Institutional Collaboration On Exchange of Students & Faculty Between

This Collaboration is effective as of 11.02.2019 to establish an affiliation by and between

GOVERNMENT DEGREE COLLEGE, CHENNOOR

established in the year 1984, situated by NH63, opp:SBI Kistampet Branch; an institution of higher education catering mainly to the educational aspirations of economically and socially struggling sections of the society, herein referred to as GDCC, of the FIRST PART,

And

GOVERNMENT MODEL DEGREE COLLEGE, LUXETTIPET,

a premier institution of higher education in the district of Mancherial and bestowed with state-of-art resources in terms of building, equipment and laboratories, established under RUSA, a holistic scheme of development of higher education, initiated in the year 2013 by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, hereinafter referred to as GDCL, of the SECOND PART, for the purpose of exchange of faculty and students.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

PREAMBLE:

WHERAS, GDCC and GDCL have many areas of common interest in sciences, arts and career development, considerable advantage may be gained from the pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education and placements.

NOW THEREFORE, GDCC AND GDCL have decided to enter into this Collaborative activity which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both institutions agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic area of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

I. FACULTY EXCHANGE:

- i. The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both the institutions,
- ii. Collaboration in teaching and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest,
- iii. The exchange of academic materials and publications,
- iv. Conducting lectures
- v. Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit shall be worked out between the institutes. Any activity taken up shall be on the basis of mutual consent only.

II. STUDENT EXCHANGE:

GDCC AND GDCL agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to gain new horizons of knowledge in an already pursuing course or program of study or research.

- i. Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and host institution.
- ii. An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- iii. An exchange student will be considered as a full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.
- iv. The exchange student has to take examinations at his/her home institution only.
- v. If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
- vi. GDCC and GDCL agree to provide suitable accommodation and travelling expenses for student exchange.

vii. The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

III. OTHER AREAS:

- i. To exchange information on research and educational programs.
- ii. To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs.
- iii. To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- iv. To propose and engage jointly in research or training programs sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- v. The provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes,
- vi. To use laboratory facilities in specific cases for a limited period.
- vii. To permit students and faculty members to use the library facility.

GDCC AND GDCL agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of GDCC, and a programme coordinator from the side of GDCL, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The institutions are not obligated to share any kind of confidential information.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested to both institutes of this Collaboration.

Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with the prior written consent of both, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

This Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of TWO years commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice of 2 months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither GDCC nor GDCL will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institution may suffer. However, GDCC and GDCL will ensure that the provision of this Collaberation shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

ARTICLE 7: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

The Collaboration may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

ARTICLE 8: ADHERENCE TO LAWS

Participating faculties and students involved in any activities under this Collaboration must adhere to the rules and regulations of the host institutions.

ARTICLE 9: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this Collaboration shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Collaboration is a statement of intent to foster genuine and will be mutually beneficial.

ARTICLE 10: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case, there is a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation both institutes will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

GDCC and GDCL welcome the establishment of this Collaboration for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions as set out above.

- ii. Inter-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary studies

NOW THEREFORE THE DEPT. OF BOTANY, GDC CHENNOOR AND HARITHAHAARAM (MANDAL PARISHAD DEVELOPMENT OFFICE), CHENNOOR

Have intended, agreed and consented to the following terms and deeds in pursuance of a common intent to promote Study of Botany and generate zeal for research.

1. FIELD OF COOPERATION:

a. Supply of Categorized Plants: During the supply of plants for HARITHAHAARAM purpose, plants of medicinal importance and research importance, new evolved species may be supplied to the institution based on their availability and priority.

b. The Co-operation may include

- i. Faculty visits and extension lectures.
- ii. Student visits to nursery.
- c. Awareness on Improvement of Plantations: To create awareness among the students about the necessity of Plantations certain programs may be conducted and students may be required to participate in AWARENESS PROGRAMS conducted in the nearby localities.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. The details of the efficacious implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.
- **b**. The parties to the memorandum may, by mutual consent, add, modify, amend, delete, review any item(s) and condition(s) of this agreement.
- c. The intent and implementation of this memorandum is subject to the policies, rules and regulations of the respective institutions.
- d. The MOU shall remain in force for a period of 2 years from the date of its signature and seal, and may be terminated by either side by giving a one month notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.
- e. The parties to this MOU undertake to treat as confidential and privileged information of the other institution, which is so classified in advance. The terms of

confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms. This MOU shall require the ratification of the competent academic/executive body of both the institutions.






