- While purchasing Power consuming tools and equipment, care will be

taken to see that they consume less power. For instance, fans with 5-star rating will be purchased.

- The college has already replaced high power consuming tubes, bulbs and fans with energy efficient LED bulbs and less power consuming fans.
- Computers and other gadgets will be purchased that consume less

power.

 Sensitisation to the stakeholders about the usage of all electric

equipment, both in labs and elsewhere will be conducted.

Our computer, TSKC and other labs shall display notices in the labs in this regard.

Initiatives for the installation of solar plants for energy requirements will be done.

The purchase of high energy consuming equipment like A.C. will be

discouraged. Since most of the systems of the college are designed to work in Indian environment conditions, the usage of already existing A.C.s will be discouraged unless in harsh conditions such as harsh summers.
