- ✚ Main Answer Booklet- what is to be filled in by the students and by teacher- points to be noted.

- ✚ What are the points to be noted while submitting the answer booklets of students after examination?
- ✚ He sought the support o teachers for the smooth conduct of examinations.
- ✚ He answered a few queries raised by the teachers.

- Practicals- laboratory- Dos and Don'ts in the COVID-19 period.



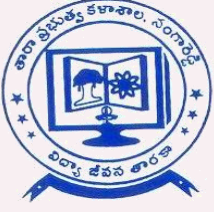

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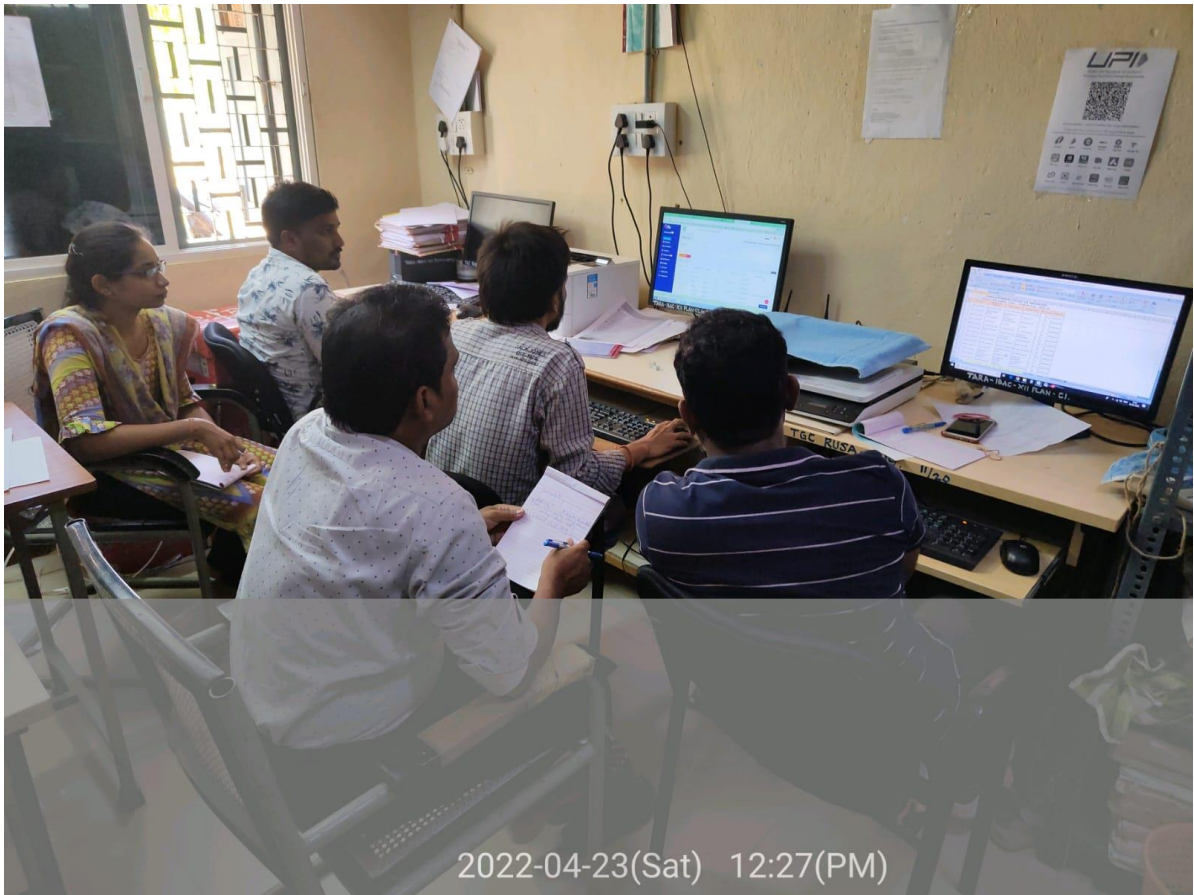

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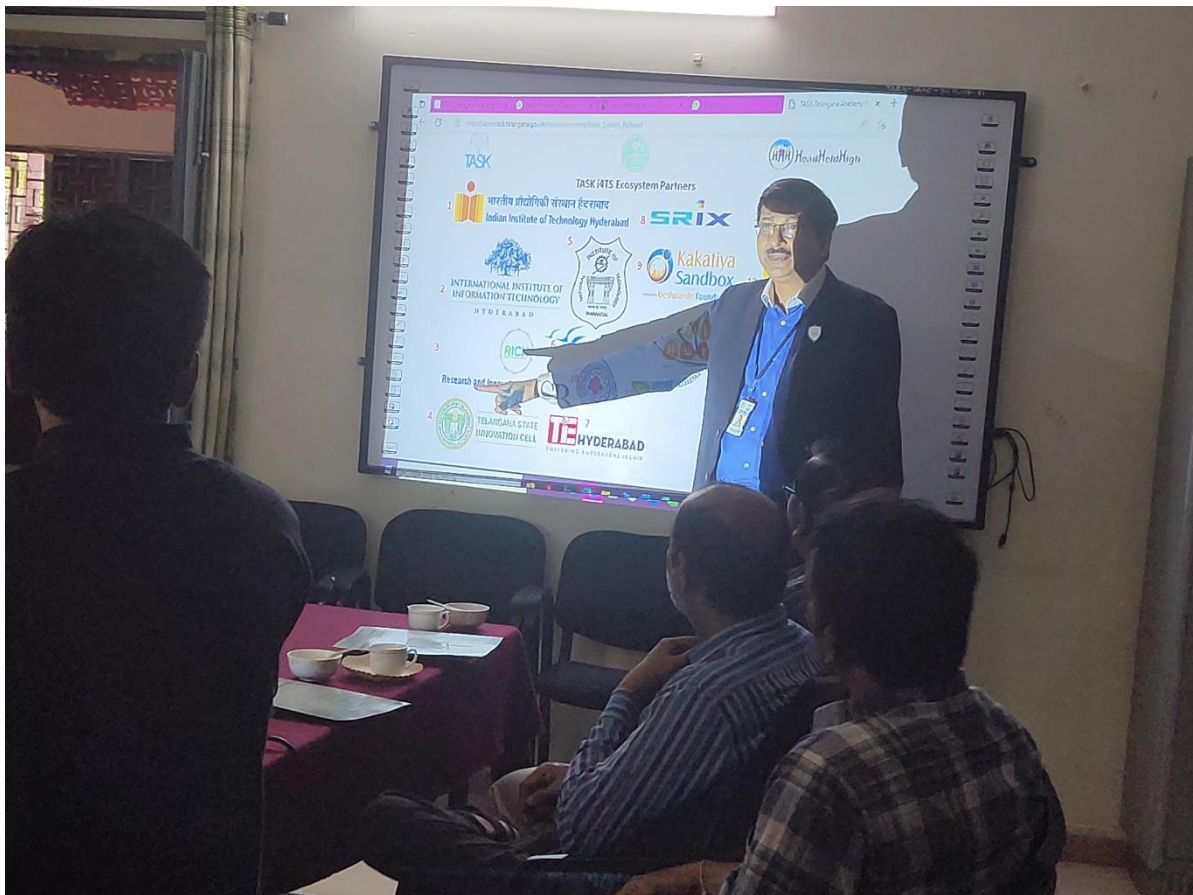
Telangana Skills and Knowledge Centre
