Library in Nagarjuna Government College, Nalgonda has a long history of 60 Years in parallel with the history of the college which was established on 25th July 1956. The collections of total books are 56811 including Text and reference Books plus covering at presently 29 UG groups including restructured subjects and 5 PG courses.

The library acquires reading materials on all disciplines taught in the college. Our college library has a good collection of textbooks catering the needs of students as most of them come from rural area and belong to socially and economically under privileged sections of the society who cannot afford to buy text books, which is provided by the college library.

Library issues 2 books to Under Graduate students and 4 books to Post Graduate students. Every book will be issued for 15 days and can be renewed if required. Books are issued to the students on all days of the week during working hours.

LIBRARY READING ROOM:-

The library provides with vast material on various branches of knowledge which caters to the needs of the academic growth of students belonging to UG & PG levels. The library has a spacious reading room where in the students and staff may go through the periodicals, newspapers, magazines, subject journals covering all the language spheres. Some back volumes of journals are also available.

The library has a good collection of competitive material for various exams and entrance examinations. The competitive section which is part of reference section is kept open in the afternoon from 2.30pm to 6.00pm wherein, the students of UG & PG courses are provided with latest General Knowledge, spoken English, current events etc. PG Entrance material on all arts and science subjects are also available for the students. Thus, helping the students of college in securing jobs in Government, banking & private sector and to acquire seats in various courses.

RECREATIONAL CENTRE:-

Library also provides with light reading material like magazines, weeklies, novels for recreation. Every day around 350 to 420 students and 15 to 20 staff members visit the reference section. Average number of books issued per year is 380
