ANNUAL REPORT OF THE COLLEGE 2020-2021

History of the college

Jadcherla, a noted village in Mahabubnagar district, situated in backward rural area. This is an historical place well-known for “Ranganadalayam” and chennakeshava” temples. Though this village is 85 Km away from Hyderabad, the state capital and 20 Km away from the district head quarters, Mahabubnagar it is a typical rural village with limited resources. In spite of this, there is a big scope for rapid change in tune with global trends as it is directly connected to the National Highway (44) and also linked to Railway network since 1916. Majority people of this region belong to marginalized communities of the society, there agricultural, commercial, professional, occupational and economic activities mostly depends upon vagaries of nature.

This college, named after the first CM of Hyderabad state, Sri Burgula Ramakrishna Rao, established in the year 1963 with 23 students in a private oil mill with humble contributions from local farmers and great efforts by business community. The man behind “The education committee of Jadcherla” was Sri. Kotha Keshavulu who was popularly known as “Jadcherla Gandhi”. That is he who dedicated his life for the development of this college and procured 15.17 acres of land worth crores of rupees. After separating the intermediate classes, exclusive degree college came into existence during the year 1984-85 and shifted to the existing present building in the year 1986-87.

Dr. BRR Govt. Degree College, Jadcherla, Mahabubnagar District, T.S. was established in the year 1963 by the Merchant’s Association under private management. The college was taken over by the Government in 1970 and named after the first Chief Minister of Hyderabad State. Later onwards in the year 2016-17 the government has sanctioned PG courses in Telugu, Chemistry, and Commerce. Thereafter the college is named as Dr. BRR Govt. Degree College.

The vision of the college is reflected in the mission statement which focuses on activities and future plans which ultimately lead to overall development of the students. The teachers prepare departmental action plans, curricular plans and extracurricular plans in which the vision of the college is reflected.

The college has conventional courses like B. A., B. Com. and B. Sc. with different combinations and the self financed courses like Microbiology, Bio – Technology and Computer Sciences. It has 17 departments. From this Academic Year 2016-17 PG Courses are also started in Chemistry, Telugu, and Commerce.

The process of admission is widely publicized through brochures and college websites. UG I st Year admissions procedure is carried out online. The ICT technology is fully utilized in the Teaching – Learning process by individual teachers. Few Lecturers are awaiting for the sanction of MRP from the UGC. Attending Orientation, Refresher programmes and National Seminars have become part and parcel of the enhancement of teaching skills. The Telugu Department organized a two day national seminar and many other programmes (like Orientation, workshop etc..)are organized to enlighten the knowledge of the students.

The Research Committee is constituted to give suggestions to the staff members to maintain consultations with other organizations, to reach Memorandum of Understandings with industries, to bring linkages, to apply for the Minor and Major Research Project works. Many student study projects are done from various departments.

Infrastructure Development During 2020-2021:

- ✓ Rs.200 lakhs Grants were released Jointly by RUSA(MHRD) and Government of Telangana in the year 2016-17.
- ✓ New additional class rooms and auditorium are constructed and renovated the electric supply system in the college with Rs 140 lakhs and purchased Computer Chairs, Tables, Desktops, Dualdesks, Storage items almirahs and racks with Rs 40 lakhs.
- ✓ The works under RUSA Scheme are completed and settled in academic year 2019-20 and the class rooms are in use for regular teaching.
- ✓ Rs 25 lakhs are released in 2019 byUGC for completion of the Indoor stadium, in addition to it permission is accorded from the CCE to utilise Rs 15 lakhs as matching grant for completion of the indoor stadium works which were estimated by EWIDC as per the current rate contract. But the work is not yet initiated by EWIDC, Mahbubnagar even though the funds are accumulated as per the re estimation.

- ✓ CCE has accorded permissions to the Proposals with estimations prepared by EE, EWIDEC were submitted in 2019-20 for construction of Toilet Blocks (separately for Boys, Girls, Lady staff members and Gents), Construction of compound wall Providing water facility to garden and college needs.
- ✓ Permission is accorded by the CCE, Hyderabad to utilize an amount of Rs 100 lakhs from the accumulated funds of the college for these works. The construction work is in progress part one payment of Rs 21,73,757 is done to EWDIDC- Mahabubnagar.
- ✓ Rs 50 lakhs are sanctioned by honorable Chief Minister of Telangana for development of Botanical Garden in the premises of the College and the work is in progress.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES DURING 2020-21:

- The English department has organized a certificate course on Creative Writing for the academic year . The total students enrolled for the course stands at forty . The Course is intended to develop creative thinking abilities of the students which is required to become competent authors in their lives .
- A National Webinar has been conducted on 24 February , 2021 , the title of the webinar was The Emergence of Multiculturalism in English Language Teaching in which key note speakers from Osmania University and Palamuru University presented their views on imparting instruction on language teaching in the scenario of multicultural set up .
- The Telugu Department has conducted bhathukamma cultural program .
- The Faculty of Social Sciences has celebrated constitution day on 25 November , 2021 in order to educate the student community on the spirit and vitality of Indian Constitution . During the celebrations an Essay Writing competition and Elocution was conducted to intensify the learning the importance of the day . The department has also organized a virtual field trip to Osmania University on 9th June , 2021 for the students of the college to inculcate interest for higher studies .
- The Department of Chemistry as successfully organized World Ozone Day on 16th September , 2021 to highlight the importance of clean and pure environment to protect ozone layer and to save humanity from the impending danger .
- The Department of Zoology organized one day National Webinar on 5 June , 2021 and Invited Dr. J Venkatesh Rao , Assistant Professor from Osmania University to present a talk Cancer Biology . The Importance of Yoga is organized on 21 " June , 2021 which is also observed as International Yoga Day
