#### **2. Goal**

To make students excel at creative writing, critical thinking and collaboration through the process of running a student-run college newsletter.

#### **3. The Context**

Though students are involved in academic, curricular and extra-curricular activities in the college all through the year, seldom they do it on their own. The teachers and faculty members lead the sessions and students follow. There is a need of a platform where students could express, create, collaborate among themselves and maintain the whole thing on their own. This would provide them insight into their own latent creative, communicative and coordination skills.

#### **4. The Practice**

The English club with interested student members from various courses was constituted in the college at the beginning of the academic year by the department of English. The members of the English club in the first committee meeting discussed about the possibility of starting college newsletter in English which would be completely created and maintained by students themselves. The English club formed a core committee who would take care of writing, collecting articles, poems, motivating students for the task, design and production of the magazine regularly. They also formed a team of students who would assist the project in technical aspects.

#### **5. Evidence of Success:**

Three issues of Girraj Gazette were released in 2019-2020. The issues were released in print and online modes and placed in all the departments and college



library. It was enthusiastically received by all students. The success is evident in the increase of number of articles received and student participating with each issue.

#### **6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:**

Initially, it was difficult to gather students to form the core team for the job. But once the team was formed and motivated enough, there were no hassles. To release the magazine in print requires financial assistance from the college. Though the members of English club have borne the finances up to now, the project may require financial assistance to continue in future.

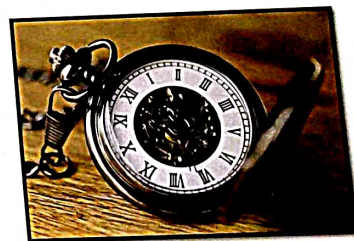

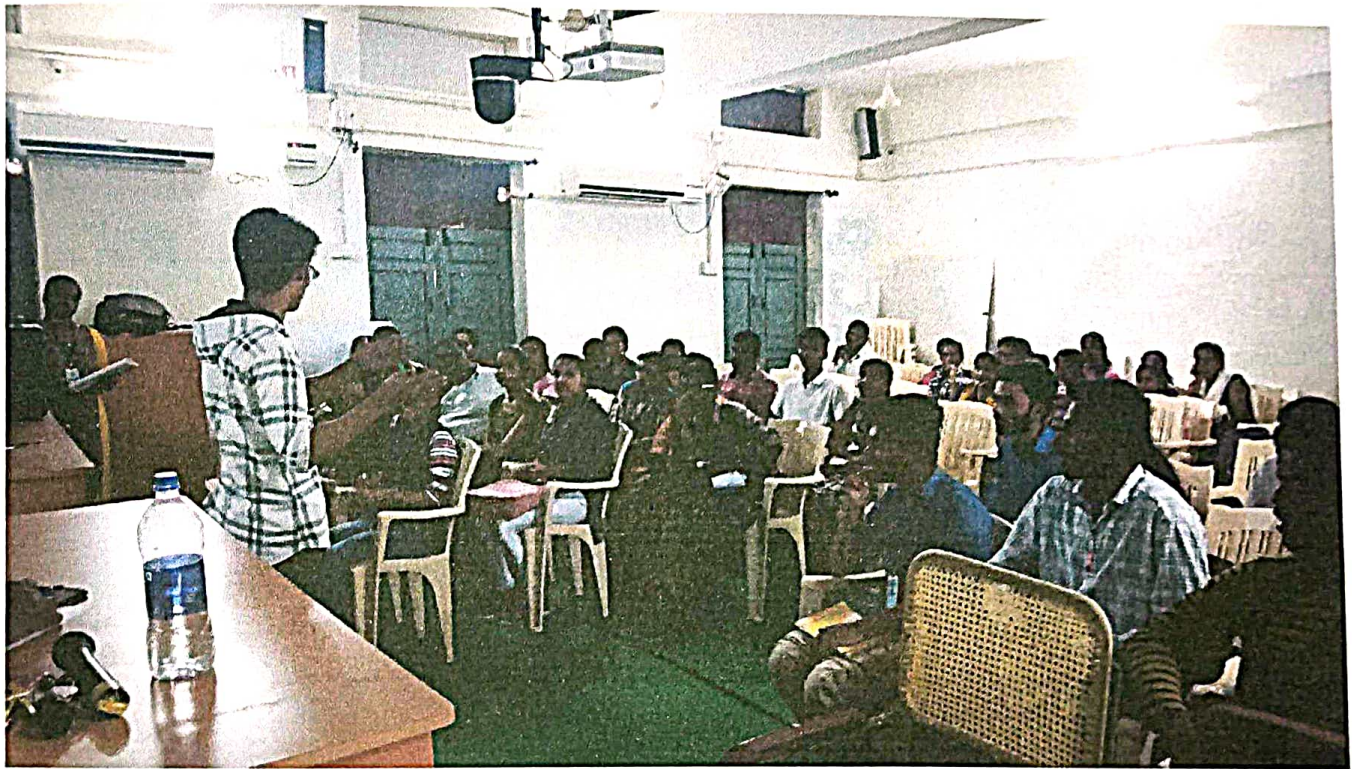
