VISION During the decade of 1950's under the spells of great geographical historical and political changes occurred throughout the country and state of Hyderabad. Nizamabad district came into the direct fold and administration of the newly formed state government of Andhra Pradesh from November 1956 and in the same year the great philanthropists and leading residents of Nizamabad town felt the need of higher education to their children. The people of Nizamabad made generous contributions and put in strenuous efforts for the establishment of a degree college in Nizamabad and it became a reality in 1956.

Obviously the college came into existence in the year 1956 after the name of Girrajmal Aggarwal Beedi manufacturers in the Nizamabad Town they had donated a lumpsum Rs. 50,001 in those hardest times for the establishment of college. That's how the name "Girraj Arts College Nizamabad" was established under private management. The college has shown enormous and vast improvement with regard to the courses offered and in the strength of the students seeking admissions.

In 1956 at first the college was started with arts sections. The course "Fine Arts" - F.A. was introduced under the Osmania University Hyderabad curriculum and syllabus which was later converted as (PUC) pre-university course by the Osmania University Authorities. These courses were started in the Quilla premises in four sheds constructed for the Teaching and Learning activities at the foot of the hill "Quilla" in the western end area of Nizamabad Town.

MISSION : High discipline and active participation and punctuality were best seen in those days. The 3 year degree course for B.A. I year (1957-1958) B.A. II year (1958-59) and B.A. III year from (1959-60). The following courses commenced respectively and the course combinations offered were. B.A. Economics, Political Science, Public Administration (EPP) in English Medium. B.A. History, Political Science, Public Administration (HPP) in English Medium.

In the year 1959, Girraj Arts College Nizamabad was taken over by the Government of Andhra Pradesh even since 1957 the Department of Political Science was functioning in the college with the increasing strength and demands for Higher Education and to avail better and new facilities the college was shifted in February 1969 to the present building which was just completed at Dubba Road, Nizamabad.

In 1971 the Department of Political Science started the medium of instruction in Telugu as per the order and instruction of the Government of Andhra Pradesh. Like wise the Department started imparting education in Urdu Medium in the 1987.

Sri K.R. Santhanam Lecturer in Political Science an eminent scholar led the Department in the earlier year. The list of Lecturers with outstanding performance in the Department are as follows.

CURRICULUM : Upto 1993 the Department followed the syllabus designed by the Osmania University in 1993 switched over to the common core syllabus introduced throughout the state of Andhra Pradesh.

The Faculty of Department strictly adhered to the academic schedule as per the clearance of the Osmania university. Besides the syllabus the faculty members are enlightening the students on regional, national and international issues of importance and current Political Science in the country and state by referring the news papers, magazines, etc.

The Department Faculty members maintain academic attendance registers of the students, teaching dairies, synopsis of the contents in the syllabus study material for students. The Department prepared an account academic plan with Seminars, Debates as well as Quiz Programmes to have more systematic approach in imparting the subject.

The Department meeting are arranged at the beginning of the academic year and whenever necessary and discussed issues pertaining to academics cocurricula matters. The same is same is recorded in the minutes book of the Department.

DEPARTMENT LIBRARY : A reference section in the department is maintained with about 60 books pertaining to the subject.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES : To enrich the general knowledge of the students the department is maintaining paper clippings the model question paper and the material of the student. To strength the knowledge of the students department conducts unit- test, assignments, class seminars, debates on the subject in order to assess the performance of the students in the University examinations. The department prepares marks lists and maintained in the separate register.

BRIDGE COURSE CLASS : Non- Arts students join in the Arts group separate class taken for improve basic knowledge of concern subject before regular class.

REMEDICAL CLASS : Remedial classes are conducted for slow learners and blind after syllabus completion revision of the syllabus is dine.

RESULTS : After re-opening the college a Department meeting on results will be conducted and a review for discussing the steps to improve the results of the students in the University examinations. The percentage of the results in the subject and papers concerned marks are recorded and maintained separately in the registers.

EXTRA - CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES : The staff of the Department is actively participates in the colleges. The staff members are extending services in the field works. "Shramadan, Programmes, Personality Development, literary and cultural activities during the NSS regular and special camps activities.

DEPARTMENT EXTENSION SERVICES : The Faculty members of the Department are counselors in Political Science subject in Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University study centre at this college. All the Faculty members are handling PG & UG classes besides this centre for Distance Education of Osmania University by these Faculty members.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE DEPARTMENT : Soon after the college was accorded with the status of autonomous by Osmania University and the State Government. The Department planned to change the curriculum of the students and several efforts were taken by the Department to collect the students pertaining to the topic.

LEARNING RESOURCES AND MODERN TEACHING METHODS : Modern Teaching methods like Power Point Presentation, India Visual Methods MANATV Lesson and extension lecturers were use frequently.

PARTICIPATION OF THE TEACHERS IN ACADEMIC AND PERSONAL COUNSELLING OF THE STUDENTS : The teachers of the Department are involved in counseling the student of anti-ragging, medical matters, career guidance and personality developemnt. Each group is attached to one lecturer they also involve in the admission and examination process of the college actively. NSS camps in various places were utilized and extenstion lecturers were giving there to the students. The D.R.C. is also utilized to conduct extension Lecturers by the scholars in DOH Science lecturer of the other college were also invited to extent their knowledge.

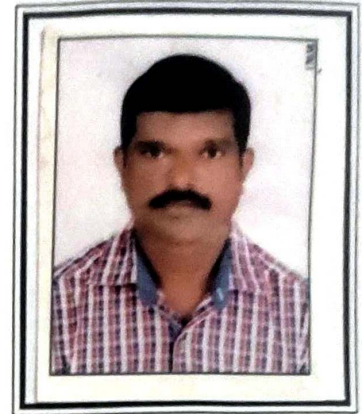
