The grandson of Maharani Adilakshmi Devamma as donated the entire fort and partial building to the degree college. Hence the college is on the name of grandmother Maharani Adilalakshmi Devamma who was the ruler of this princely state. Like that, M.A.L.D Govt. Degree College came into existence in 1960. The political Science department was started in this College for the first time in 1960. With the student strength of 30 in B A EPP course. At first the college was comprised of PUC and Degree courses as composite college. At the time the medium of instruction was in English medium only. In 1960-70 all the subjects began to teach in Telugu medium only. The college was bifurcated into Govt. Junior College Gadwal and MALD Govt Degree College Gadwal in August 1996.

The Degree College offered sciences, arts, and commerce and computer courses in the Degree level. The political science department has two courses namely HEP, EPP, in Telugu and English Medium the total strength of the students in the first, second, third year classes is 1100. The strength of lecturers in the department is 05 only. 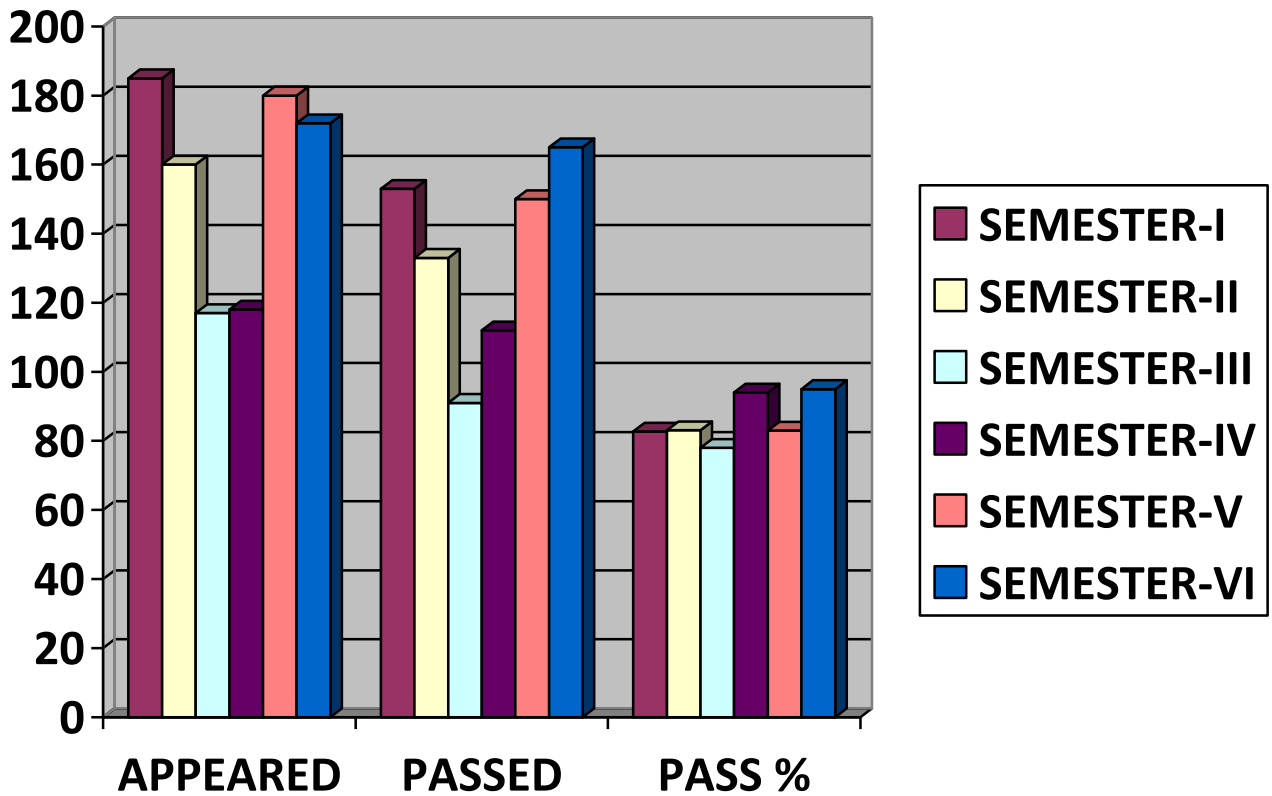

- ❖ Each student is evaluated in the class by way of tests, classroom seminars, and guidelines are given to prepare for university exams

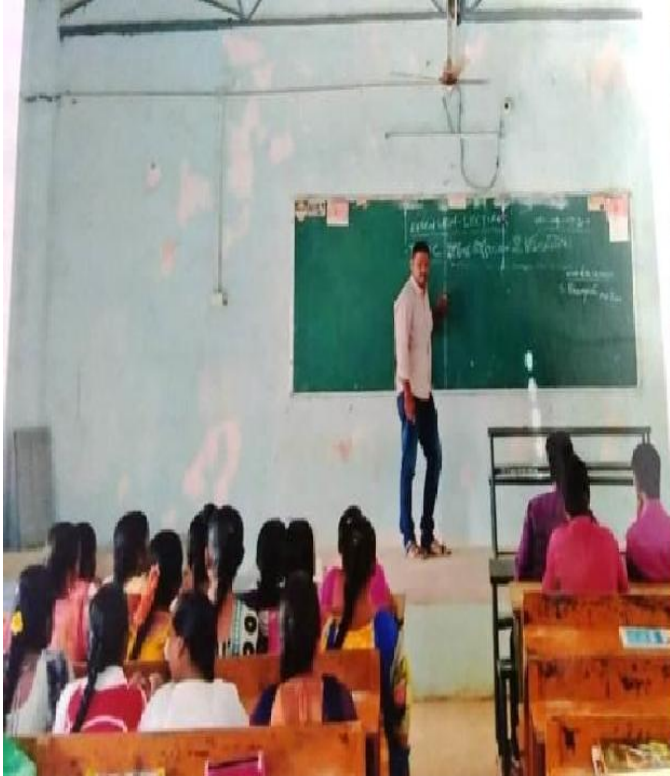
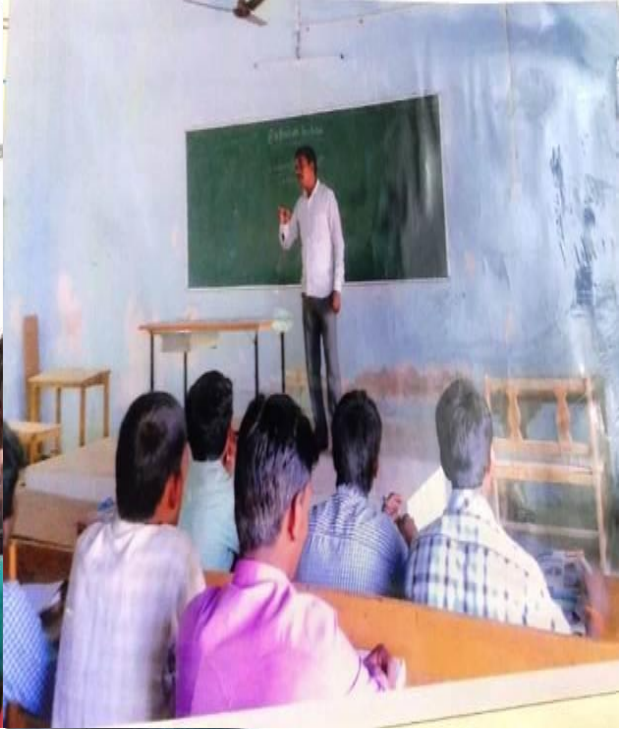
