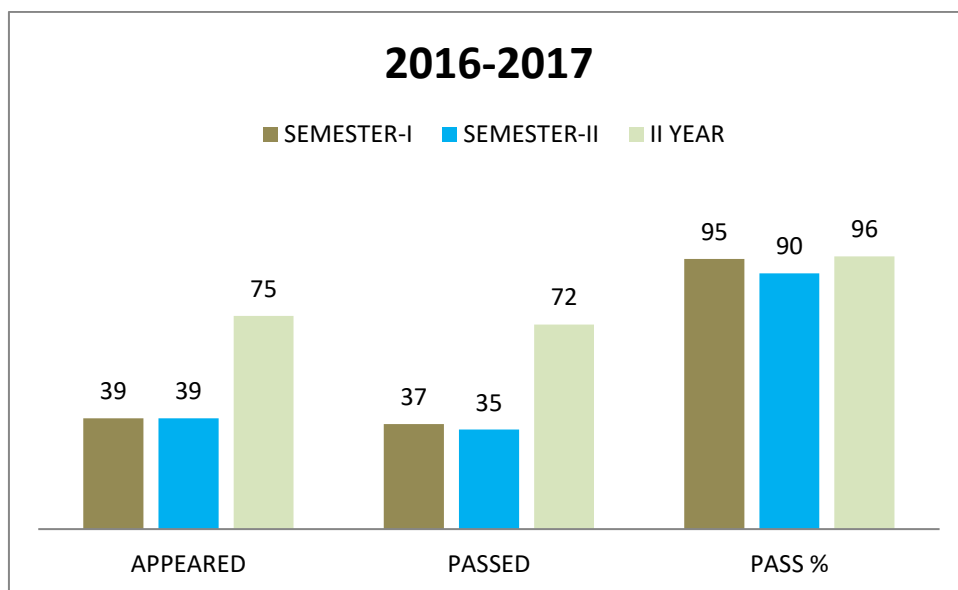

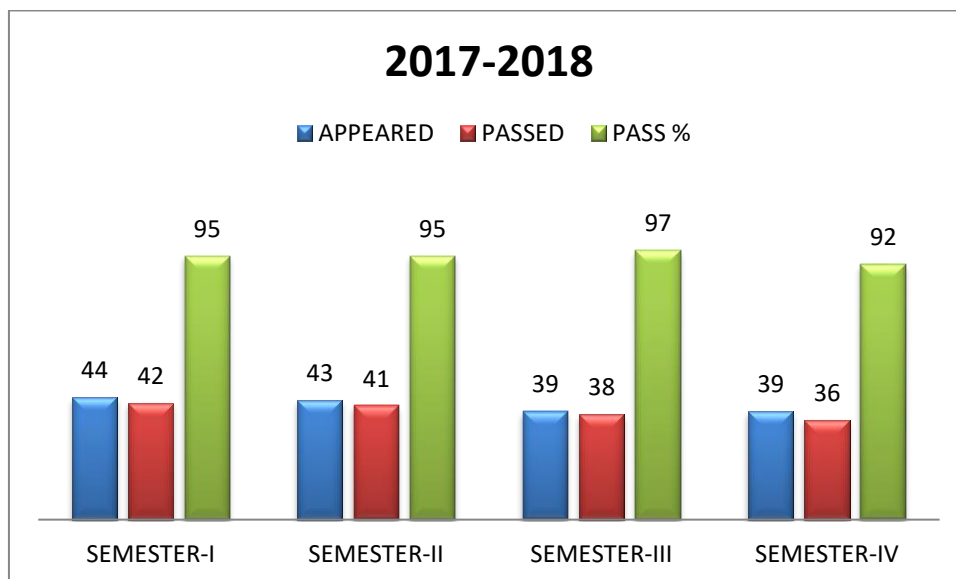
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

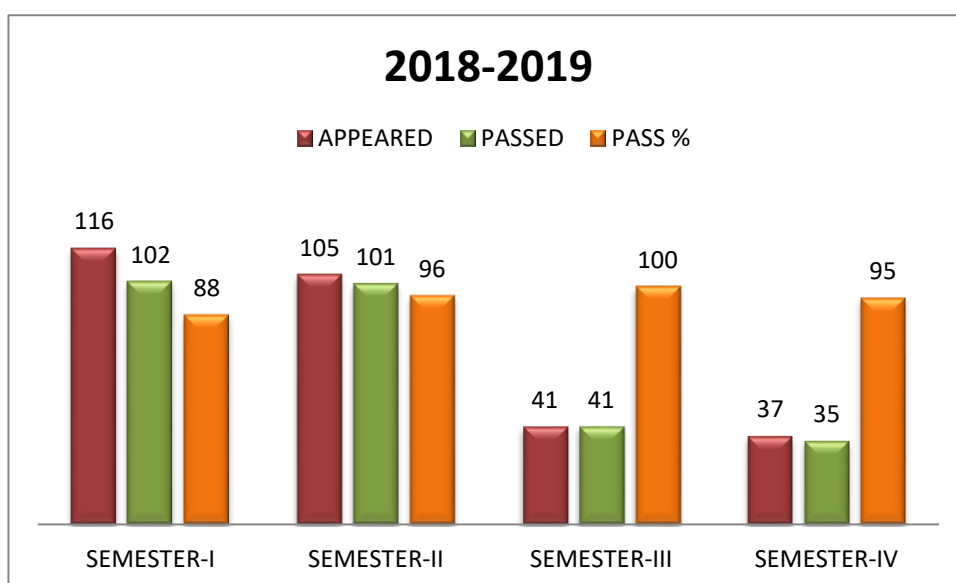
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

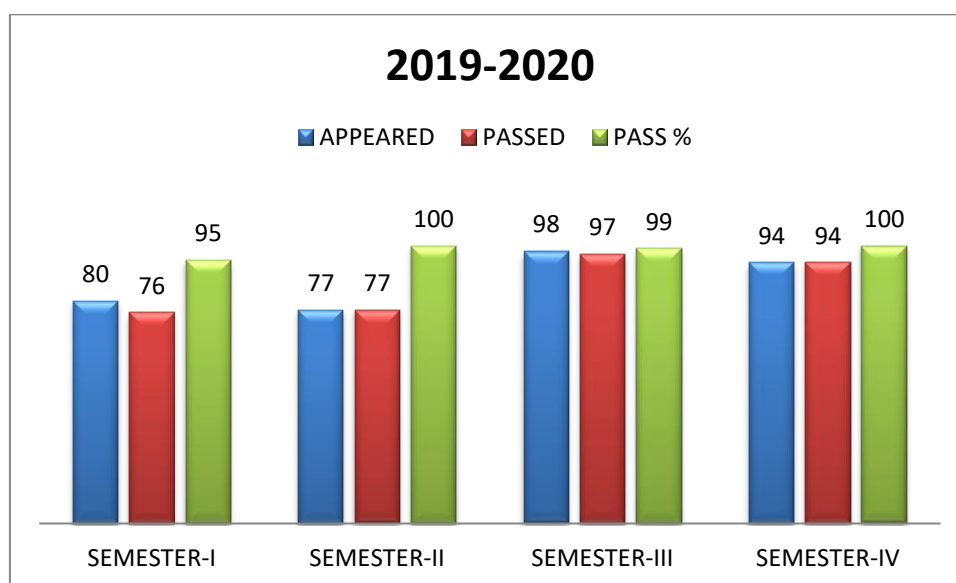
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

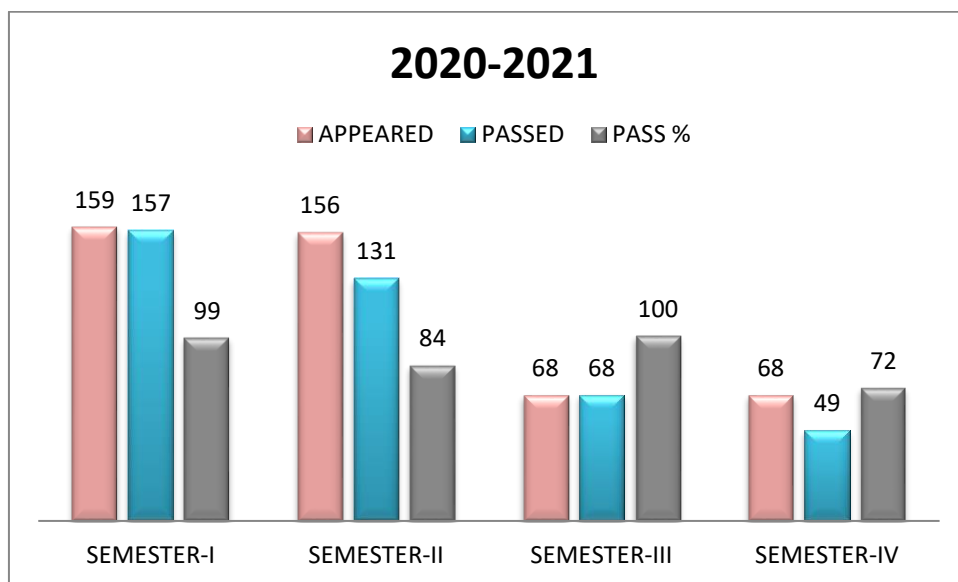
GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION

Initially the syllabus for Telugu was adopted from the syllabus of Kakatiya University , Warangal . Later on it has been thoroughly revised by universities and common core syllabus was introduced as Second Language (Telugu) for I II & III Year of under graduated courses.

Staff members maintain regularly teaching diaries, synopsis and prepare annual academic planning at the beginning, scrutinized by the Principal.

The staff has been constantly attending Refresher and Orientation courses for updating their knowledge in view of changes that have been taking place in the syllabi. Besides the members of the staff are attending enthusiastically Seminars, Conferences regularly.

Department meetings are arranged regularly to discuss various issues pertaining to academic as well as administrative matters. The minutes are recorded in Minutes book of the department. Time -Table is framed and workload is distributed among the staff as per the Time-Table.
