Awareness on seasonal diseases in sammaiah nagar and nearby waddepally area.

Objective:

To Conduct outreach programme on awareness on seasonal diseases like Typhoid, malaria, and dengue in summer, hepatitis A, diarrhea in monsoon, and flu and bronchitis in winter are some of the seasonal diseases in sammaiah nagar and nearby waddepally area.

The precautions explained by the students to reduce the risk of contracting these diseases:

- Make sure that there are no pools of stagnant water. Keep water containers clean and ensure that flower containers and plates do not hold stagnant water.
- Use insect repellents to avoid being bitten by mosquitoes.
- Wash hands before eating
- Avoid eating in unhygienic places
- Drink boiled water
- Avoid exposure to people infected with viral diseases

OUT COME:

The programme was helpful for nearly 30 to 40 families and some of the families were not aware of the seasonal diseases this programme they were enlighted, benefited and thanked the health club convener and HOD zoology department and the students and request to visit and guide them frequently.
