHING:

To create interest and to motivate students Information and Communication Technology is being used by the faculty such as:

ADDITIONAL INPUTS

It is a regular feature of the department to collect information from news papers, Journals, magazines, internet and Websites. The information is affixed on notice board and the copies of the clippings are filed in the folder for future reference.

A. Modules: Teaching activity is not only confined to the text books but also giving comprehensive and vast information on certain topics. The faculty members prepare some modules on selected topics and thus provide additional inputs to the students on different aspects of the subject. This method provides more opportunities for the students to strengthen their concepts.

B. Field Visits: To gain practical knowledge and to learn subject practically the department organizes field visits. The following field visits have been arranged for B.Com students.

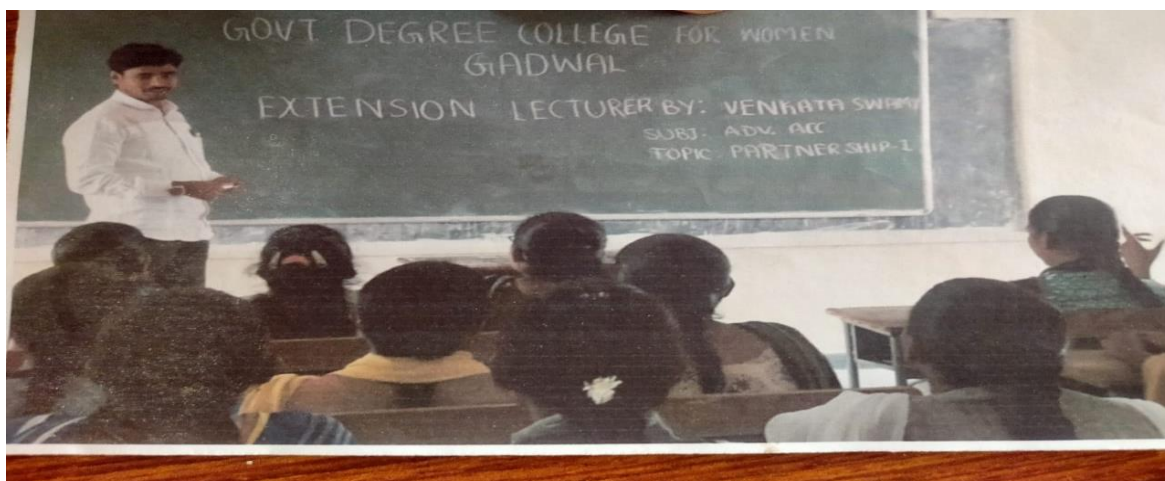

E. Guest Lectures: In addition to Extension Lectures, guest lectures are conducted by inviting famous personalities from field of Commerce, Business and Management. Some of the guest lecturers conducted by the department are:



F. Bridge Classes: The department of Commerce organises Bridge classes to the Non-Commerce students (MPC, BZC), who joined in the first year of commerce stream. In the beginning of the Academic Year the non-commerce students are identified at entry level and the staff conducts classes on basic aspects of commerce. These classes help them to acquaint with the subject.

G. Charts Methods: Charts are used at relevant places of the lesson. Most of them are prepared by the students with the guidance of the Lecturers. After the completion of lessons the charts are displayed at various places in the department.





TEACHING LEARNING AND EVALUATION

A. TEACHING: Department of Commerce is unique in teaching of commerce subject to the students of B.Com. The details of teaching practices are presented here.

1. **Lecture method:** It is a conventional and age old practice in teaching. It is adopted for the theory and problem subjects. In the lecture methods interaction of the students is solicited in between the subject teaching.
2. **Analytical presentation method:** In B.Com there are several subjects which are problem oriented. Every faculty member follows the method of analytical presentation, which gives more subject knowledge to the students and also increases their analytical thinking..
3. **Audio Video Methods:** The students of B.Com watch MANA TV programs as per schedule of SAP NET. After the lesson the concerned faculty member explains the main points of the lesson.
4. **Power Point Presentation:** All the faculty members of the department make Power Point Presentations on various syllabus related topics to the students. This helps in better understanding of the subject to the students and helps the faculty in explaining the topic in detail with live examples.

B. LEARNING: Learning is a quality practice in education. The department of commerce adopts feasible learning methods for sustaining the subject knowledge. Some learning methods adopted by the department are given below.

1. **Teaching Models:** For easy learning some models have been prepared by the students. These are displayed in the class room for easy learning. This specially helps the academically weak students to grasp the concepts easily and clearly.
2. **Quiz:** Subject quiz is conducted to the students. This method of learning enhances the subject knowledge and competitive spirit. This practice is giving more encouragement to fast and slow learners.

C. Evaluation: The department of commerce adopts academic activity in three dimension way. Teaching is first dimension, better learning process is second and evaluation is third dimension. The practices of evaluation are mentioned here under.

- 1. Assignment:** Every student should compulsorily submit assignment on given topic. The assignments are evaluated by the lecturers time to time. The same topic is given for the slip test.
- 2. Internal Assessment Tests:** As per the University schedule department of Commerce conducts the Internal Assessment tests twice in a semester.
- 3. Remedial Coaching:** After analyzing the unit test marks, the weak students are selected for separate coaching. Intensive coaching is given to them, running notes are also dictated in the separate class.

FACULTY IMPROVEMENT

The faculty members of the commerce department always try to develop their subject knowledge by adopting the advance academic learning through research. The details of faculty improvement activities are given below.

1. PURCHASING LATEST BOOKS: Every year M/S Pankaj Publications, Hyderabad, Jai Bharat Publications, Guntur, Kalyani Publishing house, Hyderabad give latest books to the staff members of the department. Faculty members also purchase subject books personally for better preparation. Every lecturer maintains personal Library.

INFRASTRUCTURE

- 1. Staff Room:** Separate Staff Room with attached toilet facilities is provided for the department. Facilities available include computer system with internet facility. The department has good ventilation, false ceiling and cyclic sheet flooring.
- 2. Departmental Library:** Department of commerce maintains a separate library for staff and students from 2008-09. About 40 books are purchased by the library. It possesses books on subjects like Accountancy, Management, Banking, Statistics, Business Economics, Business Law, Cost Accounting, FIT, C Language, Web Programming etc,. Books on personality development, GMA, Reasoning for competitive exams are also available.. The students are allowed to read in the allotted place of the department. The books are also issued to the students. Proper department library records are maintained.
- 3. Commerce Lab:** The department maintains a separate Commerce Lab in the department. In the lab separate sections are there for Negotiable Instruments, Banking Sector, Insurance Sector, Tax Sector and Corporate Sector. Other commerce and business related information is displayed for the benefit of the students. By this lab, the students will get practical knowledge on different sectors.
- 4. Class rooms:** There are three spacious class rooms for commerce with green boards with sufficient furniture. All the class rooms are ventilated and properly illuminated. Separate Computer Lab for Commerce department with 30 systems and Tally Programme Software is available. Separate commerce lab is established for providing practical application of the knowledge learned in the class room.

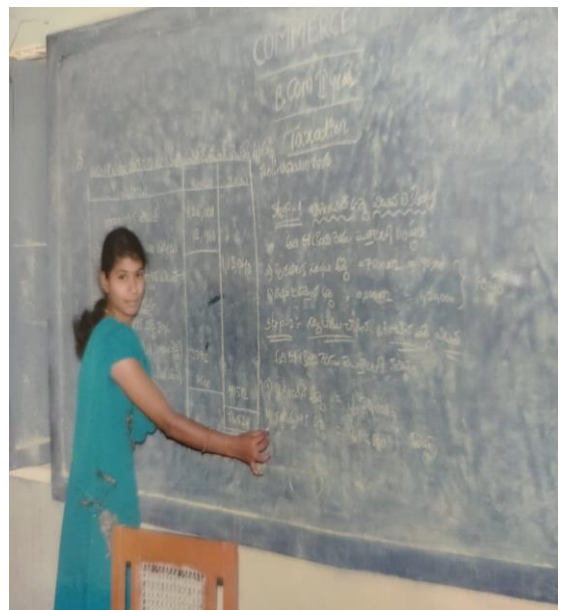
Student Support and Progression:

SUPPORT SERVICES

Department of commerce pays more attention towards support services to the students on par with academic activities. These services motivate the students' towards positive thinking and optimistic ideology towards their lives.

1. Ward counseling: Wide publicity is given for prompt attendance of students in accordance with the time table. In the opening meeting faculty advise the students to express their personal problems. A separate Performa is supplied to each student. The same will be reviewed by Incharge of the department. They make students to appear for competitive examinations. Students are guided to appear for group services, banking services, governance services, IT services. Books for the same are purchased and kept in the department library. They are also guided for placements.
