This fair continues for three days starting with taking of the Idols from Garla village to Marrigudem and performing 'Kalyanam' and Teppotsavam in the 'Koneru' (Pond) near the temple. Many people from nearby villages come to offer their offerings and prayers. This fair reflects the local culture and traditions.
