Message by Excise Superintendent

He asks the students not to use any drugs as they are harmful to their bodies. Drug addiction can cause chronic brain disease and may lead to death. Drug addicts are prone to mental problems, they feel energetic only after consumption of drugs which is not good for our body. He also talked about de-addiction programs and de-addiction centres run by Government.
