#### CODE OF CONDUCT

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



will be called separately so as to ensure freedom of expression and an atmosphere free of intimidation. The candidate is allowed to be accompanied by one representative during enquiry. The ICC must submit its report to the principal not later than one month.





#### Activities of Eco club 2020-2021

- Plantation programme is undertaken (Telangana Ku Haritha Haram) periodically through Eco Club and NSS unit.
- Removal of waste plants, thorny bushes is done under Swach Bharath programme by Eco club, NSS volunteers and other students and staff..
- As a part of green campus we have been growing medicinal herb plants like Alovera,
   Mint, Coriander, Ginger, Garlic, Amla etc. in our premises.

As a part of cocurricular plan of the institution the eco club has conducted certain specific ecofrendly activities to protect the environment.

### **Construction of Organic Compost Pit**

**Aim:** - Construction of organic waste compost pit in order to supply natural organic manure for the college garden

Organic composting is a technique of managing solid waste in which micro organisms breakdown organic material in the presence of oxygen converting it in to fertile organic manure. This is reused for the college garden in which fruit plants, medicinal plants and shady plants etc.

Initially a pit measuring 6 feet length and 4 feet width was dug. Later it was filled with organic trash such as fallen leaves, dung, dry grass and other biodegradable waste etc. which are produced in the college premises and by supplying water for 4to 5 days and allowed for biodegradation. As it was also treated with water dissolved with dung followed by regular water supply within 15 days the manure was formed.

This was utilized for college garde.

#### Outcome:-

- 1. Harmless, ecofriendly natural manure was produced and utilized for the garden at low cost.
- 2. Students realized that the harm of chemical, artificial fertilizers which are extensively being used now a days

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




# Highlighting points of the awareness programme:

Medicinal plants have been used in health care from the early civilization. They are considered as a rich resource of ingredients which can be used in drug development. They play a vital role in disease prevention. Medicinal plants synthesize hundreds of chemical compounds which help to reduce the symptoms of many diseases, allergies, inflammation and rashes. Plant medicines have less toxic effects. They are widely used, readily available and cheaper than modern medicines. Several organs of medicinal herbs like roots, stems, barks, leafs, seeds etc. serve as rich resources of medicines. Ajwain seed powder works for cough, gastric problems. Annona muricata ( Laxmana phalam) is used for curing cancer. Bryophyllum is used for dissolving kidney stones. Alovera is used to control skin rashes and also in cosmetics. There are several other plants which can cure several dreadful diseases.

Students actively interacted and shared their knowledge about traditional medicines and the role of many medicinal herbs in controlling the diseases
