Policy

The college recognised the growing pollution caused by mobile phones. so, the college has, after thorough deliberations with all the stake holders, brought into effect the following guidelines to monitor and control the negative impact of mobile phones in the campus.

- No students shall use mobile phones in the campus.
- All mobile phones will be confiscated if found with the student during examinations.

- a) There will be a dedicated mobile zone for students to use in case of emergency and exigency.
- b) Staff members are allowed to use mobile phones in their respective departments without causing any problems to any of the stakeholders.
- c) However, students are encouraged to use mobiles during ICT lessons and programmes and activities such as DEET.
- d) During classroom transaction, students shall switch off their mobiles.
- e) Sensitisation programmes are encouraged among students so that they can learn from their friends.
