FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2020-2021

Our college believes that the performance of the college is fundamentally dependent on effective learning outcomes. Feedback Mechanism is an essential and effective tool to know whether the college is delivering on imparting quality education. To impart Quality Education, IQAC developed a Feedback Mechanism and framework for its analysis. There is a formal Procedure for collecting and evaluating feedback. Feedback Forms are circulated to all the teachers at the end of academic year /each semester. Duly filled feedback forms are to be forwarded to the IQAC for analysis.

The feedback collected is based on 10 questions which include Communication, teamwork, sharing of responsibility, Dependence in terms of attendance and punctuality, participation in meetings, sharing of knowledge with co-teachers, leadership qualities, etc. and is analyzed on a five-point scale ranging from excellent to satisfactory. The feedback is taken from 5 teachers for each faculty and is analyzed. 91 to 100% is given excellent, 81 to 90 is very good and 71 to 80 is good.

The analysis represents 90-99% of the teachers have given excellent overall opinion for the other teachers and only 5-10% teachers have given very Good with 81 to 19%. The Feedback analysis report is forwarded to the Principal for further process and action.

Following is the attached percentage wise analysis of the options of the questions asked to the teachers.
