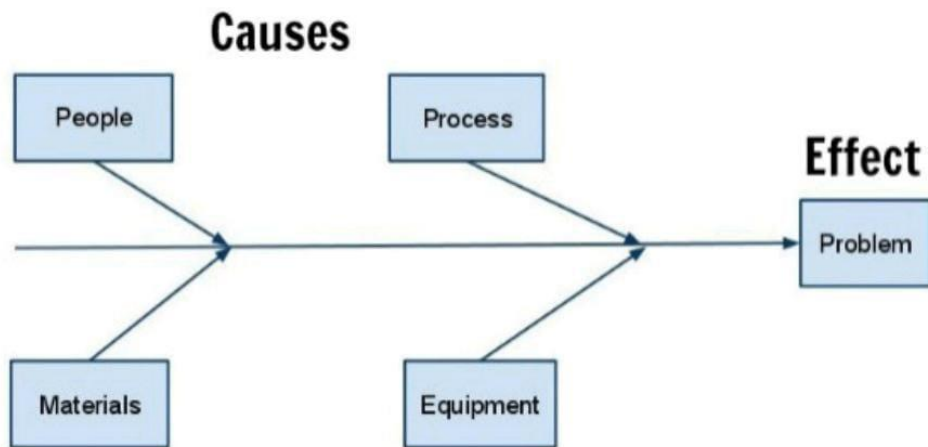

Dress for Success: Shoes Women Should & Shouldn't Wear to an Interview

Rule #1: Closed Toe

The best choice for professional shoes is to go with a closed toe, especially for an interview or the career fair.

Rule #2: Low to Moderate Heel

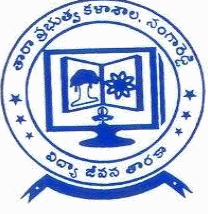
