An Indian freedom fighter and acclaimed poetess. She was born in Hyderabad in 1879. Her popular books are A Golden Threshold and The Feather of the Dawn.

3. Mahadevi Varma:

Mahadevi Varma was a freedom fighter; Born in 1907 in Farrukhabadher excellence in literature won her the Padma Vibhushan and the Sahitya Academy Fellowship among other honors.

4. Balamani Amma:

Balamani Amma was another famous Indian poetess who wrote in Malayalam. She was born in Punnayurkulam in Kerala in 1909.

5. Mira Bai:

Mira Bai was a 16th century Hindu poet and a devout follower of Krishna

6. Nandini Sahu:

Nandini Sahu is an acclaimed Indian poet, writer and critic. Born in 1973 in Orissa,, she is the recipient of two gold medals in English literature and the Shiksha Ratna Purashkar. Some of her popular books are The Other Voice, a Collection of Poems and The Silence.

7. Subhadra Kumara Chauhan

She was born in Nihalpur village in 1904, which is one of the most recited and sung poems in Hindi literature, and Veeron Ka Kaisa Ho.

8. Amrita Pritam:

Amrita Pritam was a poet and writer who wrote in Punjabi and Hindi. Born in Gujranwala in Punjab, She won the Sahitya Academy award in 1956 for her poem Sunshade, and became the first woman to do so.

9. Smita Agarwal:

Born 1958 is an Indian poet and a professor of English literature at the University of Allahabad, India.

10. Balamani Amma:

Nalapat Balamani Amma (19 July 1909 – 29 September 2004) was an Indian poet who wrote in Malayalam.

She was a recipient of many awards and honors, including the <u>Padma</u> <u>Bhushan</u> Saraswati Samman, <u>Sahitya Academy Award</u>, and <u>Ezhuthachan</u> <u>Award</u>.

11. Anamika:

(Born 17 August 1961) is a contemporary Indian poet. 2020 - Sahitya Academy Award for her poetry Tokri Mein Digant 'Their Gatha': 2014 She is the first and only female poet to have won the prize in the award's 65-year history.
