The college is functioning from 9:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Total work load of the Hindi Department is 20 periods per week.

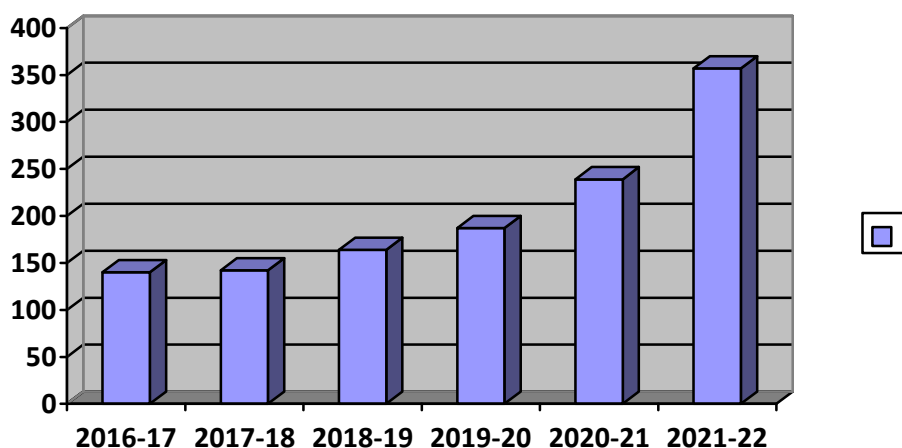

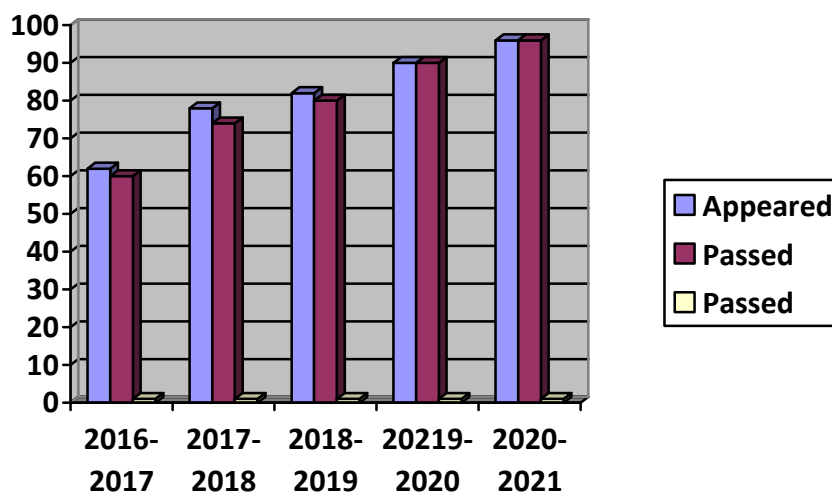

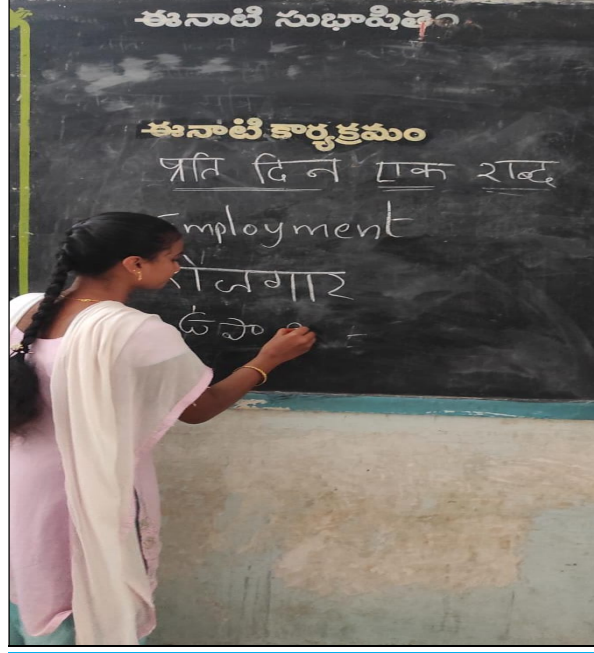
