1. NAAC status report.

- a. The CCE has instructed the institution to undergo NAAC accreditation process. Before initiating the process of NAAC, our institution has been advised to submit a draft copy of SSR to the NAAC monitoring committee at CCE, Hyderabad.
- b. The IQAC of the institution has submitted a draft copy to CCE.
- c. The draft copy of SSR has been approved by CCE NAAC committee.
- d. Online IIQA was submitted and also accepted by NAAC.
- e. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, the online submission of SSR has been delayed till the opening of institution.

2. Infrastructure and New building

- a. Only Eight class rooms were there earlier (in ground floor). First floor was constructed with more rooms and was handed over to our college.
- b. Virtual lab was bought from the accumulated funds of our institution.
- c. The college building is white washed and painted.

3. Best practises.

- a. To increase the number of admissions our college staff were instructed to campaign in and near by villages of Utnoor.
- b. Due to abrupt closure of the institution during COVID pandemic lock down period, to finish the remaining syllabus, our Faculty members were instructed to conduct online classes using Zoom or Youtube platform.

- d. Girl students were encouraged to join RSETI, where they learnt stitching.
- e. NSS winter camp was conducted in the village Hasnapur.
- f. Blood grouping camp was conducted.
