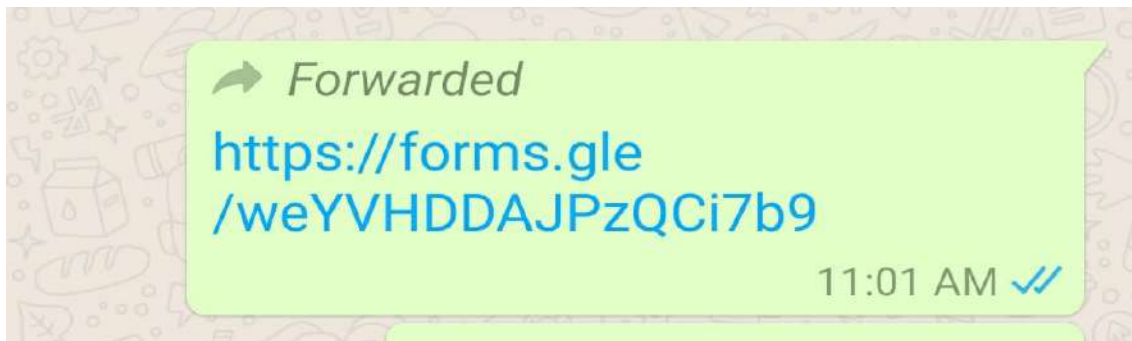


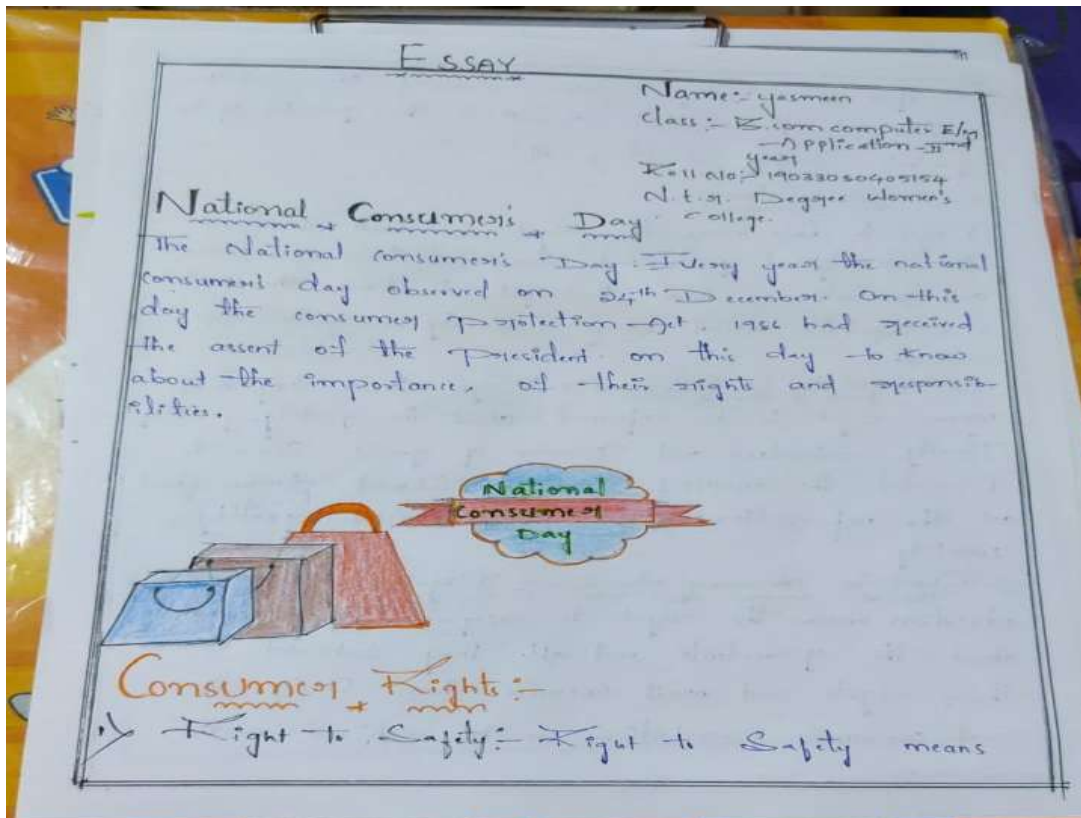

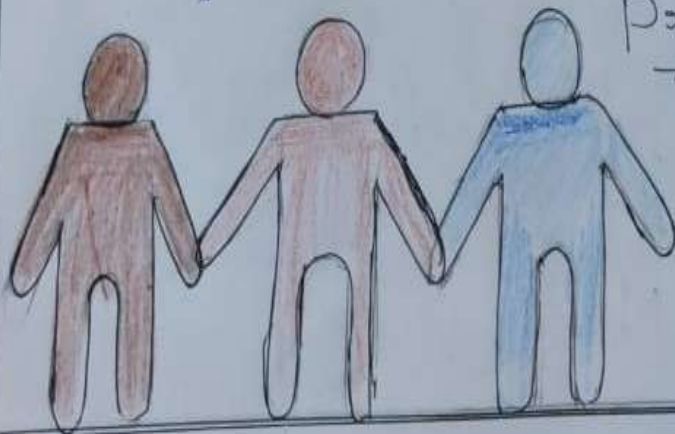

## Consumer Protection Act 2019

The Parliament passed the Consumer Protection Bill, 2019. On 6/08/2019 to replace the Consumer Protection Act 1986. The President of India gave its assent to the Consumer Protection Act 2019. The 2019 Act has brought in some major changes & provides for more protection to the consumers. The 2019 Act now provides an additional new advantage to the consumer by providing for filing of complaints where the complainant resides or personally works for gain as against the 1986 Act which only provides for filing of complaint. This would help in removing the difficulties faced by the consumers.

2) Right to choose:-

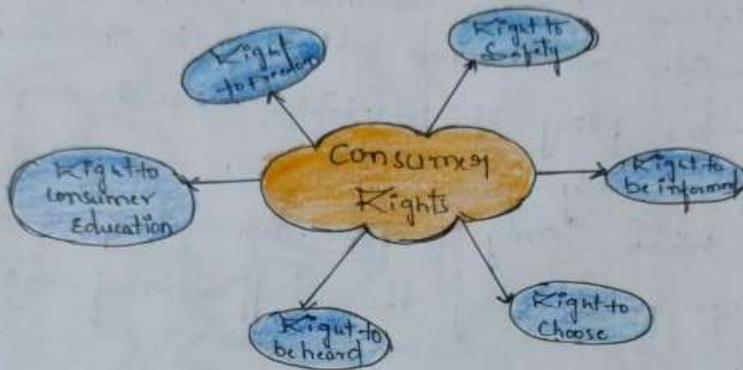
Right to choose means the right we have to choose the variety of goods and services. Better products and products we have the right to choose the products in a competitive market where a variety of goods are available.
