Infrastructure Development Policy

Introduction

Tara Government College recognises infrastructure as an important element for bestowing best possible education transaction of teaching learning process. So, it has devised a policy for acquisition of infrastructure to the college in a transparent and efficient manner.

Rationale behind the policy is to

Raison d'être

- ✤ To provide adequate infrastructure to the college.
- To devise a mechanism through which infrastructure is purchased in an efficient and transparent manner.

Policy

- New classrooms and other construction is done through Government agency only, as of now, TSEWIDC Telangana.
- There will not be any financial transaction between principal or any of the staff and contractor. The agency will look after the work progress and mediate the work execution.
- ✤ A PMU, Project Monitoring Unit will monitor and facilitate the smooth construction process.

- Any purchases that are more than Rs. 1 lakh shall go through the central purchase committee to the hon'ble Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Telangana, who is also the chairperson of The Governing Body.
- The principal is empowered to permit purchases of below Rs. 20,000/-. However, the Staff Council guides the principal in the purchase or any financial transaction.
- All equipment is purchased based on their quality only.
- This policy includes infrastructure augmentation and maintenance.
- This policy honours purchase policy of the college.
- While purchasing infrastructure related to electric / electronic equipment, the following two points are taken into consideration, namely, a. If there is any alternative of non-renewable consuming equipment available such as solar lamp, b. if it consumes less power, like 5-star rating.
