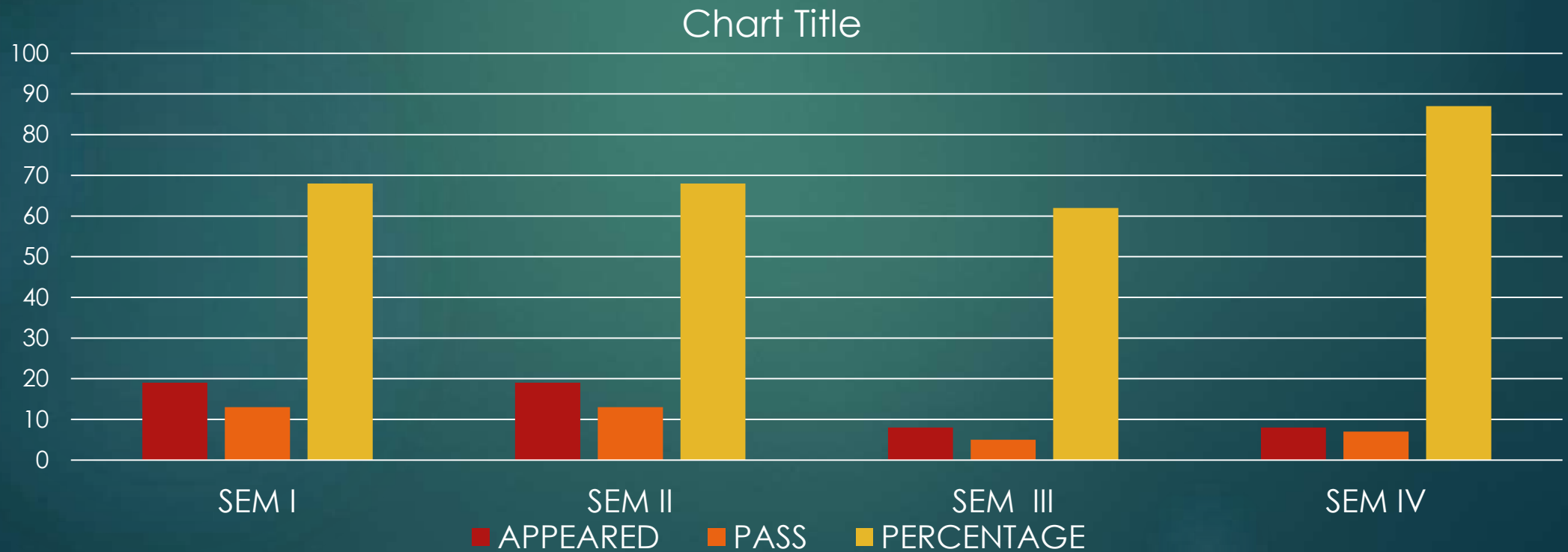

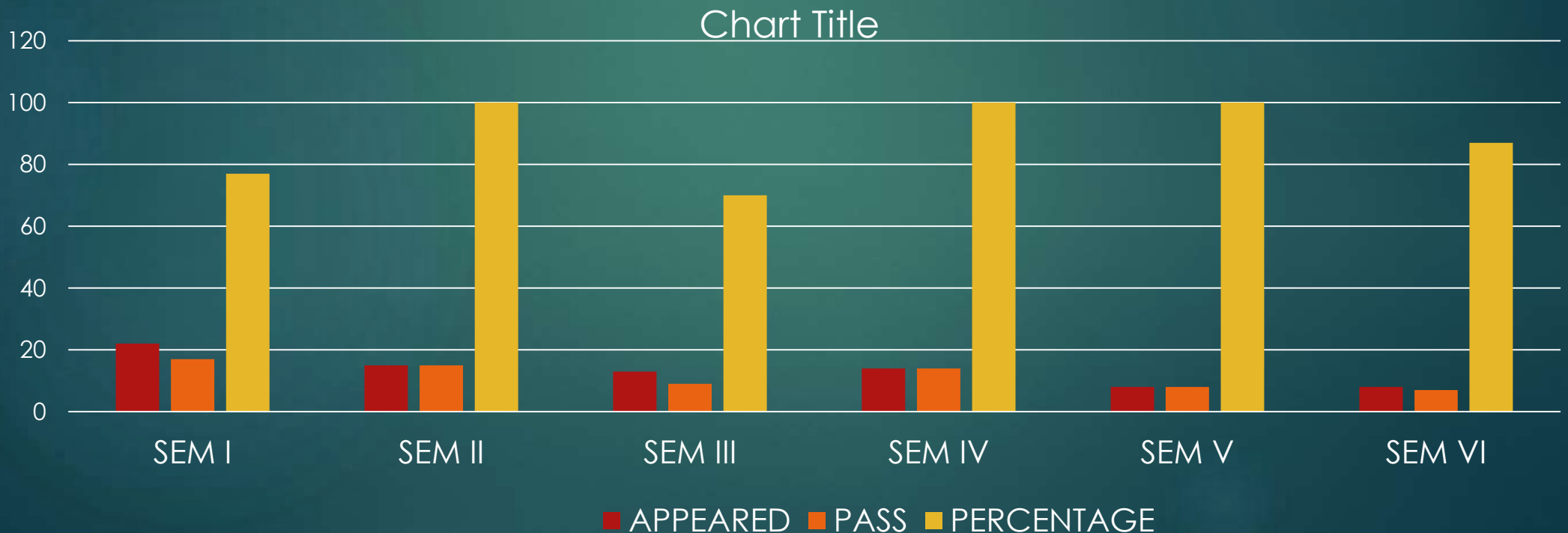

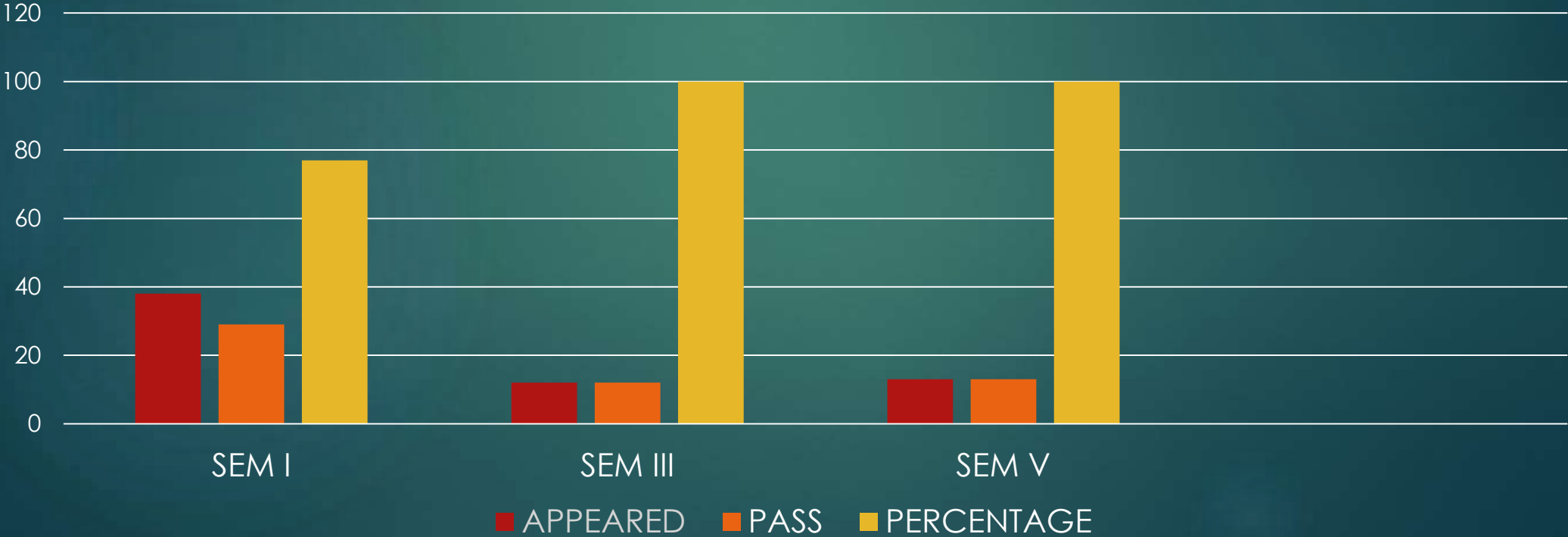

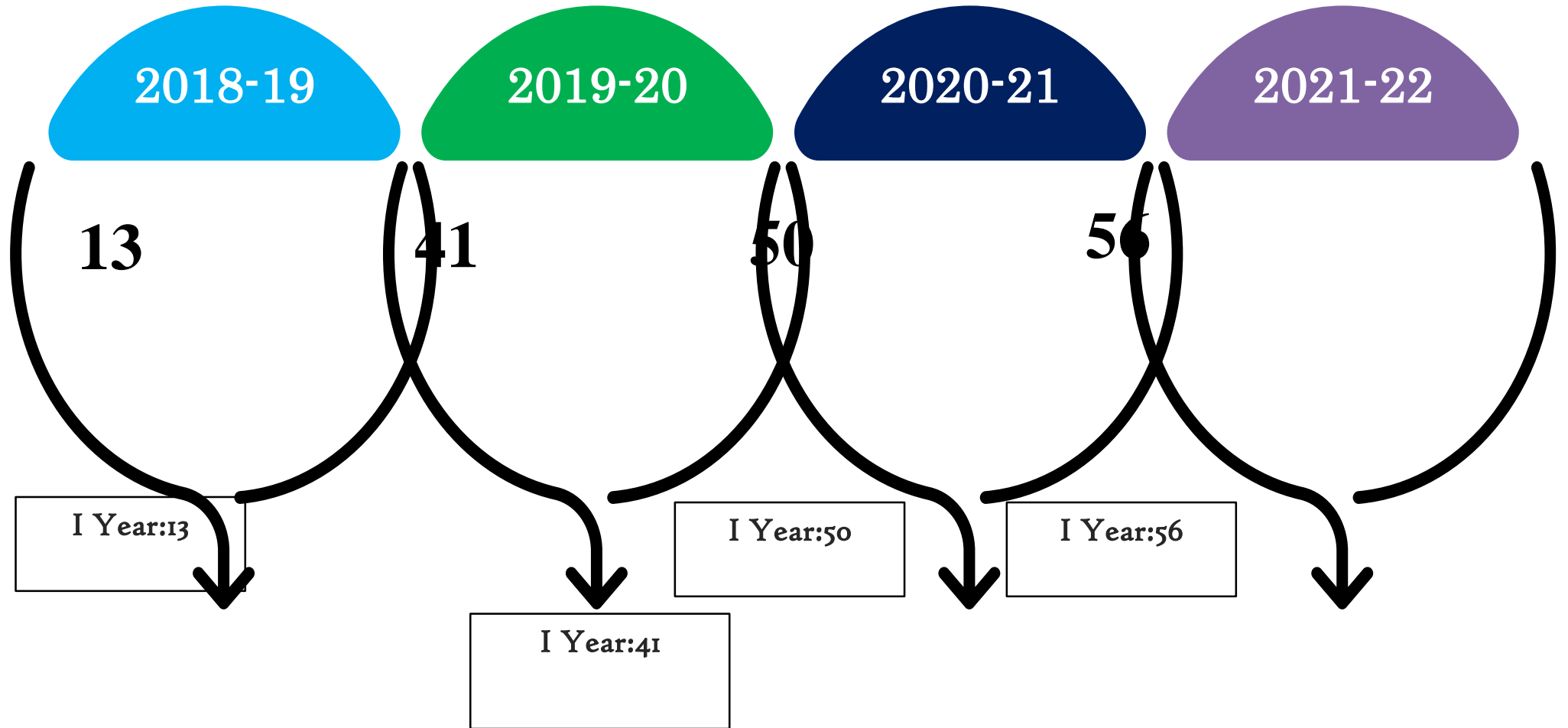

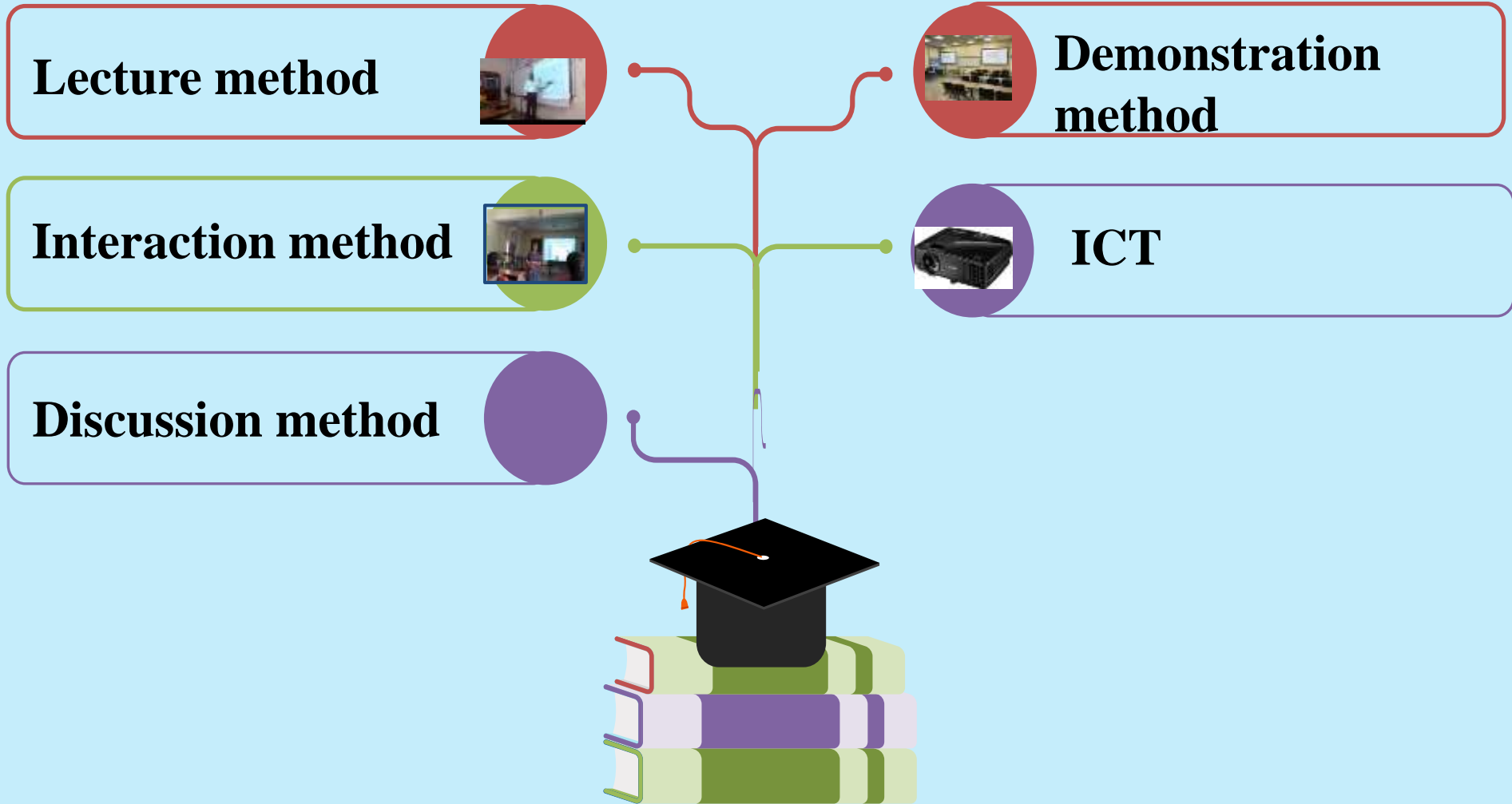

- It also provides an opportunity to become a political strategist.

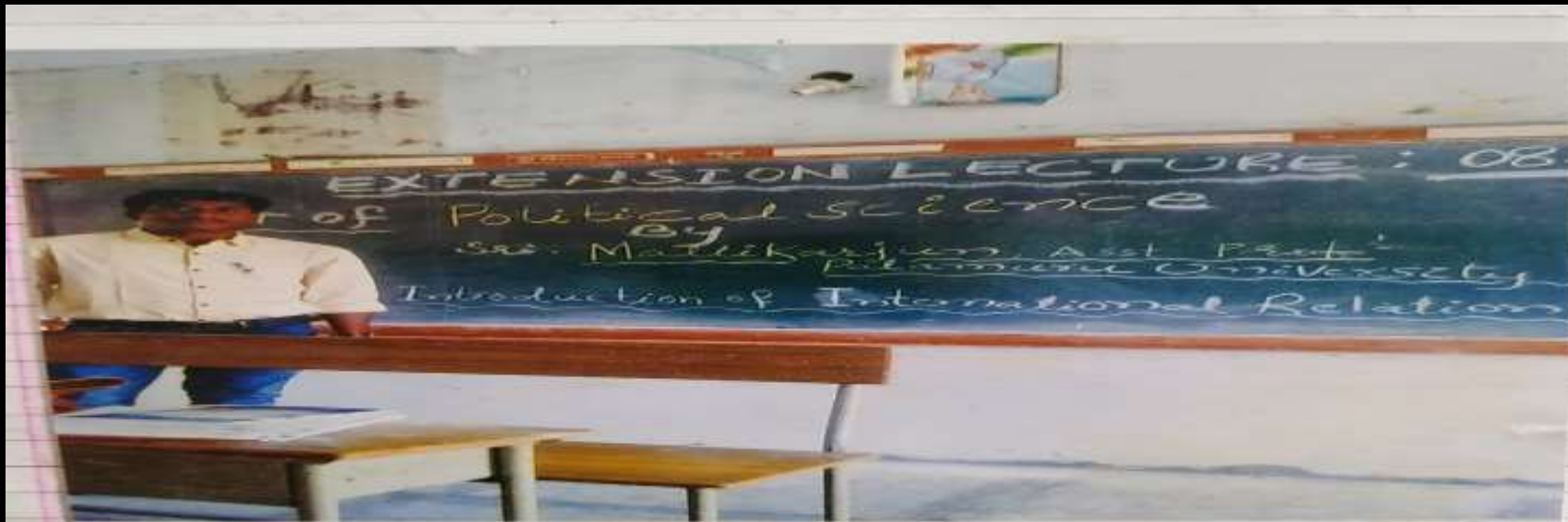
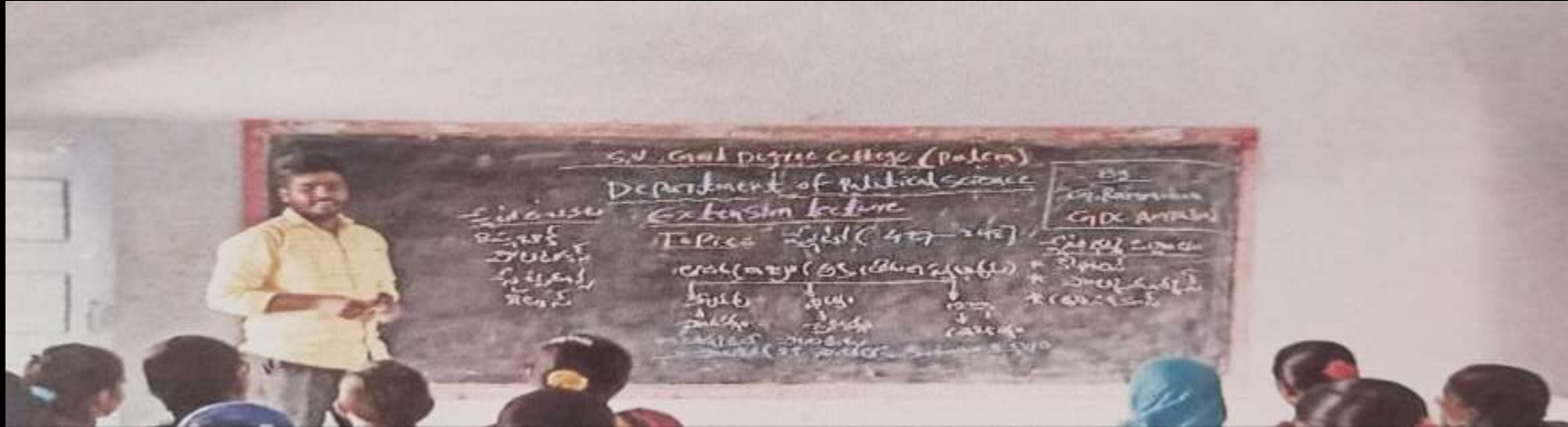
