Feedback Analysis

The institution has collected feedback from the stakeholders of this college for the on going NAAC period i.e., 2016-17 to 2020-21. The institution has taken the feedback from the students, teachers and Alumni. The feedback has been collected, analyzed and an action taken report has been based on the questions given in the form of feedback.

Analysis of student's feedback :

Ten parameters have been given to the students for obtaining their opinion one syllabus design and its adaptability to the present scenario. Four options are given in the feedback form. 10% of stakeholders feel that the Syllabus design is excellent, 80% of the stakeholder believe that the syllabus is very relevant to the present situation. Nearly 80%.of stakeholders feel that the syllabus is incorporated with necessary technical skills.

Analysis of Teacher's feedback:

Eight parameters have been provided to the teachers for obtaining their opinion on the curricular development and its need of the students. Four options are given in the feedback form. 90% of stake holders opined that the curriculum is effective and it is suitable for the need of the students. They are also believed that the curriculum has created innovative strategies. 80% of stakeholders opined that the curriculum design is helpful for ethical values in the students, 85% of stakeholders believe that the curriculum is suitable for employability skills in students , 90% of stakeholders believe that curriculum is very effective for self learning and to acquire knowledge.

Analysis of Alumni feedback :

The Alumni of the institution is one of the finest assets for development of the college. As there is no registered Association of alumni for this college, only feedback is collected from the available alumni of the college 100% alumni is highly contended with Admission procedure and infrastructure availability in the college. Most of the stakeholders are highly satisfied with the lab facilities, Library, quality of Teaching and other facilities of the college.

Action Taken Report :-

Some Alumni have expressed their dissatisfaction with the location of the college and transport facilities for the students. In this regard we have approached the RTC depot Managers of Yellandu and kothagudem to relieve them of the above grievances.

Analysis of Alumni Feedback:

The alumnus of the institution is one of the assets in the development of college. As there is no registered association of alumni in the college only feedback has been taken from the available alumni. The institution is making its efforts in getting the alumni association registered in the days to come. 84 percent of the alumni has highly satisfied regarding the quality of teaching whereas 80 percent are contended with the infrastructure, library and other facilities of the college. 50 percent have opined that the syllabi are useful for competitive exams suggesting moderating changes in the syllabus.

Analysis of Teachers Feedback:

The teacher's role in both curricular and extracurricular activities and shaping the students career in a right way is invaluable. 75 percent teachers opined positively regarding scope of syllabus to pursue higher education and career. Only 66 percent of teachers told that the curriculum inculcates social responsibility among the students.

Action Taken Report:

As the parents have expressed their dissatisfaction on the location of the colleges, we have initiated to improve the transport facility for the students. In this regard, we approached the Manager, Warangal-2 Bus Depot which runs buses in this area and have given a representation to run special buses up to the college premises in the morning and evening when students enter into the college and go to their homes. As the scope of syllabus for competitive exams is not under our purview we convey the same to the concerned people of CCE and University and we hope that is heard and necessary modifications are done in future.
