Details of Significant Achievements of the Department of Commerce and Business Management

Department Profile:

The Department of Commerce was established in the year 1966 with English as Medium of instruction and with a permitted strength of 60. In its evolution process in 1971 another section with Telugu as medium of instruction was started with another 60 intake. Further in the year 1998 B.Com Computer Application course was started with another 60 intake, again in the year 2019-20 Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) course with 60 in take was started. For the Academic Year 2021-22, PG M.Com course with 60 intake was also sanctioned. Therefore the department is growing leaps and bounds with diversified courses. However, now close to 1200 students are pursuing their education in the Department. Further the Department of Commerce and Business Management is endowed with highly qualified and experienced faculty members. They are always instrumental in inculcating and imparting quality and employable education, skills and competencies among its students. The department is one of the vital & crucial departments of the college from the point of student's strength, academic results, organizing various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. Guiding, supervising and mentoring students for their career growth & development and advancement in their future Endeavour are a few feathers in its cap right from its inception in 1966.

The department also plays commendable and invincible role in producing prominent, esteemed and distinguished alumni. The students of the department have been excelled and explored themselves in different fields, events and activities and brought unprecedented glory and remarkable shine to the college in general and department at particular. Prof. H. Venkateshwarlu, Pride Alumni of the department and former Head, BOS and Dean, Department of Commerce of Osmania University has positioned to Vice Chancellor of Central University of Kerala. Its faculty also closely associated and conduced with copious amount of scholastic works, which are indeed quite useful to its students and college in general. At present the department has 9 Staff Members in which FOUR are Doctorates; Two with M.Phils and rest are pursuing their research degree besides possessing UGC-Accredited NET/SLET/SET certificates. Right from commencement of the course in the College to till date 14 well experienced faculty members have discharged their flawless duties as HOD,s. At present **Dr. Gopala Sudarshanam** is discharging his responsibilities as Head and Chairman, BOS of the Department. During the Academic Year 2020-21, with the same spirit of enthusiasm, department and its ardent faculty have strived for best and innovative practices for the student and teacher centered activities. Following are the significant achievements of the department at this backdrop.

Creation of E-Content:

Since the academic year badly hit by COVID Pandemic, it was almost impossible for physical mode of class room teaching and learning. Department taking the stock of situation transformed from class room teaching online teaching and also developed tens of hours lecture videos for the sake student's uninterrupted learning.

Establishment of Entrepreneurship Development Cell:

Department of Commerce inaugurated ED cell in the college to inculcate entrepreneurial skills among students who wish to settle as entrepreneurship and set up their organization apart from developing various skills to make them employable and motivating them to pursue higher education. This cell actively organizes various training and workshops to promote entrepreneurial skills among students. This cell is constituted with four members where principal will chair and HOD commerce act as convener. ED cell was inaugurated by Prof. H. Venkateshwarlu, pride alumni of our college and also vice chancellor of kerala central University.

Entrepreneurship Development Programme:

Department of commerce successfully organized a Four week state level training program "Entrepreneurship Development Program" for developing entrepreneurial skill among students. This program was organized in collaboration with ni-MSME, Hyderad and sponsored by Department of science and technology – National Implementing and monitoring agency for training. The programme content includes class room training on essentials of entrepreneurship survey of the prevalent socio – economic scenario, identification of business opportunities, role and function as well as schemes of assistance offered by various constituents of the support system, preparation of a technically feasible and economically viable project report, Achievement Motivation Training and also the management of an enterprise. Sessions on technology and finance are also arranged, depending upon the nature of project selected.

One Day Work Shop on CPGET and Other PG CETS

Department of commerce with its multipronged approach in catering the student's interest, it also organized a student awareness program "One day work shop on CPGET and Other CETS" for creating awareness among the students. Resource persons from department itself and from other department actively engaged for motivating and building a strategy among the aspirants to beat the challenge and crack entrance test. Since attempting computer based test is first time a hands on session through practice link was also arranged for student to make them familiar with CBT test.

One day workshop on Tax planning;

Department of commerce crafting from its in house rich pool of resource persons organized a one day workshop on Tax Planning and E-filing was organized to aware the teaching and nonteaching employees about various exemptions provided by GOI to plan their tax liabilities. And also trained on method of calculating tax liability of an assessee. A hand on experience was also given to participants on e-filing their tax returns through income tax India website for efiling of tax returns.

SEBI Empanelled Trainer:

One of the faculty from the department recognized as empanelled resource person or as SMART (Securities market Trainer) by Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for conducting investors awareness programs among specified sections of potential investors in the Telangana region.

Books and Publications:

Department of commerce in its pursuit to enrich itself on continuous basis and achieve higher goals in the higher education arena, faculty always engage in authoring academic and referencing books and research publications. Department is credited with good number of publications in national and international reputed journals and credited with authoring two academic books during the academic year.
