






English News Paper reading for improving Vocabulary in English

Date: 15/7/2018

Francis Bacon, a well known essayist says 'Reading makes a man, conference makes a ready man, and writing makes an exact man.' A keen observation of the hobbies of the students reveals that with the advancement of technology, reading hobby has been declining for the last a few years. Reading books and English news paper are very helpful in developing not only one's knowledge but also English language. English news paper is a very powerful tool to master English language. There are various instances of people acquiring mastery of English language by reading English news paper.

To inculcate the habit of reading English news paper among the students we have organized 'English News Paper Reading Day' in the college. The students were supplied The Hindu news papers. Each student was instructed to keep their note books open. They are instructed to make a note of unknown words, idioms, and phrases, and impressive expressions they come across while reading a column of the news paper. They are asked to explain as to what they understand about the meaning of the words, idioms, phrases, and expressions on the basis of the context. Then their real meanings are explained. All the other students are asked to make a note of it. Ultimately it is observed that they, all together have acquired a number of unknown words. It is resolved to adopt this practice on daily basis in digital classroom.

SPELL-BEE CONTEST 2017-18

It is observed that the students of the college are very poor in writing the correct spelling of English words. Keeping this in view the department of English has resolved to conduct 'Spell-Bee' contest for the students to overcome the problem of misspelling the English words. Spell-Bee contest is a noted contest conducted in USA every year to encourage the students towards correct spelling of words. If a word is mis-spelt, it is likely to an adverse impact in the learning process.

Commonly mis-spelt words like: endeavour, bureaucracy, tuition, collaboration, committee, commission, entrepreneur, etc.



The Quiz Competition is conducted between B.A.I & B.Sc. I year students on 04/06/2020





Rabindranath Tagore:



Student Seminar for First Year Students

On request from the faculty members, The Department of English has come forward to conduct an orientation on 'Communication Skills in English' to the faculty members of the college. The nuances of English language were explained by eliciting often-made errors in most of the formal situations right from the presentation of the subject orally to presenting it in a written mode.

Realizing the significance of Communication skills for them the Department of English conducted an orientation programme to them on 19/2/2019. About 15 faculty members including teaching and non-teaching participated actively and responded that it yielded fruitful results.


