
A general meeting was convened by the members of Grievance Redressal Committee to solve the complaints from the students


A general meeting was convened by the members of Grievance Redressal Committee to solve the complaints received from the students







The committee agreed to look into Sanitation / Rest-room cleanliness of the girls and look into the grievances regarding it.


