- Action based activities like tree plantation, cleanliness drives both within and outside the college.
- Grow kitchen gardens, maintain vermin-composting pits, construct water harvesting structures in college etc.

## Activities in 2016 – 2017:-

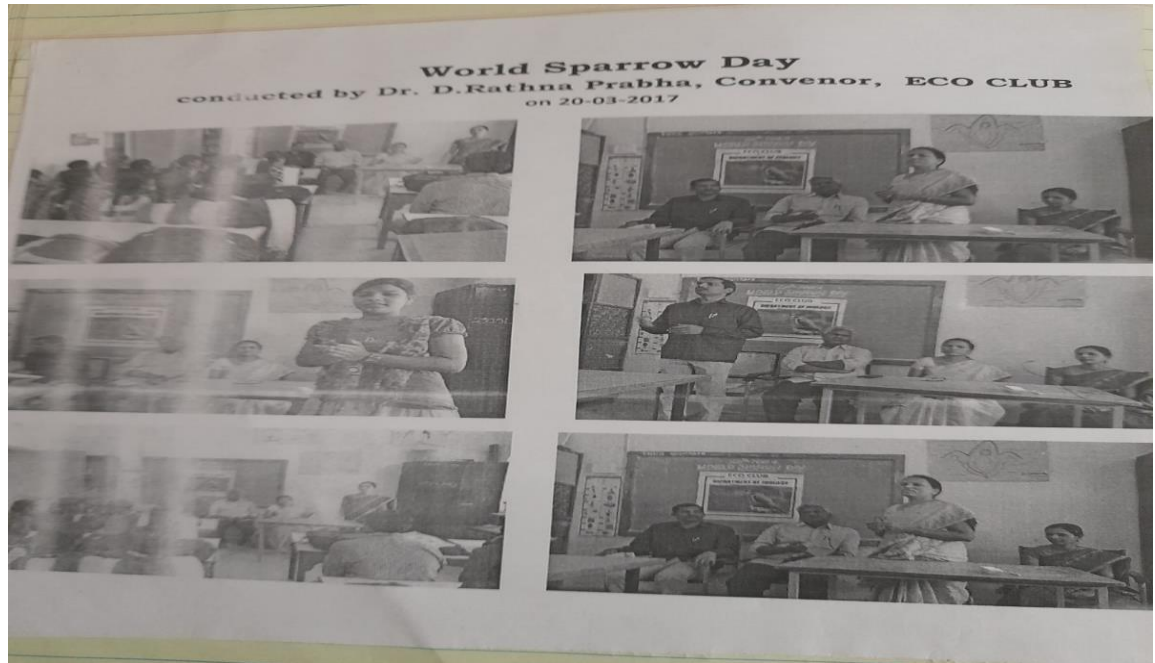

### Activities in 2017 – 2018:-

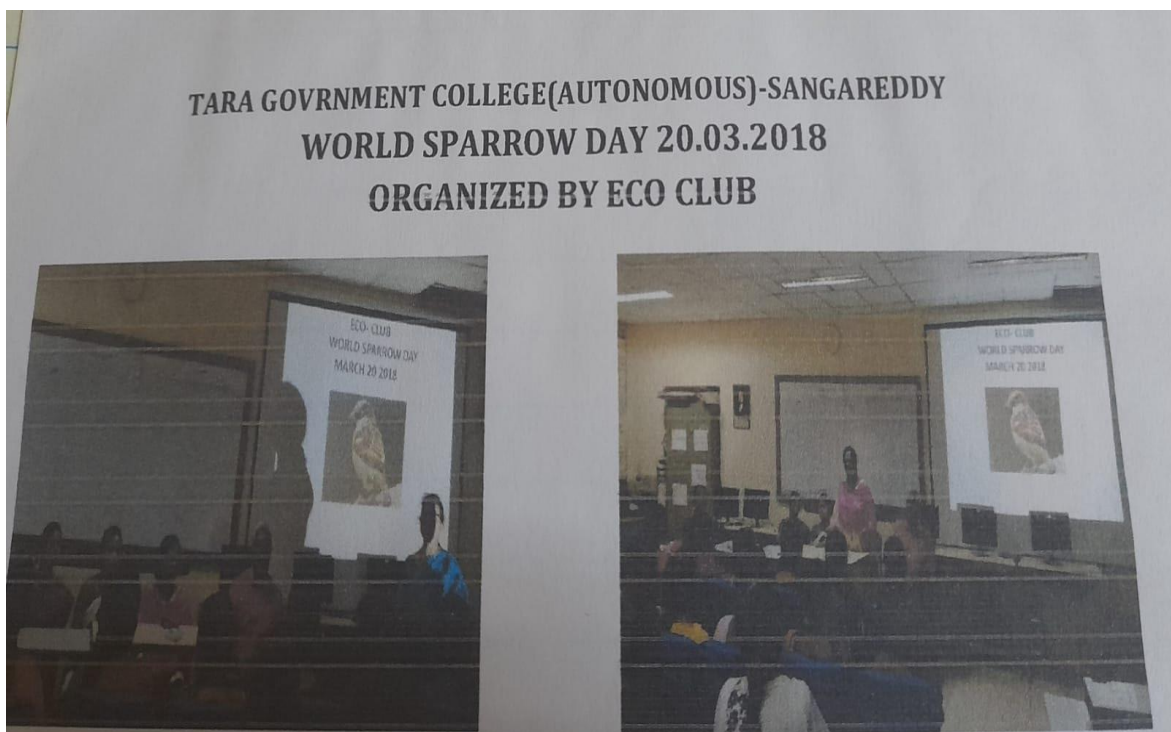
- On 19-08-2017 an eco fest was conducted by planting some saplings in the college premises.

- On 07-11-2019 Telangana ku Harithaharam program was conducted by digging the pits, doing plantation and watering to the plants with the help of students.

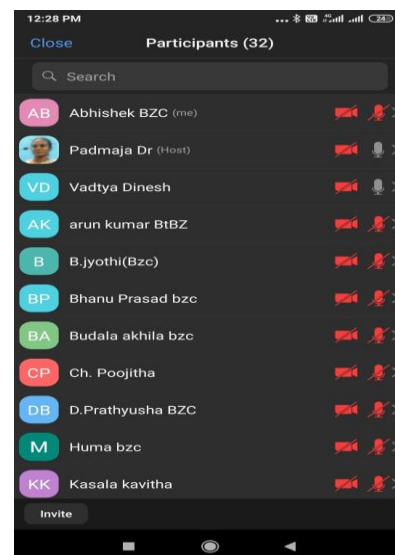
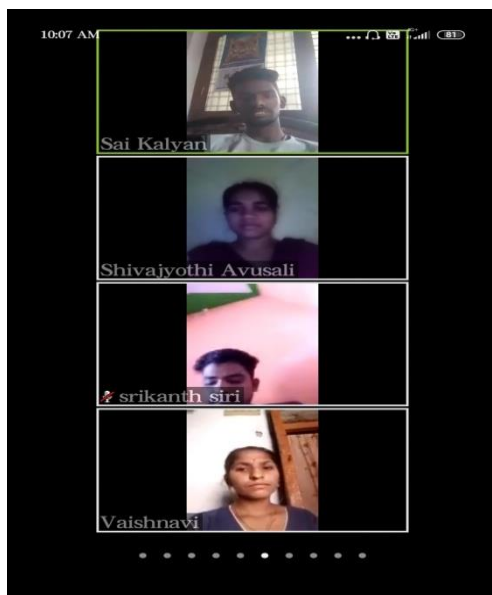


- On 02-03-2020 Swatch Bharat program was conducted along with NSS students.

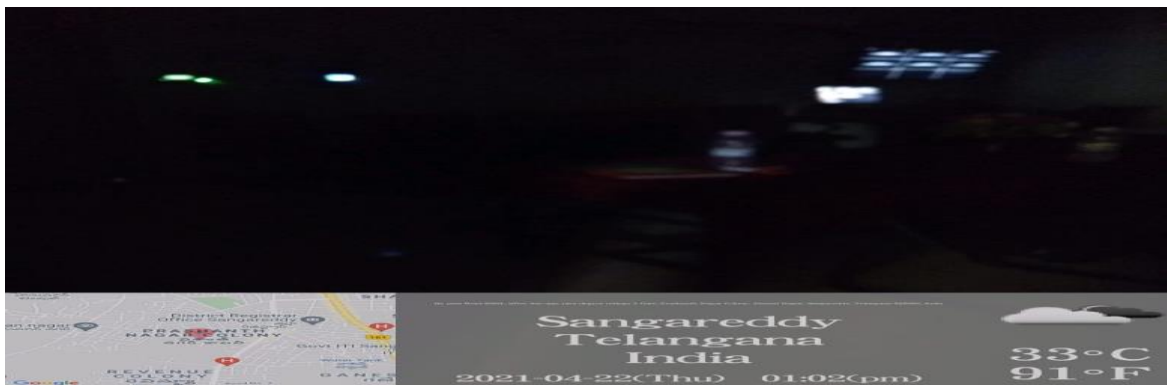

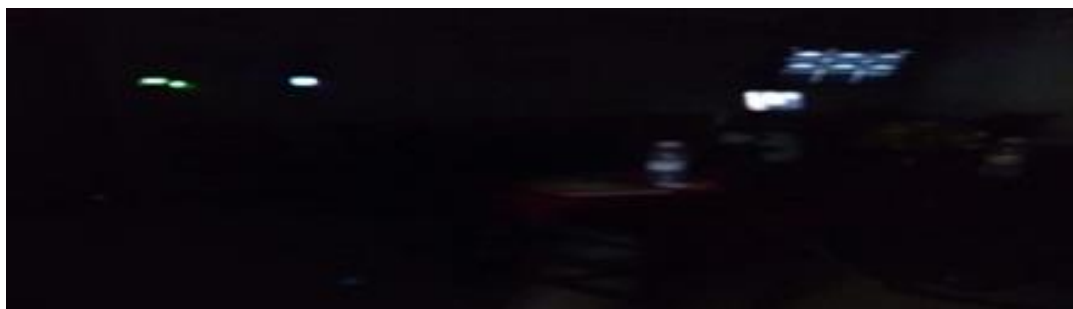

collaboration with department of Zoology conducted poster presentation on pollution prevention among student community.

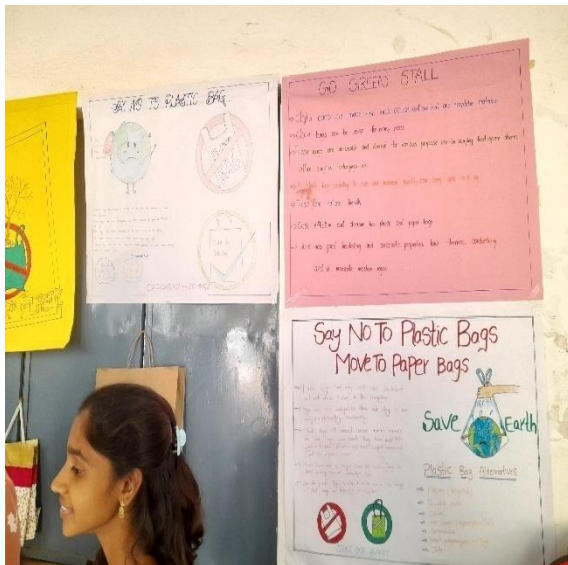


- On 14-12-2021 Zero hour was observed where in power was shut down in entire college signifying the importance and need of the hour -energy saving.

**Notice for Prohibiting Production, Stocking, Distribution, Sale & Use of Single Use Plastic (SUP) Items**

Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has issued notification No G.S.R. 571(E) dated 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 vide which manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of identified single use plastic (SUP) items shall be prohibited with effect from the July 01, 2022.

As per Rule 4(2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), "The manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2022:

- (a) Ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration;
- (b) Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers;

As per Rules 4(1)(c) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended) "Carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic, shall not be less seventy five microns in thickness with effect from the 30th September, 2021 and one hundred and twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31st December, 2022.

This Notice is being issued to inform all Producers, Stockists, Retailers, Shopkeepers, e-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malts/ Market place/ Shopping Centres/ Cinema Houses/ Tourist locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes / Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items as per the timelines specified in the said MoEF&CC Notification. Further, necessary action is to be taken by the concerned entities to ensure zero inventory of the aforementioned SUP items by June 30, 2022.

Action, as deemed fit under Environmental Protection Act, 1986 including seizure of goods, levying of Environmental Compensation, closure of operations of Industries/ Commercial Establishments, shall be taken against the violators of the said Notification.

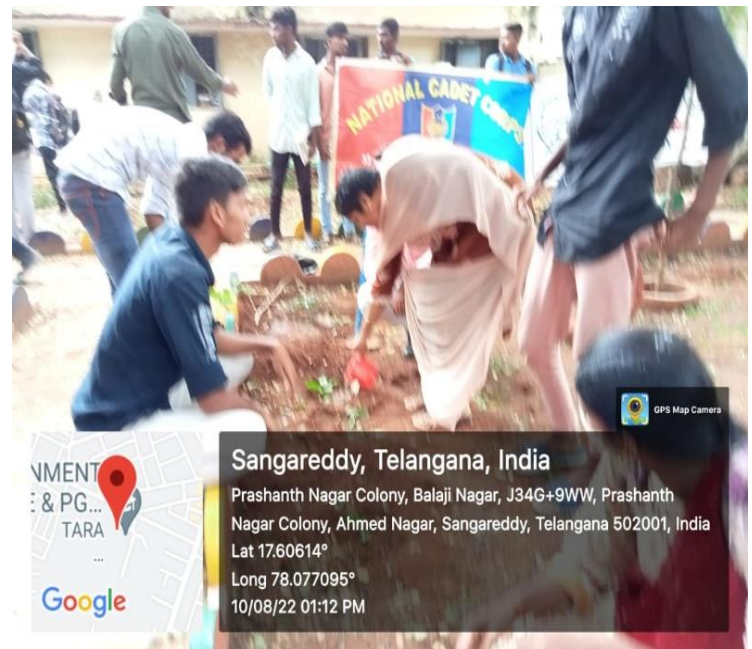


## ➤ Vana Mahotsav Program On 10 -08 -2022:-

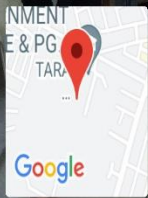
Like this only we as human beings have the responsibility to protect the plants. All the living organisms are dependents on the trees for oxygen.

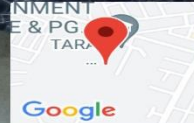


## **Painting competitions on 17 -08 -2022:-**

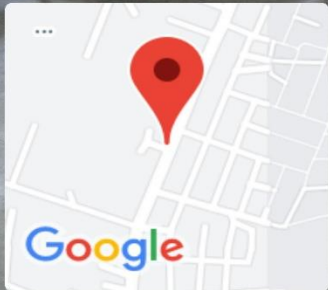
