

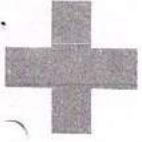

YOUTH RED CROSS

The Fundamental Principles of Red Cross viz., Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary Service, Unity and Universality are to be inculcated among youth to serve the society. Those who are below 18 years of age and studying up to 12th standard in the Schools/Junior Colleges may join in Junior Red Cross and between 18 to 30 year of age who are studying in colleges may join as Youth Red Cross Members.

The Junior and Youth Programmes help the Indian Red Cross Society to disseminate the Fundamental Principles of the Red Cross Movement through:-

- International Humanitarian Law
- The protection of health and Life
- Community Service
- Promotion of National and International Friendship and Understanding by using the International links of the movement.

Therefore the District Branches are requested to have coordination with District Educational Officers, Regional Joint Directors, Principals of respective Business Schools, Engineering Colleges, Polytechnic Colleges, ITI's Junior Red Cross and Youth Red Cross and to compile the data base of members of the Youth Groups at District Level for organizing the programmes.

The District Junior and Youth Red Cross Sub-committee may be formed consisting of a chairperson and up to 11 members, with power to co-opt representatives of relevant youth involving organizations.

- District Educational Officer of the District
- District Medical and Health Officer
- Members of teaching staff two from colleges (Rotation for two academic years)
- Two college students (one male, one Female) (Rotation for 1 academic year)

This committee shall be appointed by District collector and the president of the District Branch.

A Suitable teacher should be nominated to act as counsellor to the Junior Red Cross Schools. A Lecturer / Reader-in charge of NCC/NSS who is enthusiastic and committed to the service should be appointed as the Youth Red Cross Programme Officer of the College. Preference should be given to those lecturers who have received programme officers training, training in First Aid, Disaster Management, Road Safety, Hygiene etc., or have organized Blood Donation and Leadership camps.

A group can be established with 20 members and not exceeding (50) students who are committed to the service of needy and distress. Each group will identify a peer educator. There can be several such groups within an institution.

- One programme officer/counsellor for four such groups to be identified.
- The programme officer or counsellor of the group will administer the pledge to the members of the groups.
- *"I, [SAY NAME], a member of the Indian Junior/ Youth Red Cross, pledge to serve in the promotion of health, the relief of suffering and in the building a culture of peace without any form of discrimination and to hold in friendship the boys and girls of all nations. I also pledge to uphold the Fundamental Principles of the Red Cross, humanity, impartiality, neutrality, independence, unity, universality, voluntary service.*
- The president of the group will be the Principal /Head Master of the institution or his nominee.

The groups formed will carry out the activities of the Red Cross as per the principles of the movement/ the programmes given by the District Branch. The president will nominate a member on an annual basis for awards and international/ national and state level activities. Each group will select its own activities according to its own capacity and local needs.

- The promotion of health
- Health activities, HIV, and AIDS campaigns, Accident prevention and First Aid.
- Service to the community.
- Community based social welfare activities environmental activities disaster preparedness programmes.
- Informing Youth members and others the role and the responsibilities of the Red Cross and encourage them to contribute.
- Dissemination of information about the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, its Fundamental Principles, four Geneva Conventions, and emblem awareness use and the promotion of understanding of International Humanitarian Law (IHL).

Role and responsibilities of School/ College Body

- Enrolment register of volunteers
- Membership fund management and remittance as per orders
- Income & expenditure register
- Stock Register
- Attendance register of volunteers
- Register of project activity reports
- Blood Donors directory
- Conduct community reach programme and maintain expenditure.

The annual membership fee for the institution as well as Junior/Youth Red Cross member shall be as follows.

- *Junior Red Cross Membership fee Rs.20/- and Youth Red Cross Membership fee Rs.40/- Respectively*
- *Institution Membership fee for the Schools (VII to X Class). R.300/-*
- *Institution Membership fee for the all Colleges Rs.400/-.*

The District Branches should retain 70% of the Institution Membership fee and 15% to the State Headquarters and 15% to the National Headquarters. Out of the individual membership 85% be retained with the School and College / university; and 15% shall be sent to District Branch. The amount retained can be spent for the activities.

The District Branches are also requested to encourage IRCS Junior/ Youth groups to conduct fund raising ideas such as Holiday gift wrap service, charity shows, Car wash, Music Charity show, etc., and provide financial assistance to weak groups in addition to following: -

- 1) To conduct seminars, workshops/ cultural programmes at District level including First Aid Training.
- 2) Make available IEC Material to the Junior/ Youth groups.
- 3) To prepare annual calendar of events / activities and function according.
- 4) The District Junior/ youth Sub-Committee meeting will be held on monthly basis on a fixed date and venue with agenda to increase activities of the Red Cross.
- 5) Inter -School/College camps in the same District.
- 6) A separate Junior/ Youth Red Cross Budget be drawn up in the accounts of District Branches.
- 7) To arrange visits to Anganwadi, Orphanage/ School for the blind, institutions for the physically handicapped with gifts
- 8) Special Service programmes / camps during local fairs and festivals.

Red Cross offers membership not only to those schools and colleges but also to the Youth Professionals and Youth who have completed studies. The District Branches are requested to contact youth coordinators in the District to enrol the Youth as members in order to inculcate principles of Red Cross so as to make them to serve the community as and when necessary as their basic duty. I request District Branch to put their concerted efforts in forming the Junior/ Youth Red Cross in Schools/ Colleges/ Universities in the District and make his programme a successful one.

It is also informed the JRC/YRC Groups in schools and colleges endeavours to teach students personal health rules, community health and make them to bestow a keen interest in people's welfare and thereby making them useful citizens. The Junior Red Cross/ Youth Red Cross Conducts Training camps in the country and deputed juniors / Youth abroad on an exchange programme.
