About Library :

Sri Venkateshwara Government Arts & Science College Library in Palem has a long history of 59 Years in parallel with the history of the college which was established in the year 1963. College library is the heart of institution. It supports process of college education through providing required reading materials (Print + Electronic) to the user and opens the doors to the wide world of books which encourages reading for gain of knowledge and pleasure. Library is equipped with essential academic and intellectual needs of its students. College library is also used for recreation and leisure as it provides light reading materials like magazines, novels etc. Library has 01 reading rooms and provide an atmosphere conducive to study. It has provision of 40 seats for users to be seated.

It is well stocked and collection consists of more than 22731 books. Collection is continuously updated with changes curriculum and subscribes to many newspapers and Journals.

Library is a member of N-LIST(a program of INFLIBNET) to provide remote access to users to huge number of e-resources.

Working Hours :

The library is open six days a week (Monday – Saturday)

Timings are 9.30am – 4.30pm. It remains closed on all Sundays & holidays.

Lending services are available from 10.30am – 4.00pm.

Library Architecture :

The main library has separate block in with area of 691.2Sq.feet in the first floor and it has 3 Rooms. consists of Reading & Periodicals section, reference & competitive section. Digital Library. In addition to central library there are 11 Departmental libraries.

USERS:

The clientele of library includes all the students on roll of Undergraduate, teaching faculty, non-teaching staff. It has about 300 Undergraduate students, 15 teaching and 5 non-teaching staff to serve, Alumni.

COLLECTION:

Library has 22732 books at present and it covers many broader to minute subjects. Library subscribes to journals, periodicals related to subject & also to recreational magazines and N-List . Library subscribes 04 newspapers Telugu, as per the needs of UG students and staff.

The college library automation is under process. Installed licensed software - SOUL 2.0 full edition of INFLIBNET – UGC for the automation of Library. However, presently the library is automated for module OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue). The library database is created and updated with 15500 records in SOUL (Software for University Libraries) of UGC INFLIBNET. Bar-coding work initiated and work is in progress.

Books are issued to the students on all days of the week during working hours.

The library has a spacious reading room where in the students and staff may go through the periodicals, newspapers, magazines, subject journals covering all the language spheres.
