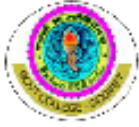

Report on Workshop

Introduction:

This Students centred one day college level workshop was proposed and organized by the department of Commerce and Business Management of our College. As per the program schedule, entire workshop has been divided in to Five Sessions: Inaugural, Technical Session-I, Technical Session-II, Technical Session-III and Valedictory Session. Inaugural Session:
