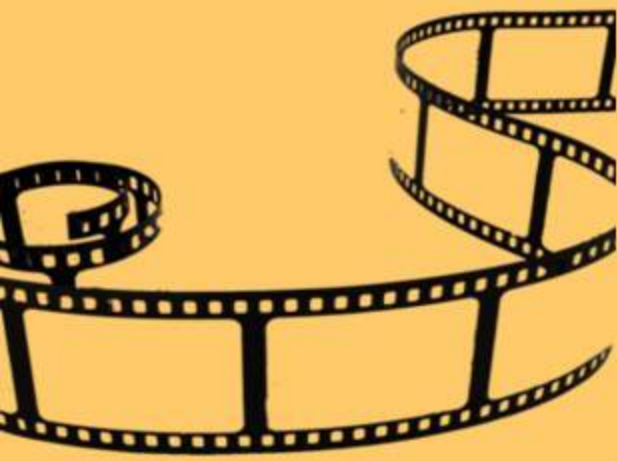

- Sub: Collegiate Education – Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE) – Issue of line of instructions to GDCs to promote activities related to Swachhta on the occasion of World Environment Day - Orders Issued–Reg.
- Ref: Letter received from Chairman, Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Dated: 18.05.2022.

World Environment Day is the largest global platform for environmental public outreach and is celebrated by millions of people across the world. It is being held annually on 5 June since 1974 by United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) to globally celebrate the spirit of positive environmental action. **#OnlyOneEarth** is the campaign for World Environment Day 2022 and it calls for a collective, transformative action on a global scale to celebrate, protect and restore our planet.

Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE) is a National Ranking Agency for Swachhta in Higher Education Institutions and one of their keen interests is to promote Swachhta in all colleges in Telangana. Vide reference cited, the Chairman, (MGNCRE) has requested the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Hyderabad, to conduct programmes for promoting Swachhta and Environment Conservation practices on the occasion of World Environment Day. MGNCRE calls for Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to encourage and rehabilitate the environment as HEIs need to be the beacons for environmental resilience.

In this regard, all the Principals of GDCs are instructed to form Swachhta and Rural Engagement Cells (SREC) with faculty members and students in each college and carry out the following activities.

- 1. Build Outdoor classrooms and Healthy Open places in the Campus**
 - Survey of the College Campus and Study Greenery - Conduct Survey of the College Campus using Google Maps
 - Mark areas under Green cover and barren area.
 - Highlight and mark areas in the Campus Map which need immediate action
 - Conduct a meeting with all the departments in the college for exchange of ideas and a holistic understanding of the campus scenario in terms of greenery.
 - Display the Marked Campus map.
- 2. Reinforcing Greenery in the College Campus**
 - Initiating a Sustainable Campus nursery - Collect seeds from trees and shrubs in and around the campus. Find out if they have the capacity to survive in the campus and if they are native to campus. Plant these collected seeds in the campus nursery and monitor them regularly. These saplings from the campus nursery are to be planted in empty and barren spaces, in and around the campus.

- Students could make a collection of mango seeds at their home and all the collected seeds can be used to make a Mango Seed Bank in the college. These seeds can be used to plant mango saplings in the college campus.
- Plant Protection Management – The sown seeds, saplings and plants have to be regularly monitored. New plants have to be planted in place of Old trees which fall. Biopesticides can be administered to plants as per the need. Have a replacement strategy wherever the sapling does not survive.

3. Zero Waste Champions

- Form Swachhta teams/ Campus divisions.
- Pledge to Keep Campus and Neighbourhood Clean.
- Offer challenges to the teams to observe zero waste week in campus divisions.
- Build Consensus to Observe Monthly Electricity Free/Fuel Free/Plastic Free Days.
- Organize Awareness Campaigns about Swachhta, Water Conservation, Recycling, Sanitation, Hygiene, Post COVID safety measures in Campus and Neighbourhood.
- Make Paper Bags, Creative Arts and Crafts from Recycled Material.
- Organize Water Feeders for Birds, Composting, Seeds Distribution, Herbal Gardens.
- Introduce Energy Saving Lights/ Fix Leaking Taps/ Put Waste Segregation Bins Check Water Bodies/Initiate Rainwater Harvesting Pits/Evolve Monitoring Aspects
- Appreciate and Award best performing Team with Zero waste champion Certificates.

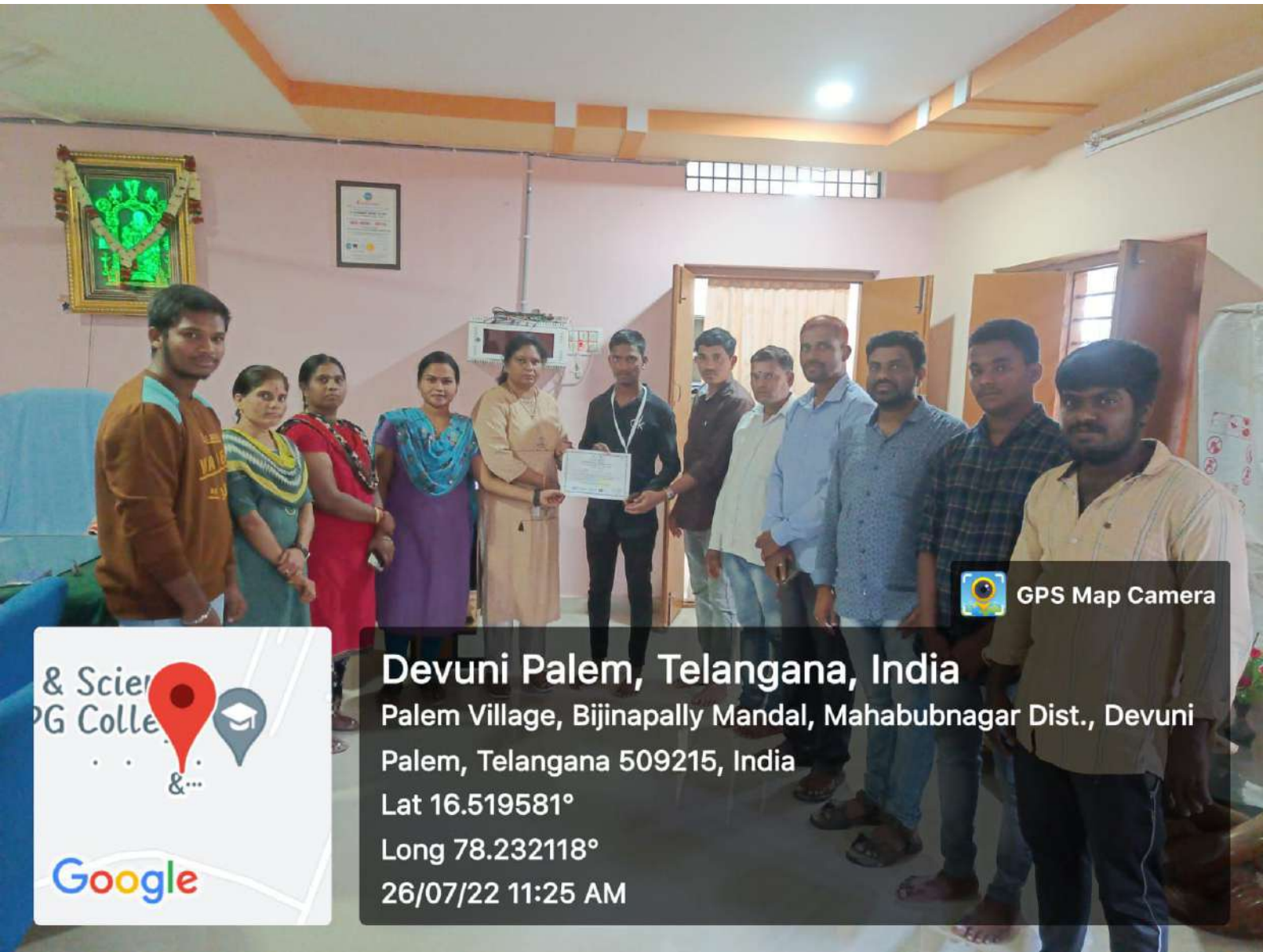

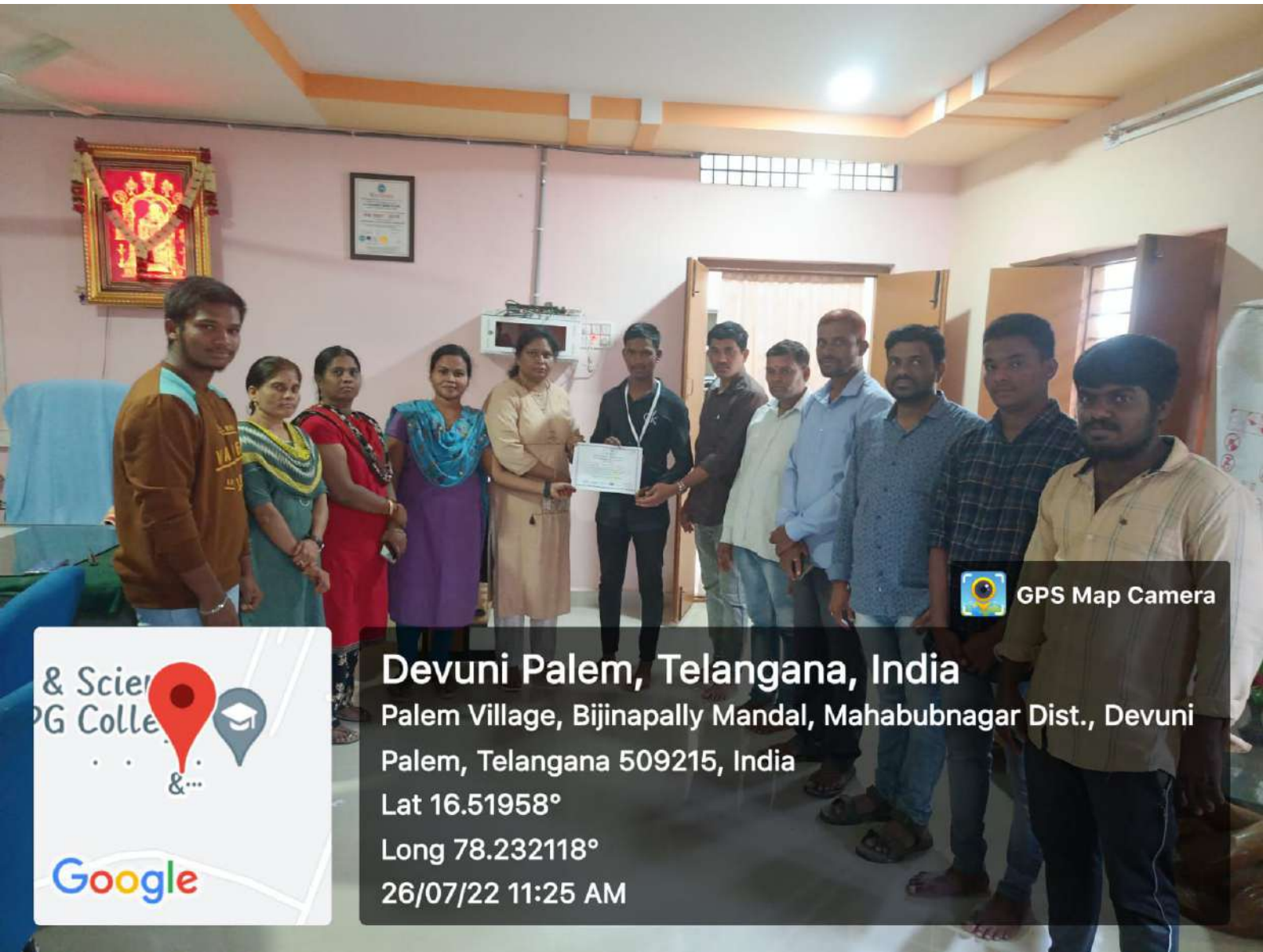
