# Report of the UGC sponsored National Seminar on Capacity building of Girls and Prevention of Atrocities

# 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> January 2015

A two day UGC sponsored national seminar on "Capacity building of girls and prevention of Atrocities on Women" was organized by Department of Zoology and women Empowerment Cell of S.R.A.S. Govt. Degree College, Kothagudem, Khammam (Dist.), Telangana on January 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> 2015. The seminar began with the inaugural session. Sri J. Abraham, Lecturer in History invited the guests on to the Dias. Lighting of the lamp was performed by Sri R. Vankati, Principal of the college, Smt. K. Padmavathi, special officer for the higher education, Smt. Kalyani Vidmahe, Professor, Telugu Department, Kakatiya University, Sri Vijayendhar Rao, C.P.D.C. Chairman, Sri. Vaysya naik, Village sarpanch, Smt. P. Sowbhagyalakshmi, Convener of the seminar. Sri R. Venkati, Principal and chair-person of the meeting welcomed all the resource persons, dignitaries, delegates and participants. He expressed his immense pleasure to announce that the college is conducting the second national seminar inthis academic year. He made a mention of the requirements of the college which has been catering to the needs of S.C., S.T and B.C students since 50 years. After the initial remarks of the principal a souvenir on the seminar was released and copies were distributed to the guests. Smt. P. Sowbhagyalakshmi, convener of the seminar gave a brief introduction about the activities of the Women Empowerment Cell of the college. She expressed her hope that the present seminar, keeping in view the growing number of atrocities on women day by day would help in finding solutions to the problem through interaction and sharing of ideas. She explained that all the six technical sessions will help the girls to build their capacity and to fight against the atrocities on women.

The guest of honor, Sri Vijayendhar Rao, C.P.D.C on chairman commended the principal and the staff for obtaining a good grade to the college in NAAC re-accrediation. In this inspiring speech, he ascribed the present status of women to the shift towards patriarchal domination from the previous matrichal domination. He said that women should know their rights. He instead on the importance courage to the girls by giving as interesting example. He said that only goats and sheep were slaughtered in the sacrifices we offer but not the ions and tigers. Another guest of honor Sri Vaysya naik, village sarpanch expressed his gratitude to the national seminar. He made a mention of the greatest women of our country like Smt. Indiar Gandhi and Smt. Pratibha Patel.

The chief guest of the session Smt. K. Padmavathi said that it was a great pleasure to be with the august gathering and share her ideas on the issues of women. In her speech, she explained the steps taken by the present Telangana government to protect the right of the women. She expressed her pleasure to announce that gender studies is going to be the compulsory subject for the students of Telangana in the near future. In her address, she encouraged the girls to stop

sexual harassment at work place. She strongly advocated the need for internal complaints committee in every institution to solve the grievances of girls.

Professor, Katyayani Vidmahe, Department of Telugu, Kakatiya University in her key note address recollected her memories of long fought battle of women's problems and rights since 1982. She said that the teacher had a larger role in the society apart from teaching. She strongly objected the restrictions imposed on girls in dressing, manners, etc. she opines that for a woman every day is a human rights day. There is a strong need to bring changes in the behavior of women. She conducted her speech with a small anecdote "What is my mane" written by P. Sathyavathi. Thaus the inaugural session came to close with the vote of thanks proposed by Sri J. Abraham.

Technical session one starts at 2.30 PM. The sub theme of the session was "Social Status". This session was chaired by Prof. Kathyayani Vidmahe, Department of Telugu, Kakatiya University and Co-chaired by Dr. B. Madhuri, Head Department of Telugu, S.R. & B.G.N.R College Khammam. Dr. Katyayani in her address, emphasizes the need for the women to come out of the four walls of the house and participate in all the social activities equally with men in the society. They must take their share in the development. According to her the first step to get social status was education. Dr. B. Madhuri, the Co-chair person said that on one side women are going forward with Racket speed competition with men in all the fields. But, on the other side they are victims of atrocities. Now, there is a need for creating an atmosphere in which the women can live in a safe and secured manner. Three papers were submitted in the session.

The sub theme for the technical session. It was "Psychological Strength". The chair person for the session was Dr. K. Sreedevi, Dept. of Political Science, A.S.M. College for women, Warangal. Dr. ...... Sahithya, Lecturer in political science, S.K.P. Govt. Degree College, Gunthakal was the Co-chair person for this session Dr. Sreedevi said that women have become the victim of the gender discrimination for a long time. She had denied active participation in all the fields. To improve the psychological strength of women a lot need to be done. Attitudinal change, confidence building measures skill development programs and the support of the government through different schemes are the steps to be taken. Three papers were presented in this session by the participants.

"Legal Awareness" was the sub theme of the technical session Prof. B. Vijaya Laxmi, University College of Law (Rtd.), K.U was the chair person for this session. B. Kumar Swamy, Lecturer in History acted as the co-chair person. Prof. Vijaya Laxmi observed that peaceful co-existence, sharing equal response by both the wife and the husband are essential principals for successful family life. She advised the participants to use law in extreme cases only but not for every simple reason in family matters. She said that legal awareness would help in the capacity building of women. Sri B. Kumar Swamy explained the historical perspective of women emancipation movement. The role of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar in the introduction of hindu code bill and his contribution for the welfare of women was discussed. One paper was presented in the session Sri V. Narasimha Kumar, Associate Professor, S.R. Govt. Arts & Science College, Kothagudem spoke at length on need for capacity building of girls and the immediate need to address the problem of "malnutrition in girls".

The second day of the seminar began with technical session IV on the sub theme "Physical strength" Dr. Jhansi Laxmi, famous gynecologist acted as the chair person for this session. Dr. V.V. Ramana, Head of Department of Botany, Singareni Womens Degree College was the co-chair person of this session. Dr. Jhansi Laxmi in her speech explained in a detailed manner the importance of physical strength and the ways to build up physical strength in girls through nutritious food. She expressed her concern about the girls working as daily wage laborers instead of going to schools. She suggested the SHG and Anganwadi to take active steps in girl education. Dr. V.V. Ramana said that physical strength helps us to gain confidence and confidence in our capacity leads to empowerment. One paper was presented in this session.

The fifth session with the sub theme "Economic Development" was chaired by Smt. M.C. Sahitya lecturer in Political Science, S.K.P. Govt. Degree College, Gunthakal.
