Policy

The following are the salient features of the policy

- This policy honours and follows the e- waste guidelines forwarded to the College by CCE.
- Plastic will be used to the minimum, i.e., only when required.
- The College is a No Plastic zone.
- It is declared as PFC (Plastic Free Campus).
- Environmentally harmful plants such as Parthenium are weeded out. The college is a Plastic Free Campus (PFC).
- Students actively Participate in and motivate to participate in Plantation and Protection of plants.
- Our college will work towards the goal of making itself a carbon neutral campus.
- All equipment purchased must be low energy consuming.
- The college has its own Eco club which works in collaboration with other departments/ clubs/committees/cells to enforce the policy.
